## RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ACT 1991 DIRECTION #6 INDEPENDENT HEARING PANEL

## **PURPOSE**

1. The purpose of Direction #6 is to address the request by Spark New Zealand Trading Limited to lodge a late submission.

## **DIRECTION**

- 2. By Memorandum dated 5 May 2023, counsel for the Council has sought directions granting Spark New Zealand Trading Limited's (Spark) request to lodge a late submission (Attachment 1 of the Memorandum). Spark made neither a submission nor a further submission on PC9.
- 3. The PC9 heritage classification provision opposed relates to a building owned by Spark at 7 Caro Street notated in Appendix 8A of the Hamilton District Plan as a Category B built heritage item (Telephone Exchange: H172).
- 4. From correspondence submitted to Council it appears that notification to Spark was incorrectly addressed and it has only subsequently become aware of the PC9 matter.
- 5. Council supports the extension of time sought particularly because built heritage is a PC9 Session 2 matter scheduled to be heard in September 2023 for which a timetable for evidence exchange has yet to be advised.
- 6. Counsel proposes the following per s.37 RMA:
  - (a) Extending the time limit for Spark to make its submission in relation to the proposal to include 7 Caro Street in Appendix 8A as a Category B built heritage item to 19 May 2023;
  - (b) Extending the time limit by which any person may make a further submission, either in support of or opposition to, Spark's submission to 9 June 2023; and
  - (c) Requiring that all submitters and further submitters on PC9 be notified by the hearing administrator of these directions via their nominated address for service.
- The Panel has considered that request, agrees that allowing the extension causes no obvious prejudice to any party, is procedurally fair, and Spark is the only person directly affected.

- 8. The Panel grants the request and directs as per Counsel's proposal in paragraph 6 above.
- 9. All parties are to be advised accordingly.
