

Public notice - Alcohol licence

Section 101, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

JD Distillery Ltd has made an application to the District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council for the renewal of off-licence in respect of the premises situated at 24 Cecil Street St Andrews Hamilton 3200, known as JD Distillery Ltd. The general nature of the business to be conducted under the licence is that of a Remote Sales Premises.

The days on which and the hours during which alcohol is intended to be sold under the licence are as follows:

Remote sales and delivery – Alcohol may be sold at any time of the day, and must not be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1:00pm on Anzac Day, or between 11:00pm and 6:00am the following day.

The applicant seeks the following variation to the licence conditions:

- Removal of condition (e) “The type of alcohol sold is limited to 700ml bottles of the licensees own brand gin priced no less than \$66.66.

The application may be inspected during ordinary office hours at the office of the Hamilton District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council Municipal Building, Garden Place, Hamilton. To request an electronic copy of the application please email licensing@hcc.govt.nz.

Any person who is entitled to object and who wishes to object to the issue of the licence may, not later than 25 working days after the date of the publication of this notice, file a notice in writing of the objection with the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council, Private Bag 3010, Hamilton 3240 in email to Licensing@hcc.govt.nz

No objection to the renewal of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
