Starts at Central Library
about 1.1km long

- 1 Make your own #TronRock or fairy door at the Central Library Auaha CreatorSpace. This happens every third Wednesday of the month. Fairy doors are made in February, April, June, August, October. Tron Rocks are made in March, May, July, September, November.
- 2 Find your favourite tile on the Peace Wall in Civic Square. Take a picture and share on social media using #HCCPlayTrail.
- 3 How many licks do you think it would take to finish the giant lollypop at the Lolly Shop?
- 4 How high can you jump? See which hand you can give a hi-five on the pole.

- 5 Have a go at playing hopscotch.
- 6 Carefully look inside the planter boxes. Can you find and re-hide any #TronRocks?
- 7 How many colours can you see? Count the all the different colours in the Ward Lane murals.
- 8 Find the blue river of tiles. Can you balance, swim, or paddle along the river? How else can you move?
- 9 How many times does the red person flash when the traffic lights change?
- 10 Give your best performance on the Garden Place stage. Will you do a song, dance, skit, or tell a joke?
- 11 If the Garden Place fountain is going, can you get from one side to the other without getting wet?

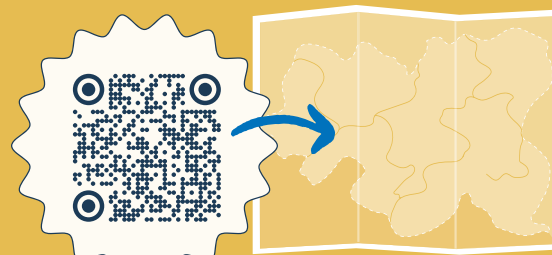

- 1 Can you moon walk along Grantham Street?
- 2 Shhhhhh! Can you find any fairy houses around Ferry Bank?
- 3 Play Follow the Leader along the grey retaining wall steps. Have a go at leading and following.
- 4 Climb onto the (3D printed!) seat and jump off. What's the most fun way to land?
- 5 Pick up a leaf and throw it into the river from the bank by the jetty. Then run! What is faster: the river flow or you?
- 6 Find a hidden spot along the river path. Can you scare the people you're with?

- 7 Find a leaf on the ground. Which tree do you think it came from?
- 8 Play Hide and Seek along the river path.
- 9 Let's race! How long does it take for you to get from one end of the ramp to the other?
- 10 While you wait at the traffic lights, count how long before you get the green light to cross.
- 11 Make up your own tune and play it on the piano outside Trek 'n' Travel.
- 12 Do a silly walk as you travel to the next spot.
- 13 While you wait at the traffic lights to cross the road, put your finger on the blue circle arrow button. What happens when the pedestrian light turns green?
- 14 Pretend to be the fish and you're escaping from the tiger on the wall. Then snap a photo. Now become the tiger - roooooaaaar!
