Our self-hosted product offers the same features and functionality of our Software-as-a-Service (SaaS) product. This table compares the All-In-One (AIO) and the Multi-Tier – Commercial (MT – COMM) versions to help you determine which version is right for your cloud deployment.

### Recommendations:

- **MT – COMM:** Best for scalability and larger deployments (\$12M and up for annual in AWS spend max)
- **AIO:** Best for POC and smaller deployments (\$3M - \$5M annual in AWS spend max)
