Benefits of Volunteering

- Volunteers reduce pressure on services
- Volunteering brings services closer to the community
- Volunteering is cost effective
- The Long Term Plan sets out the need for well designed volunteering initiatives



This presentation is designed to highlight some of the common challenges in framing your volunteering projects so that systems feel confident investing in them.

What is Your Priority?

Projects need to be seen to be addressing the priorities of systems

- Reducing delayed discharge
- Contributing to population health management
- Reducing health inequalities
- Quality Improvement
- Responding to civil emergencies
- Improving integration helpforce

Considerations

- You don't have a volunteering project, you have a project with a volunteering component
- You must explicitly refer to the priorities in ICS plans
- Your project must link different parts of the system together

Where Does Your Project Exist?

- Is it at system level (ICS)?
- Is it at place level (ICP)?
- Is it at Primary Care level (PCN)?

Different levels of systems will have different priorities. These need to be reflected in your plan.



Integration is Everything

- Do you have partners, from within the system, explicitly referenced?
- Does your project demonstrate how service flow will be more effective?
- Can you demonstrate an understanding of population level needs?



- Difference between outcome and activity
- Can you connect the outcomes to your project? Attribution
- The less data you collect the higher quality it will be
- Evaluation vs business intelligence



- Can you demonstrate how the project will survive beyond the first business case?
- Do you understand how your project can scale?
- Is your service replicable?
- Do you have a plan to report the outcomes?





- Innovation Demonstrate why this is innovative
- Don't focus on what you will do, focus on why
- Remember that value for money is a fundamental element of volunteering
