Notice of Decisions on Submissions

Second decision on Hamilton City Operative District Plan - Plan Change 9 - Historic Heritage and Natural Environment.

Hamilton City Council gives notice that the Hearing Panel has released the second decision (Decision #2) on Plan Change 9 which deals with part of the Historic Heritage Areas topic.

Decision #2 removes the following Historic Heritage Areas from the notified Schedule 8D of Plan Change 9 on the basis that the assessment of the areas only meet the threshold of moderate and are no longer being pursued by Council. No submitters sought to support any of the nine areas.

The areas are:

- i. Augusta, Casper and Roseburg Streets
- ii. Casey Avenue
- iii. Hooker Avenue
- iv. Jennifer Place
- v. Lamont, Freemont, and Egmont Streets
- vi. Oxford Street (East) and Marshall Street
- vii. Seifert Street
- viii. Springfield Crescent
- ix. Sunnyhills Avenue

As a consequence of Decision #2, the proposed Historic Heritage Area rules do not apply to all nine areas as of the date of the decision.
