

Public notice - Alcohol licence

Section 101, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Summit Hospitality & Catering Limited has made an application to the District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council for the renewal of an on-licence in respect of the premises situated at 199 Victoria Street Hamilton Central Hamilton 3204, known as Iguana Street Bar & Restaurant. The general nature of the business to be conducted under the licence is that of a Tavern.

No objection to the renewal of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
