Like all medicines, Lanacane can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them. On very rare occasions, the use of Lanacane can result in a skin reaction called sensitivity. Sensitivity can be recognised by reddening of the skin, minor swelling, blistering, or the itch and/or irritation becoming more intense. In the unlikely event that you experience these symptoms, **stop using Lanacane and consult your doctor for advice.** If you notice any side effects not listed in this leaflet, please tell your doctor or pharmacist.

If you get any side effects, talk to your doctor, pharmacist or nurse. This includes any possible side effects not listed in this leaflet. You can also report side effects directly via the Yellow Card Scheme at: www.mhra.gov.uk/yellowcard. By reporting side effects you can help provide more information on the safety of this medicine.

Keep out of the sight and reach of children.
Store at room temperature (below 25°C).
Do not use after the expiry date which is stated on the packaging and on the seal of the tube. The expiry date refers to the last day of that month.
Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste.
Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required.
These measure will help to protect the environment.

The other ingredients are: chlorothymol, diethylene glycol monoethyl ether, docusate sodium, perfume (contains citronellol, benzyl benzoate, geraniol, benzyl alcohol, citral, cinnamal, alcohol, linalool and d-limonene), glycerine, glycerol monostearate, isopropyl alcohol, stearic acid, sulfonated castor oil, triethylamine, purified water, zinc oxide.
