**Characters:** Shane, the initial narrator to begin the story, Cindy, the co-worker that is feeling anxious. Sally, the co-worker who listens to Julie vent. Other unnamed co-workers are in the office.

**Color Palette:** There is no specific color palette except for the masked character faces. Shane has a neutral grey background and Sally has a teal background in her mask. Otherwise, all scenes were taken out of the Vyond library. Most scenes focus on the space in the office.

## **Global Comments:**

- There is background music underneath throughout the entire skit except for when she has a panic attack.
- Throughout the skit, the main characters will be using the dialog action to speak to each other or to do the VO.
- Unless stated otherwise, every scene does fade to white. If they are continue scenes, it will be noted if there is a transition, but otherwise there is just a continuation.
