No. 2 UCLA (21-1, 11-0) defeated No. 8 Iowa (18-4, 9-2) inside Pauley Pavilion on Sunday afternoon, 88-65.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Ava Heiden led Iowa with 19 points (7-12 FG) and three rebounds.
- Heiden has reached double figures in 10 straight games and against all 11 Big Ten opponents.
- Chit-Chat Wright registered 10 points, a team-high seven assists, and three rebounds.
- Wright has dished out five or more assists in four out of the last five games.
- Taylor Stremlow added 12 points and four assists.
- Hannah Stuelke recorded 13 points, eight rebounds, and four assists.
- It was Stuelke's 16th game with eight or more boards.
- Addie Deal made her second career start as a Hawkeye.

TEAM NOTES

- It was Iowa's fourth loss in the last 21 Big Ten regular season games.
- The Hawkeyes fell to 5-3 against AP Top 25 foes this year.
- Iowa is 8-9 against AP Top 25 teams in the Jan Jensen era.
- The Hawkeyes are 4-1 against their last five ranked opponents.
