The History of Harrowfield Park

In 1990, development of the Harrowfield subdivision commenced and the property developer offered original land and house buyers the opportunity to contribute financially to the development of the Harrowfield Park. The funds gathered assisted to; grass the park, plant trees and shrubs, create two tennis courts and a tennis practice wall, create the driveway and car park area and create the children's play area - to make it the great park it is today.

The Harrowfield Club

The Harrowfield Club, run by a committee of volunteers (currently 11), was formed to manage the administration and up keep of the Harrowfield park. The fixed costs for the 2021/2022 financial year include rates, lawn mowing and insurance for the park and its assets. The total cost per annum is approximately \$9,000.

We need your support and are looking for as many club members as possible to ensure the fixed costs are met, the park is kept in an enjoyable condition and there are financial reserves for future maintenance and up-keep of the park, playground, tennis courts and security cameras and also for community events.
