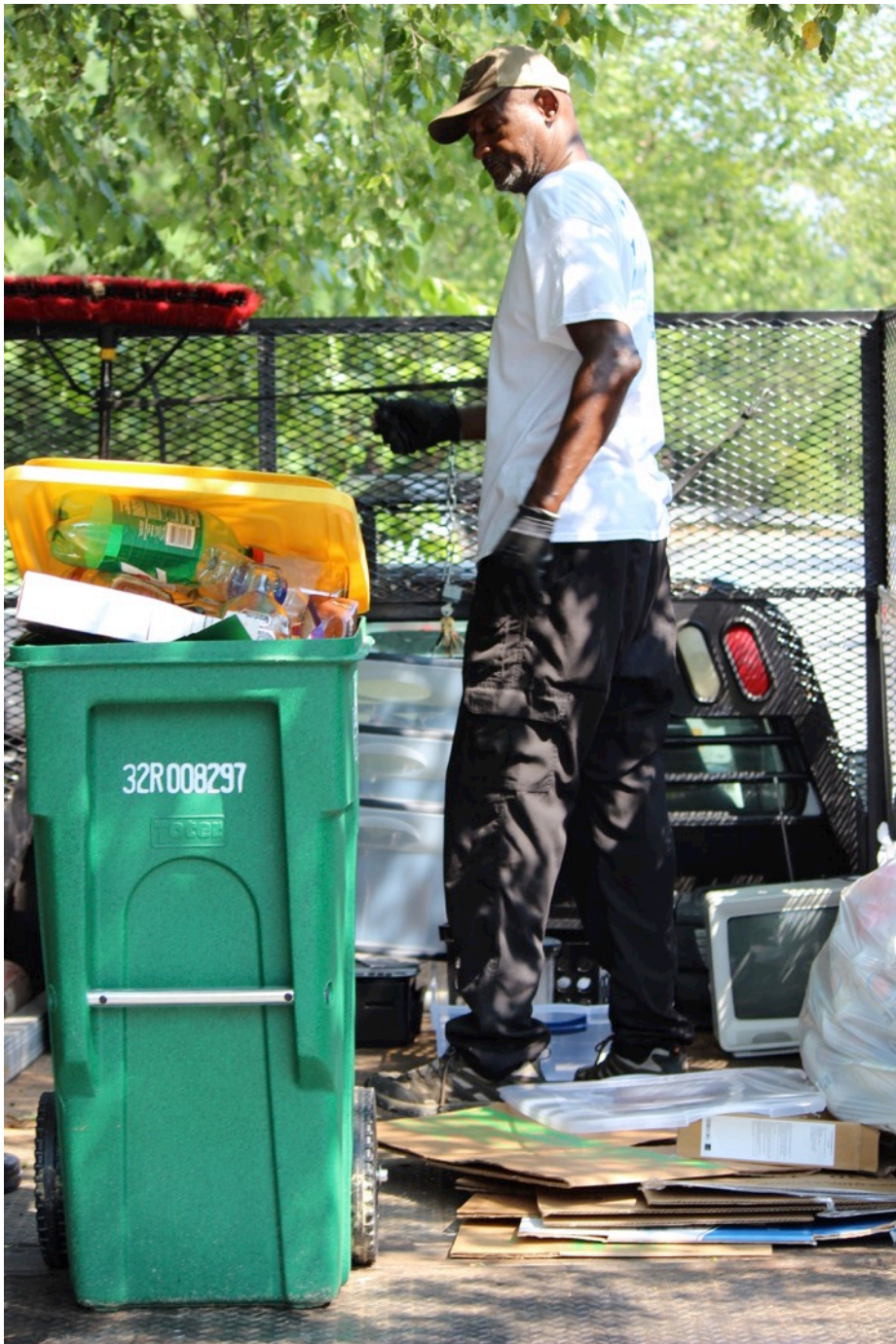

University of Georgia MOVE IN

- 9,696 gallons of Styrofoam and plastic film diverted
- Over 50 volunteers
- Over 100 volunteer hours



Major Challenges

- No set or consistent community move-out date or range
- No set times for moveout from most apartments
- 100+ Apartment Complexes across the county
- Limited staff time and budget (3 staff in Recycling Division)
- Illegal Dumping at drop sites or dumpsters
- Coordination with private haulers
- Students not planning ahead → “I have to move out *today* and just remembered my queen sized bed isn’t going to fit in my Prius”
- Transient community (not just the students)

Goals & Ideas

- Establish guidelines for apartment complex-led diversion events
- Strengthen our volunteer base to deploy volunteers to apartment complexes that need assistance
- Build upon existing partnerships with local thrift organizations, University of Georgia, other ACC Government Entities, and volunteer groups.
- Pull successes from existing community events, such as our Rivers Alive river cleanup volunteer event with our Keep America Beautiful affiliate (Keep Athens-Clarke County Beautiful)
- Metrics for measuring progress and impact
