Further to your information request of 18 February 2020, I am now able to provide Hamilton City Council's response.

You requested:

How much does Hamilton city council earn off car parking on average per day?

How much does the Hamilton city council earn from car park fines on average every month?

How many parking tickets does the Hamilton city council give out on average per day?

Our response:

How much does Hamilton city council earn off car parking on average per day?

- On average, car parking revenue from on street parking meters is \$1,023 per day over a one-year period from 1 February 2019 to 31 January 2020.
- On average, car parking revenue from off street parking is \$3,508 per day over a one-year period from 1 February 2019 to 31 January 2020.

How much does the Hamilton city council earn from car park fines on average every month?

On average, revenue from car parking and traffic infringements is \$48,000 per month over a one-year period from 1 February 2019 to 31 January 2020.

How many parking tickets does the Hamilton city council give out on average per day?

On average (based on a 6-day working week), 76 infringement tickets are issued for parking and traffic offences per day over a one-year period from 1 February 2019 to 31 January 2020 by Hamilton City Council.

If you have any concerns with the decision referred to in this response, you have the right to request an investigation and review by the Ombudsman under section 27(3) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987.
