

Game Summaries

Game 25 lowa 67, Michigan 55 Feb. 19, 2006, Carver-Hawkeye Arena

IOWA CITY - - lowa snapped a two-game losing skid with a 67-55 victory over Michigan in front of 5,061 fans at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

The Hawkeyes didn't shoot the ball well (38.6%), but did out-rebound the Wolverines by eight (40-32). Hawkeye sophomore Krista VandeVenter controlled a game-high 11 rebounds, marking the fifth time in eight games the forward has grabbed double digit rebounds. lowa improves to 10-0 when it out-rebounds its opponents this year.

lowa had four players net double figures, led by freshman Megan Skouby's 14 points. Eight of Skouby's 14 points came from the foul line. Freshman Kristi Smith tallied double figures for the fourth time in five games as the point guard scored 11. Seniors Tiffany Reedy and Crystal Smith each contributed 10 points. All of Crystal Smith's 10 points came in the first period.

Kristi Smith posted career highs in rebounds (5) and steals (3). In addition to scoring 10 points, Crystal Smith collected four rebounds, five assists and three steals in only 27 minutes of action.

Michigan was led by freshman Jessica Minnfield, who recorded a game-high 20 points. Sophomore Janelle Cooper and freshman Stephanie Skrba each scored 10 points in the losing effort.

lowa built a 10-point advantage (18-8) in the first 11 minutes and never looked back. The Wolverines closed the deficit to five points (23-18) with 4:40 remaining in the half, but the Hawkeyes closed the half on a 9-2 run to take a commanding 32-20 lead into the break. Iowa led by as many as 20 points in the second half en route to its seventh-straight victory over Michigan.

The Hawkeyes forced 19 turnovers and converted Michigan's miscues into 14 points.

Game 26 lowa 71, Illinois 60 Feb. 23, 2006, Assembly Hall

CHAMPAIGN, **IL - -** lowa's Crystal Smith scored a game-high 23 points to lead lowa to a 71-60 victory over Illinois at Assembly Hall. The win is lowa's six-straight over the Fighting Illini, including winning the last three at Assembly Hall

lowa nearly took an eight-point advantage into the half, but Illinois freshman Lori Bjork drained an off balance 3-pointer at the buzzer to trim the Hawkeye advantage to five (40-35). lowa improved to 12-2 when leading at the break.

Illinois scored the second half's first four points to cut Iowa's advantage to one (40-39). The Hawkeyes countered by scoring the next 10 points to rebuild their lead to 11 (50-39) with 14:03 left. Later in the half, the Fighting Illini fought back with a 10-2 run to cut their deficit to six points (56-50) with 8:01 remaining. However, Iowa maintained its advantage and held on for the 11-point victory.

Skouby contributed 18 points, six rebounds and two blocks for the Hawkeyes. Freshman reserve Wendy Ausdemore scored double figures for the fifth time this season, netting 14 points. Iowa improves to 11-3 when Ausdemore scores seven points or more.

lowa did a good job coveting the basketball and feeding its post, as the Hawkeyes out-scored Illinois 22-6 in the paint and posted a season-low 10 turnovers. Iowa also converted 14 Illinois turnovers into 19 points; out-scoring the Fighting Illini 19-2 in points off turnovers.

Three Illinois players tallied double figures to lead the Fighting Illini. Lori Bjork and Erin Wigley each netted 15 points, while Janelle Hughes added 14. Danyel Crutcher pulled down a game-high 11 rebounds.

A Crystal Smith free throw at the 3:49 mark of the first stanza, marked her 1,000th combined point the last two years.

lowa's win snapped a three-game road losing skid for lowa. The Hawkeyes' last triumph away from lowa City came at Wisconsin (68-59) on Jan. 19. lowa also picked up its ninth conference win, besting last year's total of eight.
