















In summary: we consider the oak trees behind 10, 12, and 14 Opoia Rd (T253.2 and T253.3) a health and safety hazard because of:

- potential to fall on power wires, River Rd, our houses, and paths,
- their shading contributes to cold and dampness in houses and slipperiness on paths,
- Council needs to work to ensure storm resilience removing these trees may prevent a lot of future problems

The decision we want from Council:

Do **not** make the Oak trees (T253.2 & T253.3) on the edge of River Road, behind 10, 12, and 14 Opoia Rd Notable trees....

but instead remove them and replace with smaller growing natives such as kowhai and pohutakawa.
