Further to your information request of 13 February 2020 in respect of Three Waters Infrastructure Capacity, I am now able to provide Hamilton City Council's response.

You requested:

I have two high level questions:

Could you please give me an estimate of how many additional dwellings there is capacity for on the existing three waters network?

I understand upgrades are currently underway to both water treatment and wastewater facilities. How many additional dwellings will there be capacity for once these upgrades are complete?

Our response:

Can you please give me an estimate of how many additional dwellings there is capacity for on the existing 3 waters network?

The water network consists of a Water Treatment Station, a network of storage reservoirs and pumps as well as a reticulated network. There are significant planned investments over time to make sure that the network can meet the forecast demand, which is subject to many assumptions. The question asked is complicated to answer but at present we estimate that the existing Water Treatment Plant could accommodate an additional 5,000 households before capacity is exceeded.

I understand upgrades are currently underway to both water treatment and wastewater facilities. How many additional dwellings will there be capacity for once these upgrades are complete?

The current capacity of he Water Treatment Plant is 100 million litres per day. The Water Treatment Plant is being upgraded over the next 3 years to have a capacity of 140 million litres which should provide adequate capacity to 2046 based on a set of assumptions. This upgrade will provide for an additional 15,000 households before capacity is exceeded. The planned investments in the wastewater network will match this capacity.
