Under sections 52 and 53 of the Local Electoral Act 2001, I give notice that on Saturday 8 October 2022 the following elections will be held by postal vote using the Single Transferable Voting electoral system:

#### Mayor

Election of Mayor (elected 'at large')

#### Wards

Election of six councillors for the East General Ward

Election of six councillor for the West General Ward

Election of two councillors for the Kirikiriroa Maaori Ward

#### **NOMINATIONS**

Each candidate must be nominated on the appropriate nomination paper obtainable during normal business hours from Friday 15 July 2022 at:

Nominations of candidates must be in the hands of the electoral officer or an electoral official no later than midday on Friday 12 August 2022.

Each nomination must be accompanied by a deposit of \$200 GST inclusive (payable by bank transfer, eftpos or cash).
