



# HUME VIRTUAL CAMP

INFORMATIONAL "CHEAT SHEET"

## Hello, Teachers and Administrators!

We are so grateful that you are joining us for our Spring Virtual Camp. We want to make sure that you're prepared for the week, so here's a guide to help you out!

### WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Bible, pen, and notebook!
- Smartphone, computer, or TV!
- A comfy chair, couch, or even a hammock!
- Snacks on snacks on snacks!

### SCHEDULE

You can schedule your use of our Virtual Camp however you want. We want you to use it in a way that makes the most sense for your school and students. There are a total of 5 sessions. Each session has a theme video, a message to go along with the theme video, and small group discussion questions for follow-up breakout sessions. One suggestion might be to set aside time in the school schedule for a daily chapel session and small group discussion time for an entire week, Monday through Friday. Or maybe have the chapel and discussion time once a week for five weeks. Bottom line, we hope this will be a useful tool for your school to use as a spiritual investment and encouragement to your students.

### CHAPEL SESSIONS

What to expect in each 30-minute chapel session:

- Camp Kajabe theme episodes
- 15-minute teachings focused on the Church
- Small group discussion time

### THEME VERSE: EPHESIANS 2:19-22

*"So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit."*

### THEME OVERVIEW:

In the midst of this unique season, our goal with Camp Kajabe is to cultivate a greater affection for, and a greater priority of, the local church. On the surface this theme might just seem like theological pillars of the Church (covenant of redemption, gospel, mission, spiritual gifts, heaven), which in many ways is true. However, our hope is that students will hear of God's love for the Church and God's love for them in the gospel. We pray that this new understanding naturally overflows into passion — a passion to go and proclaim Christ to the corners of the globe, a passion to use their giftings in the Body of Christ, as well as a passion and excitement for the Church's destiny of heaven. We pray the natural outcome is a passion that leads you to proclaim Christ to the corners of the globe, using your gifting in the body of Christ, and an excitement for the Church's destiny of heaven.



## MESSAGE THEMES + DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Whether virtually or in person, our hope is that schools, small groups, and families engage in a time of discussion after each chapel session using the questions below.

### MESSAGE 1: THE BEGINNING OF THE CHURCH

Since before time began, God has had an eternal plan for His Church that He deeply loves.

#### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

What are some misconceptions about the Church? According to God's Word, how did the Church begin? What is the agreement or covenant between God the Father and His Son Jesus? Because God loves His Church, what are we as believers called to do? When it comes to the Church, what are some things you're confused by?

### MESSAGE 2: THE MESSAGE OF THE CHURCH

The message of the Church is the gospel of Jesus Christ and believing in Him by faith alone.

#### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

Why did Jesus have to die for the Church? Describe your understanding of the gospel message. Describe what the idea of "by faith alone" means when it comes to believing in Jesus Christ. Have you given your entire life to Jesus?

### MESSAGE 3: THE POWER OF THE CHURCH

The power of the Church is found in God's Word and God's Spirit.

#### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

What is the power of the Church dependent on? What is the importance of God's Word? What is the role of the Holy Spirit? How do you see the power of God's Word and the Holy Spirit working in your life?

### MESSAGE 4: THE MISSION OF THE CHURCH

The mission of the Church is to make disciples as we proclaim Christ and use our unique gifting by God in the advancement of His kingdom.

#### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

How does God work through His Church? As a member of the Church or Body of Christ, you play a valuable role. How are you using your gifting to accomplish the mission of the Church? Church isn't something you merely attend, but something of which you are a member. How are you being an obedient and active participant in the Church?

### MESSAGE 5: THE DESTINY OF THE CHURCH

The destiny of the Church is heaven where the Body of Christ will forever be united with our Lord Jesus Christ.

#### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

What is the hope of the Church in? Describe your understanding of heaven; what are you confused by? God's ultimate plan for the Church is to be united with Him for all eternity; how does that affect the way you live your life today?



## CAMP KAJABE FILM OVERVIEW
