Section 101, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Made Mess Hall Limited has made an application to the District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council for the renewal and variation of an on-licence in respect of the premises situated at 401 Grey Street Hamilton East Hamilton 3216, known as Made Mess Hall. The general nature of the business to be conducted under the licence is that of a food hall/restaurant.

No objection to the renewal of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
