

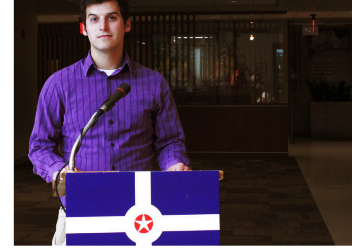


PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Funded by the McKinney Family Foundation, the **Indiana Sustainability Development Program (ISDP)** is a sustainability-focused workforce development program for IU undergraduate and graduate students.

Our aim is to:

- Develop a **statewide network of sustainability professionals** in the corporate, nonprofit, government, and higher education sectors;
- Learn how to best **prepare students for sustainability careers** by listening to industry professionals;
- Train and **place interns in sustainability-focused positions** through partnership development and an intensive boot camp; and
- Build the state of **Indiana's sustainability workforce** capacity by retaining skilled talent through employment and internship opportunities.

- Attend the 3-day Sustainability Boot Camp (May 2019)
- Available to work full-time for 10- 12 weeks between May and August 2019
- Passion and interest to work in the sustainability field after graduation
