

## **Support Reflection and Supervision for Rose End of Life Care Volunteers**

## Supervisors' responsibilities:

- To deliver monthly Group supervision for one hour
- To offer optional 121 unburdening sessions as and when required Supervision will be facilitated by either the Rose EOLC Volunteering Project Manager, the End of Life Care Nurse Educator, or trained Chaplains/Pastoral Care Officers
- Brief process notes to kept by the volunteer office as evidence of support
- Start and finish on time
- Confidentiality is assured, unless risk of harm to self or others is suspected

## **Responsibilities of Supervisees:**

- Arrive on time
- Contribute to group discussion
- Maintain confidentiality
- Give and receive feedback
- Listen to others in a non-judgemental manner
- Promote a shared learning environment
