## Section 139, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Amy's Flowers Ltd has made an application to the District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council for the renewal and variation of an off-licence in respect of the premises situated at 24 Lincoln Street Frankton Hamilton 3204, known as Amy's Flowers. The general nature of the business to be conducted under the licence is that of a Remote Sales Premises.
