

Public notice - Alcohol licence

Section 101, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

The Commercial Hotel Accommodation Limited has made an application to the District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council for the renewal and variation of the on-licence in respect of the premises situated at 287 Victoria Street, Hamilton, known as Ramada Hotel. The general nature of the business to be conducted under the licence is that of a Hotel. The days on which and the hours during which alcohol is sold under the licence are:

Monday to Sunday: 08:00am – 03:00am the following day

The applicant seeks the following variation to the licence conditions:

Condition (d) being the licensed area. The applicant seeks to increase its licensed area to include the entire hotel premises (restaurant, bar and rooms) under one licence.

The application may be inspected during ordinary office hours at the office of the Hamilton District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council Municipal Building, Garden Place, Hamilton.

Any person who is entitled to object and who wishes to object to the issue of the licence may, not later than 15 working days after the date of the publication of this notice, file a notice in writing of the objection with the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council, Private Bag 3010, Hamilton 3240 in email to Licensing@hcc.govt.nz

No objection to the renewal of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
