DIRECTION #29

HEARING PANEL

PURPOSE

1. The purpose of Direction #29 is to respond to Counsel for Kāinga Ora's 7 May 2024 request for directions relating to Hearing session 3 and HHA evidence and report exchange.

INTRODUCTION

2. By memorandum dated 7 May 2024, Counsel for Kāinga Ora seeks directions for report and evidence exchange on the merits of identifying HHAs with reference to HCC's final set of draft provisions circulated on 3 May 2024. Counsel was not clear that had been intended under Direction #26.
3. The directions sought mirrored the timeframe already directed, and were:
 - a. *Council to exchange any further evidence in support of the listing of its proposed HHAs by 3 July 2024.*
 - b. *Submitters to exchange any evidence on the merits of listing the proposed HHAs by 24 July 2024.*
 - c. *Council to exchange rebuttal evidence by 9 August 2024.*
 - d. *The matter to proceed to hearing commencing on 21 August 2024.*

DIRECTION

4. The Panel confirms that the exchange timetable section of Direction #26 (i.e. 2(g)-(k)) was intended to apply to both Built Heritage and Historic Heritage Areas. That includes the direction for legal submissions to be filed by 16 August 2024.
5. Direction #26 is accordingly amended by the clarification sought by Kāinga Ora.
