Further to your request under the Local Government Information Act requesting draft visuals for the potential treatment of the Founders Theatre site, I have attached a copy of the PowerPoint presentation to Councillors from the briefing held on 26 February. I think you are specifically seeking the slides headed Option 1 and Option 2.

It is important to note neither of these options are intended as final plans or outcomes. They were created to provide elected members a visual lead as to the type of design options that might be pursued. In fact, they generated a number of differing ideas well beyond the visuals presented at the briefing.

Our intention ultimately, subject to Council approval, is to go back out to the community again in 2-3 months-time and seek their views on either the retention or removal of the Founders theatre. As a part of this consultation, we would demonstrate the options of how the remaining land might be repurposed should the Founders building be removed. As a part of this exercise, the consultation will show illustrations to demonstrate concept ideas. Again, any future designs for consultation will not be the same draft designs used at the recent Councillor briefing, hence my desire to not publish them as is. If you do publish these, can I ask that you mark them clearly as DRAFT concept plans and make it clear these will not be the design options under consideration.

Present a report to Council on 10 March 2020 seeking approval of the plan to undertake one last consultation on the matter with the community



# Background



Founders Theatre closed.

28 April 2016

HCC undertook engagement with the community over a four week period on the future of Founders Theatre.

28 July 2016

Waikato Regional Theatre (WRT) proposal from Momentum Waikato was accepted by Council.

29 September 2016

Council resolved to report back on Founders' Theatre future once further information on WRT was known.

24 August 2017

Council resolved to report back on the options and financial implications regarding the future of Founders Theatre.



Council resolved to approve three options for public consultation, approved the consultation plan and requested a report back to Council with findings and a recommended approach for the future of Founders Theatre.



Public consultation took place over four weeks from 25 Oct - 26 Nov 2017.



Council approved to hold off on demolition until community sector consultation and a business case was reported back to Council by 30 March 2018. No viable proposals were received.



Council adopt the West Town Belt Masterplan which sets a thirty-year vision for the open space and its adjoining streets. The masterplan includes the Founders Theatre site.




## Site Context

Located in the centre of the West Town Belt (WTB) and western edge of the central city. The site is on a prominent street corner and the theatre is a dominant feature on the urban landscape due to it's distinct form and park setting.

The Founders site is not formally part of Boyes Park but the two spaces as 'read' as one.










## Options for the Founders site

**Option 1:** Removal of the building and basic reinstate the site as green space (already budgeted for - \$800,000).

**Option 2:** Removal of the building to create a new community park space that respects the rich history of Founders Theatre, celebrates and promotes the culture and arts sector, and enhances open space opportunities (\$1-2 million).

**Option 3:** Retention of building and it's adjoining spaces requiring a whole new plan (\$12m+).


