The objection outcome

A valuer from Opteon may view your property and may contact you to discuss your objection further.

A decision will be made to either;

- a) alter the valuation; or
- b) decline to make any amendment in the valuation.

Notice of the valuation decision will be given to you in writing, once approved by the Hamilton City Council.

Acceptance of the Objection Review

If no response is received from you within 20 working days from the date of the objection outcome notification, the decision of Hamilton City Council is said to have the objector's agreement.

If you do not agree with the review, you may, within 20 working days from the date of being notified of the decision, request that the objection be heard by the Land Valuation Tribunal. To do this you must file the objection in the office of the District Court and provide a copy of the objection to the Hamilton City Council.
