## **Job Summary**

A Hume Lake Support Services Crew Member prepares rooms, cleans restrooms and areas of camp to Hume standards for guests and staff in a timely manner. He or she must be prepared to meet the spiritual needs of guests and staff.

- Laundry
- Stocking of support services and guest items throughout the various facilities.

- Supervise any weekend and or summer help

- Perform other related duties and assignments as required. Hume maintains the right to reassign or change duties as needed.

### **Physical Demands**
