- It is the second straight year (fourth time all-time) that Iowa will face a top 10 ranked Iowa State team.
- It is the third time in series history that the two teams meet as ranked opponents (Iowa is 23rd in coaches poll and 26th in AP poll). In 2013-14, ISU was 17th and Iowa 23rd, while in 1987-88, Iowa was No. 7 and Iowa State was 20th.
- The Hawkeyes' 8-1 start is the best for the program through nine games since the 2000-01 season (9-0).
- Iowa rebounded from its first loss of the season to down Maryland, 83-64, on Dec. 6 in Iowa City. Four Hawkeyes landed in double figures in the game.
- The Hawkeyes opened the season with seven straight wins -- the best start since 2021-22. Head coach Ben McCollum was the fourth Iowa coach all-time to open his tenure with seven consecutive wins -- the first since Dr. Tom Davis in the 1986-87 season.
- The Hawkeyes are 17th in the nation with a .517 field goal percentage, which includes a .594 effective field goal percentage.
- Iowa won the Acrisure Classic with victories over Ole Miss and Grand Canyon, while senior Bennett Stirtz was named the tournament MVP after averaging 21 points, 3.5 assists and 1.5 steals with seven 3-pointers.
- Stirtz has a team-high four 20-point games, including a season-high 29 points in the win over Ole Miss, making 9-of-20 field goals and six 3-pointers. He scored a game-high 25 points in the Dec. 6 win over Maryland.
- Iowa held Grand Canyon to 46 points -- the fewest allowed since 2010 -- and it was the team's first win when scoring fewer than 60 points since 2020.
- Stirtz is averaging 18.8 points with .505/.451/.800 shooting splits, while averaging 4.9 assists, 2.6 rebounds and 1.8 steals. He ranks in the top seven in the Big Ten in points, assists and steals.
- Amongst active players, Stirtz is the only player nationally ranked in the top 10 in points (1,787) and assists (476) and he is one of six to have 1,500 points and 350 assists.

ON THE AIR

Radio: Games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network with Gary Dolphin (play-by-play) and Bobby Hansen (color) on the call. The network includes 1 more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and includes portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network includes a 60-minute pregame show.

TV: Thursday's game will be televised on FS1 with Kevin Kugler (play-by-play) and Miles Simon (color) on the call.

SCOUTING IOWA STATE

- The Cyclones bring a perfect 9-0 record into Thursday's Iowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series matchup at Hilton Coliseum. Iowa State is 4-0 at home this season.
- Iowa State has five Power 5 Conference victories this season, downing Mississippi State (96-80), St. John's (83-82), Creighton (78-60) and Syracuse (85-64) on neutral courts and posting an impressive 81-58 road win at top-ranked Purdue.
- The Cyclones are leading the nation with a 54.9 field goal percentage and are third in 3-point percentage (.438). Iowa State also has the No. 1 scoring margin, winning by an average of 30 points per game.
- ISU is also No. 1 in the nation in points per possession, averaging 1.317 per game, while ranking eighth in point per possession defensively (0.899).
- Iowa State also ranks in the top 10 nationally in turnover margin (+8.9, 1st), turnovers forced (19, 2nd), scoring offense (8th, 84.6) and steals (8th, 11.1).
- The Cyclones have four players averaging in double figures with sophomore Milan Momcilovic leading the way with an 18.3 scoring average. Momcilovic is No. 2 in the nation in 3-pointers per game (4.11), third in total 3s (37) and eighth in 3-point percentage (.536).
- Joshua Jefferson averages 17.6 points and a team-high 6.7 rebounds and 5.4 assists. He is shooting 56.6 percent from the field. Tamin Lipsey, who has missed three games because of injury, averages 16.8 points, while Killyan Toure averages 12.0.
- Iowa State has four players with 13 or more steals and the team has 100 steals combined in nine games. The Cyclones have forced 171 turnovers (19 per game).

SERIES HISTORY

- Thursday's game is the 79th meeting in the all-time series against Iowa State. The Hawkeyes won the first 10 meetings, beginning in 1910, and 17 of the first 18 contests.
- Iowa leads the all-time series, 48-30.
- The Cyclones have won the last two and three of the last four meetings, including two straight in Hilton Coliseum. Iowa State leads 22-17 all-time in Ames.
- Iowa's last win in Hilton came in 2019 -- an 84-68 victory. The win snapped an eight-game losing streak in Ames.
- It is the second straight year Iowa has faced the Cyclones when they were a top 10 opponent.

IOWA CORN CY-HAWK SERIES

The 2025-26 season marks the 21st year of the Iowa-Corn Cy-Hawk Series, which tracks head-to-head matchups between Iowa and Iowa State. The Cyclones currently lead the series, 11-2, with wins in football, volleyball, men's and women's cross country and men's wrestling. Iowa won on the soccer pitch. • The teams meet in women's basketball on Wednesday and there are scheduled meetings in women's swim and dive, women's tennis, women's gymnastics and softball remaining.

LAST GAME: IOWA 83, MARYLAND 64

The Hawkeyes notched their first Big Ten victory of the season, downing Maryland, 83-64, on Dec. 6 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Iowa had four players land in double figures with senior Bennett Stirtz leading the way with 25 points on 10-of-17 shooting.

- The Terps lost despite making 24 free throws (to Iowa's six) and Maryland attempted 38 free throws (to Iowa's 12).
- The Hawkeyes had a 44-20 advantage in paint points and shot 54 percent from the field with nine 3-point field goals.
- Iowa jumped on Maryland in the first half, using a 12-0, 17-2 and 19-4 run to build a 30-13 lead.
- Junior Cam Manyawu (12 points and seven rebounds), freshman Tate Sage (12 points, four rebounds, three assists) and Cooper Koch (11 points) were also in double digits.

NOTABLES

- Junior Alvaro Folgueiras is averaging 8.3 points, four rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.1 steals. He has 21 assists and seven turnovers in nine games, while shooting 54.3 percent from the field and 46.2 percent from 3-point range.
- Sophomore Isaia Howard had a breakout game in the win over Grand Canyon, leading all scorers with 19 points on 7-of-10 shooting with a season-high three 3-pointers.
- In two games at the Acrisure Classic, Howard averaged 11.5 points and five rebounds, while shooting 56.3 percent from the field.
- Freshman Tate Sage scored 12 points on 5-of-9 shooting to go along with four rebounds and three steals in the Big Ten win over Maryland. He played 20+ minutes for the second time this season.
- The Hawkeyes are averaging 34.9 points in the paint this season.
- Senior Brendan Hausen has made 10 field goals this season -- all but one coming from 3-point range. All but four of his attempts have come from distance.
- Iowa is third in the Big Ten in 3-point field goal percentage (.377). The team has made 10 or more 3-pointers in three contests and eight or more six times.
- Iowa has the No. 2 scoring defense in the conference (12th nationally), allowing 62.6 points per game. The team has allowed fewer than 65 points five times.
- The Hawkeyes are forcing 15.7 turnovers per games -- tops in the Big Ten.
- Iowa is second in the Big Ten in steals at 8.0 per game and the team has had 10+ steals three times this season.
- The Hawkeyes attempted 44 free throws (made 36) in the season-opening win over Robert Morris. Iowa, who has made 25 or more free throws in three games this season, is averaging 18.3 makes per game -- sixth-most in the Big Ten.

IOWA'S ROSTER CONSTRUCTION

- Head coach Ben McCollum's first Iowa team features one of the top transfer classes in the nation. 247Sports ranked the Hawkeyes' portal class as eighth-best in the country.
- Among the 12 newcomers, eight are Division I transfers, including **Tavion Banks** (Drake), **Kael Combs** (Drake), **Alvaro Folgueiras** (Robert Morris), **Brendan Hausen** (Kansas State), **Isaia Howard** (Drake), **Cam Manyawu** (Drake), **Joey Matteoni** (Drake) and **Bennett Stirtz** (Drake).
- Iowa had one scholarship holdover -- **Cooper Koch** -- and one walk-on returnee -- **Jacob Koch** -- from the 2024-25 roster. Cooper Koch played in 10 games before medically redshirting.
- **Banks** was the MVC Sixth Man of the Year as a junior at Drake after averaging 10.1 points and five rebounds. He played 103 collegiate games at Northwest Florida State and Drake in his first three seasons.
- **Combs** played one season at both Wyoming and Drake before making the transition to Iowa City. He played in 31 games as a reserve guard for the Bulldogs, averaging 3.8 points, two rebounds and 0.9 assists. He tied a career-high with 13 points in the NCAA Tournament against Texas Tech.
- **Folgueiras** was the Horizon League Player of the Year and a first-team All-Horizon League selection after averaging 14.1 points, 9.1 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.4 steals. The Spain native led the Colonials to a regular season and tournament title en route to the NCAA Tournament. Folgueiras is on the Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year Top 20 Preseason Watch List.
- **Hausen**, the Amarillo Assassin, has played three seasons of Power 5 basketball at Villanova (2) and K-State (1), where he has seen action in 99 games with 33 starts. Hausen has scored 671 career points with 178 3-pointers in his collegiate career.
- **Howard** saw action in 30 games as a freshman at Drake, where he averaged 4.5 points and 2.5 rebounds. The Missouri native scored 3,001 points at Plattsburg High School.
- **Manyawu** played his first two seasons at Wyoming and Drake. He averaged 7.1 points and 5.3 rebounds for the Bulldogs. Manyawu was one of Iowa's representatives at the 2025 Big Ten Media Day.
- **Matteoni** originally signed with McCollum at Northwest Missouri State and he was McCollum's first signee at Drake. Matteoni redshirted during the 2024-25 season in Des Moines.
- **Stirtz** is the headliner of the class after earning All-America honors and being named the MVC Player and Newcomer of the Year in 2024-25. One of the top returning guards nationally, Stirtz averaged 19.2 points, 2.21 steals and 5.7 assists. He is a preseason All-American and named to the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Top-20 Watch List.
- Iowa brought in four freshmen -- **Trevin Jirak** (West Des Moines, Iowa), **Peyton McCollum** (Maryville, Mo.), **Tate Sage** (Weatherford, Okla.) and **Trey Thompson** (Greenville, Tenn.).
- **Jirak** was Iowa's Mr. Basketball as a senior, **Sage** originally had signed with Drake before coming to Iowa, **McCollum** was an all-state selection at Waukee Northwest and **Thompson** reclassified from the Class of 2026 to the Class of 2025, bypassing his senior season of high school. Thompson was a four-star recruit by On3 and 247Sports.

- Iowa has attempted more free throws than its opponent in seven of nine games this season.
- The Hawkeyes have been projected to place seventh in the Big Ten by Blue Ribbon College Basketball Yearbook and ninth by the USA Today Network.
- Assistant coach Luke Barnwell is in his first season on the coaching staff following a two-year stint at Texas Tech. The Red Raiders advanced to the Elite Eight during the 2025-26 season.
- Director of basketball operations Kyle Denning is the lone holdover on Iowa's staff. Denning is in his 11th season with the program and fourth in his current position.

EFFICIENT BASKETBALL

The Hawkeyes rank in the top 35 in offensive efficiency. Iowa is 22nd in the nation in points per possession (1.229).

HAWKEYES WIN ACRISURE CLASSIC

- Iowa won two games in two days, defeating Ole Miss and Grand Canyon to win the Acrisure Classic title on Nov. 25-26 in Palm Desert, Calif.
- Senior Bennett Stirtz was named the Acrisure Classic MVP after averaging 21 points, 3.5 assists, 2.5 rebounds and 1.5 steals, while making seven 3-pointers.
 - It was the second straight year the Hawkeyes have won a preseason tournament (Kenny Arnold Classic, 2024) and it is the first tournament-style crown since 2018 at the 2K Classic in New York City following wins over Oregon and UConn.
 - Iowa's win over Ole Miss was its first over an SEC opponent since 2010 and the sixth win over the conference since 2000.

MAC STARTS STRONG

- Head coach Ben McCollum was the fourth Iowa head coach all-time to win the first seven games of his tenure -- the first since Dr. Tom Davis in the 1986-87 season.
- The Hawkeyes scored 101 points in McCollum's debut game, making him the third Iowa coach in his Hawkeye debut, joining Ralph Miller (1965) and Lute Olson (1975).

IRON HAWK

- Senior Bennett Stirtz has started 105 of 112 games in his collegiate career, including 105 consecutive starts. He has played 40 or more minutes 44 times, including four this season.
- Stirtz is currently tops in the Big Ten and No. 3 nationally in minutes played (37:44). He also led the nation in minutes played last season.
 - He played all 40 minutes in 24 games last season at Drake.

BENNETT IN BLACK & GOLD

- Senior Bennett Stirtz has been in double figures in eight games, which is tops on the team, which includes a team-high four 20-point contests. He is averaging 18.8 points with a .505/.451/.800 shooting clip. He also is averaging 4.9 assists, 2.6 rebounds and 1.8 steals per game.
- He ranks in the top seven in the Big Ten in assists (sixth), steals (sixth) and scoring (seventh).
 - Stirtz was unguardable in Iowa's 74-69 win over Ole Miss, finishing with a season-high 29 points, making 9-of-20 field goals and tying a career-high with six 3-pointers.

- In his second Big Ten game, he finished with 25 points on 10-of-17 shooting with four 3-pointers in Iowa's 19-point win over Maryland.
- Stirtz finished with 24 points, seven assists and two steals against Western Illinois and 21 points, eight rebounds, three assists and two steals against Xavier.
- He has 37 career 20-point contests.
- He finished with 19 points on 6-of-10 shooting with six assists and four steals in his Hawkeye debut against Robert Morris. His 19-point output tied Aaron White for the most by a Hawkeye in their debut in the last 30 seasons.

HIGH ASSISTS, LOW TURNOVERS

- Senior Bennett Stirtz has a team-high 44 assists, averaging 4.9 per game, ranking sixth in the Big Ten. He has committed 15 turnovers in a team-high 339 minutes.
- He has had five or more assists in five games, including a season-high nine assists in the Nov. 18 win over SEMO.
 - Twice this season, Stirtz has had seven or more assists without committing a turnover. He has four games with zero turnovers.

COOOOOOOOOOOP

- Redshirt freshman Cooper Koch had a breakout in California, averaging 12.5 points and team-high eight rebounds in wins over Ole Miss and Grand Canyon. He finished in double-digits in both contests, shooting 53.8 percent from the floor with three 3-pointers in 35.9 minutes per game.
- The Peoria, Illinois, native recorded his first career double-double against the Rebels, finishing with 14 points and career-high 10 rebounds. He followed it up with 11 points and six rebounds in the title game against GCU.

EFFICIENT AL

Junior Alvaro Folgueiras has been in double figures in four games, where he is averaging 8.3 points, four rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.1 steals in a reserve role. The Spaniard is shooting 54.3 percent and 46.2 percent (12-of-26) from 3-point range. His 12 3-pointers are third-most on the team.

- Folgueiras had his best game as a Hawkeye on Nov. 18 against SEMO, finishing with a season-high 16 points on 4-of-6 shooting with three 3-pointers.
- He had 14 points, six rebounds, four assists and one steal against Chicago State, making 5-of-9 field goals and three 3-pointers.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE T

Senior Tavion Banks notched Iowa's first double-double of the season on Nov. 20 against Chicago State, finishing with 16 points and 10 rebounds in 24 minutes. It was his 18th career double-double.

- Banks has scored in double figures in three games this season, where he is averaging 8.6 points and 4.1 rebounds, while shooting 55.3 percent.
- The Kansas City, Mo., native finished with 17 points and four rebounds, making 6-of-7 field goals, in his Hawkeye debut against Robert Morris.

SHARING THE ROCK

Ball movement and unselfish basketball is the name of the game for Iowa hoops. The Hawkeyes have dished out 151 assists over nine games. Iowa has assisted on 151 of its 241 field goals -- 62.7 percent.

- Iowa has had 20+ assists in three games, including a season-high 26 assists in the Nov. 20 win over Chicago State.

CHERISHING THE ROCK

Along with incredible ball movement, the Hawkeyes take care of the basketball. Iowa averages 10 turnovers per game and the team has four games with 10 or fewer turnovers.

MAC IS HOME

Head coach Ben McCollum was born in Iowa City, grew up in Storm Lake and played two seasons of college basketball at North Iowa Area Community College in Mason City. McCollum's mother, Mary Timko, earned her undergraduate, master's and law degrees from the University of Iowa.

- McCollum is the first Iowa native to lead the men's basketball program since Dick Schultz from 1970-74.

MAC NOTABLES

- Ben McCollum coached four NCAA Division II National Championship teams at Northwest Missouri State, winning titles in 2017, 2019, 2021 and 2022. The 2020 NCAA Tournament was canceled because of COVID.
- McCollum has led his team to 20+ victories in 14 consecutive seasons, dating back to the 2011-12 season (his third at Northwest Missouri State).
- Since winning his first NCAA title in 2017, McCollum's team's have lost a total of 25 games over the past nine seasons. His teams have gone 286-25 (.920) since the start of the 2016-17 season.
- No McCollum-coached team since his first team in 2009-10 at Northwest Missouri State has allowed more than 70 points per game in a season.

BOB COUSY POINT GUARD OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

Senior guard Bennett Stirtz was named to the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Preseason Top 20 Watch List. Stirtz is the fourth Hawkeye all-time to be named to the list along with Jeff Horner (2006), Mike Gesell (2016) and Jordan Bohannon (2018).

- Stirtz is one of four players from the Big Ten named to the initial watch list along with Purdue's Braden Smith, Michigan's Elliot Cadeau and Ohio State's Bruce Thornton.

KARL MALONE POWER FORWARD OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

Junior Alvaro Folgueiras has been named to the Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year Preseason Watch List. Folgueiras is the third Hawkeye named to the list, joining Keegan (2021) and Kris (2022) Murray.

- Folgueiras is one of five Big Ten players named to the watch list along with Michigan's Yaxel Lendeborg, Purdue's Trey Kaufman-Renn, UCLA's Tyler Bilodeau and Northwestern's Nick Martinelli.

STIRTZ: 1 OF THE NATION'S BEST

After transferring from Division II Northwest Missouri State to Drake, senior Bennett Stirtz established himself as one of the nation's best players.

- The guard averaged 19.2 points, 4.3 rebounds and 5.7 assists per game, while shooting 49.8 percent from the field and 39.5 percent from 3-point range. Stirtz finished in double figures in 33 of the team's 35 games.
- Stirtz was selected as the Missouri Valley Player and Newcomer of the Year after leading the league in scoring, steals and assist-to-turnover ratio. He also was second in the league in assists.
- Stirtz led the Bulldogs to the MVC regular season and tournament titles -- he was the Most Outstanding Player of the MVC Tournament -- and to the Round of 32 in the NCAA Tournament.

BIG AL(VARO)

After two seasons at Robert Morris, junior forward Alvaro Folgueiras makes the transition to the Big Ten. The Spain native was the Horizon League Player of the Year and a first-team all-league selection after averaging 14.1 points, 9.1 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.4 steals. Folgueiras led the Colonials to a Horizon League regular season and tournament title and to the NCAA Tournament.

- In the Round of 64, Folgueiras finished with a 15-point, 10-rebound double-double to go along with four assists against top-seeded Alabama.
- Ranked as the 84th-best player in the nation by On3 entering the 2025-26 season.

SNIPER B

Senior Brendan Hausen is a sniper with the basketball in his hands. The 6-foot-4 guard has made 187 3-point field goals in his collegiate career in stops at Villanova, Kansas State and Iowa.

- 187 of Hausen's 218 field goals -- 85.8 percent -- have come from 3-point range.
- Last season in Manhattan, Hausen enjoyed the best season of his career, averaging 10.9 points and 2.5 rebounds. He made 90 3-pointers, which were the sixth-most in a single season in K-State history.

IT'S IN THE NAME

Senior guard/forward Tavion Banks is endearing himself to Hawkeye fans with his name alone. He shares a name, although a different spelling, with former Hawkeye running back Tavian Banks, who was an All-American and the Big Ten Co-Offensive Player of the Year in 1997.

- Iowa's current Tavion Banks was the MVC Sixth Man of the Year during the 2024-25 season at Drake after averaging 10.1 points and five rebounds.

LONE RETURNEE

Redshirt freshman Cooper Koch is the lone scholarship player returning to the Hawkeyes in 2025-26. The Peoria, Illinois, native played in 10 games as a true freshman before being sidelined with a medical condition. The former top-100 recruit averaged 4.6 points and 2.1 rebounds, while shooting 48.4 percent from the floor and 42.9 percent from 3-point range.

INTERNATIONAL AL

Junior Alvaro Folgueiras spent the summer playing for the U20 Spanish National Team in the 2025 FIBA U20 EuroBasket Championships in Greece. He also trained and played in two friendlies with the Spanish Men's National Team in August.

MR. BASKETBALL

Freshman Trevin Jirak was named Iowa's Mr. Basketball in 2024. The West Des Moines, Iowa, native originally signed with Northern Iowa before flipping his commitment when Ben McCollum became Iowa's head coach.

- Jirak averaged 16.2 points, 9.4 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.1 blocks per game as a senior at Valley High School, leading the Tigers to the Class 4A state title. He shot 59.2 percent from the field and 38.6 percent from 3-point range.
- Jirak is the third Mr. Basketball to join the Hawkeye program since 2018 -- Joe Wieskamp (2018) and Pryce Sandfort (2023).

STAFF CONTINUITY

Iowa's coaching staff includes seven staff members that were a part of Ben McCollum's staff last season at Drake, including three of the four assistant coaches -- Bryston Williams, Josh Sash and Connor Wheeler.

- Bryston Williams, Xavier Kurth (director, player development) and Jaran Richman (director, scouting) all have played for and coached under McCollum.
- Chief of staff Jesse Shaw was a member of the Drake coaching staff. Shaw played with McCollum at Northwest Missouri State and coached with McCollum at Emporia State.
- Jace Smith is in his second season under McCollum as video coordinator.

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 3,017 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,783-1,234 (.590). Iowa's 1,783 wins are 38th most among Division I programs. That includes a 1,142-391 (.744) record in home games, a 641-844 (.430) record in contests away from Iowa City, an 844-845 (.499) mark in Big Ten games and a 547-168 (.764) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

HEAD COACH BEN McCOLLUM

Iowa native Ben McCollum enters his first season as the head men's basketball coach for the University of Iowa. McCollum is the 23rd head coach in program history.

McCollum arrives in Iowa City with a sterling resume that includes four NCAA Division II national championships (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) at Northwest Missouri State University. In his first season in NCAA Division I, McCollum guided Drake to a school-record 31 wins, the Missouri Valley Conference regular season and tournament titles and to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

During his 17+ year coaching career, McCollum has amassed a record of 433-96 record for an 81.8 winning percentage. It is fifth-best all-time among collegiate men's basketball coaches.

During his first and only season in Des Moines, McCollum guided the Bulldogs to a 31-4 record en route to being named the Missouri Valley Conference Coach of the Year and the Joe B. Hall National Coach of the Year, which is presented annually to the top first-time head coach in Division I college basketball. He was also one of 10 coaches nationally named as a semifinalist for the Naismith Coach of the Year after leading Drake to 31 victories -- the most by a first-year coach in MVC history.

After sweeping the league's regular season and tournament titles, the Bulldogs earned a No. 11 seed in the NCAA Tournament. Drake followed with a 67-57 triumph over sixth-seeded Missouri to record the program's first non-First Four win since 1971.

The Bulldogs boasted the Larry Bird Player of the Year (Bennett Stirtz) and Sixth Man of the Year (Tavion Banks), while having two all-league, one all-newcomer and one all-defensive team selection. Four of McCollum's players from Northwest Missouri State joined him at Drake.

During his 15-years in Maryville, Missouri, McCollum posted a 395-91 record (81.3 winning percentage) and he earned five NABC Division II National Coach of the Year awards, the most for a single coach in Division II history. McCollum also garnered three Clarence Gaines Awards, nine Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association (MIAA) Coach of the Year honors and was a 2024 Missouri Sports Hall of Fame inductee.

McCollum's individual accolades were a direct result of the high-level players he recruited and instructed. His Bearcat squads captured a dozen MIAA regular season titles, eight MIAA tournament crowns, and over his final eight seasons the program averaged more than 31 wins per year and compiled a record of 253-21 (92.3 winning percentage).

During McCollum's Bearcat tenure, the program's single season win totals were staggering. He led the team to at least 21 wins in each of his final 13 seasons. Five of those years included 30+ wins highlighted by an undefeated 38-0 campaign in 2018-19. That season marked just the fifth time in Division II history that a team ran the table through the regular and postseasons.

Individual players flourished under McCollum. He coached dozens of players to All-MIAA status and a handful of others to more specialized recognition. Those individual honors were highlighted by two National Players of the Year, six NABC All-Americans, six MIAA Players of the Year, three MIAA Defensive Players of the Year and five MIAA All-Freshman selections.

McCollum's storied coaching career began as a graduate assistant at Northwest, his alma mater, from 2003-05. He experienced his first full-time position at Emporia State for four seasons (2005-09) before returning to Maryville and taking over as the Bearcats' head coach.

As a player, McCollum helped lead Northwest Missouri State to a 51-12 record and the program's first-ever Elite Eight appearance in 2001-02 following a 29-3 season. That was also the first time the Bearcats ever swept both regular season and tournament titles, an accomplishment he replicated years later as head coach.

McCollum's playing career began at North Iowa Area Community College in Mason City, Iowa, where he was a two-time all-region selection. Born in Iowa City, McCollum was raised in Storm Lake, Iowa, and graduated from St. Mary's High School in 1999. He earned his bachelor's degree in business finance from Northwest Missouri State in 2003 and his master's in athletic administration from the school in 2004. McCollum's mother, Mary Timko, earned her undergraduate, master's and law degrees from the University of Iowa.

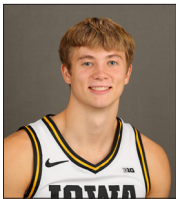
