

Public notice - Alcohol licence

Section 101, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Skycity Hamilton Limited has made an application to the District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council for the VARIATION of conditions of a ON licence in respect of the premises situated at 340 Victoria Street Hamilton Central 3204, known as Garden Room. The general nature of the business to be conducted under the licence is that of a Function Centre.

The VARIATION is sought for the following:

Amend the current licensed area – remove the ground floor from the license and redefine the principal purpose to function centre.

The application may be inspected during ordinary office hours at the office of the Hamilton District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council Municipal Building, Garden Place, Hamilton.

Any person who is entitled to object and who wishes to object to the issue of the licence may, not later than 15 working days after the date of the publication of this notice, file a notice in writing of the objection with the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council, Private Bag 3010, Hamilton 3240 in email to Licensing@hcc.govt.nz

No objection to the variation or cancellation of conditions of licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 105 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
