- 1. I have prepared this statement of supplementary evidence to address the question regarding the potential effects of the proposed vegetation clearance on the continuity of the corridor.
- 2. The proposed vegetation clearance at 29 Petersburg Drive will include the loss of vegetation along an edge of the planted indigenous shrubland. As such, it is not expected to create any new gaps within the corridor.
- 3. The corridor of which this vegetation forms a part is also already substantially fragmented by roading.
- 4. The ecological assessment does not include vegetation clearance within the easement.
