Game Summaries

Game 16 lowa 80, Northwestern 48 Jan. 15, 2006, Welsh-Ryan Arena

EVANSTON, **IL** -- Iowa built a 21-point first-half lead and cruised to an 80-48 triumph over Northwestern at Welsh-Ryan Arena. The win was Iowa's largest conference win since recording a 40-point win over Northwestern on Jan. 25, 2001 in Evanston. The victory was also Iowa's 10-straight over the Wildcats, all under Head Coach Lisa Bluder.

Megan Skouby and Crystal Smith were lowa's offensive catalysts today. Skouby netted a game-high 18 points (8-16 FG, 2-2 FT), marking the 11th time this year she has scored double figures. The Big Ten's leading freshman scorer, has tallied double digits four-straight contests and five of lowa's six league games. Smith added 13 points in only 18 minutes of action.

Tiffany Reedy had a solid all-around game, converting 3-4 from 3-point range for nine points and collecting seven rebounds, four assists and three steals.

lowa had a better 3-point shooting percentage (.692, 9-13) than Northwestern did free throw percentage (.615, 8-13). Reedy and Lindsey Nyenhuis drained three triples each, Smith nailed two, while Abby Emmert made one.

Leading 16-7, lowa went on a 12-0 run to expand its advantage to 28-7. lowa converted 10 of its first 13 field goal attempts, while Northwestern made only three of its first 19. The Hawkeyes made only two field goals the last nine minutes of the first stanza. lowa led by 16 at the half (36-20).

Northwestern was led by reserve forward Lauren Roberts and Nadia Bibbs. Roberts tallied a team-high 10 points, while Bibbs recorded a career-high eight rebounds.

Eleven of lowa's 12 players scored, including 33 points from the Hawkeye bench. Also, lowa's freshmen netted a season-high 43 points.

The Hawkeyes outrebounded the Wildcats by 11 (49-38) and collected 24 assists to Northwestern's 14.

Game 17 lowa 68, Wisconsin 59 Jan. 19, 2006, Kohl Center

WISCONSIN, WI - - lowa converted 11 of its last 12 free throws in the final minutes as the Hawkeyes held off a surging Wisconsin Badger squad 68-59 Thursday night at the Kohl Center. Freshman Megan Skouby poured in a game-high 23 points, while seniors Tiffany Reedy and Crystal Smith each contributed 15 points.

lowa was forced to make its foul shots down the stretch as Wisconsin held the Hawkeyes to only one field goal the last 7:18. The Badgers cut the lowa advantage to four (61-57) with 57 seconds remaining, but the Hawkeyes made five of their last six free throws en route to victory.

lowa scored more points at the free throw line (16) than from the field (14) in the second period. The Hawkeyes finished the game shooting 78.6 percent (22-28) from the charity stripe. Wisconsin shot a dismal 28.6 percent (4-14) from the foul line, including 20.0 percent (2-10) in the second period.

In addition to scoring 15 points, Smith equaled a career high with six steals. Reedy's 15 points was a season best.

Wisconsin dominated lowa on the glass, out-rebounding the Hawkeyes by 12 (43-31). Hawkeye sophomore Krista VandeVenter pulled down 13 of their 31 boards.

Reedy has a nice first half, shooting 4-4 from the field, including 1-1 from 3-point range, and 1-2 from the foul line for 10 points. Skouby netted 13 first-half points, while Smith added seven points for the Hawkeyes.

The Hawkeye defense was stifling, forcing 14-Wisconsin first-half turnovers, with lowa converting those miscues into 18 points. Wisconsin recorded 19 miscues for the game.

The Badgers were led by Jolene Anderson and Ashley Josephson. Anderson tallied a team-high 20 points, while Josephson registered 10.
