CANES TAKE ON LEAGUE FAVORITES AGAIN

Miami opens its season with three straight games against teams that were picked to win their respective conferences.

Lehigh was chosen as the preseason favorites in the Patriot League. Stephen F. Austin was picked to repeat as the Southland Conference champion, while Bethune-Cookman was selected as the preseason MEAC favorite.

TUESDAY: MIAMI 96, SFA 58

· Miami scored its most points since a 105-point effort against Mississippi State on Nov. 19, 2015. · Ebuka Izundu recorded his second career doubledouble with 22 points and 19 rebounds. Both totals are career highs, as were his four blocked shots. · Izundu was the first UM player to record at least 15 rebounds in a game since Kamari Murphy had 15

against Duke on Jan. 21, 2017.

- Chris Lykes also scored 20 points, two off his career high, set in the season opener against Lehigh. · Miami posted its largest margin of victory since a 38-point win (94-56) at North Florida on Nov. 16, 2016. · Leading 53-32 at the break, Miami scored its most points in any half dating to a 55-point second half explosion at Virginia Tech on March 10, 2016.
- Anthony Lawrence II played in his 100th career game. Miami did not commit a turnover in the first half. It marked the Canes' first turnover-free half since the first half against Virginia Tech on Feb. 15, 2014. · For the second straight game, five Miami players scored in double figures - Izundu (22), Lykes (20), Lawrence (18), Vasiljevic (17) and Johnson (15).

NOTING IZUNDU'S IMMENSE NIGHT

Ebuka Izundu had a career night against Stephen F. Austin, recording career highs in points (22), rebounds (19), blocks (four) and assists (three). He also tied a career best with three steals.

He played a career-best 32 minutes as well.

He fell one rebound shy of the first 20-rebound performance by a UM player since Reggie Johnson piled up 20 boards on March 16, 2011, against FAU.

LYKES JUMPS OUT TO QUICK START

Chris Lykes picked up where he left off from last season and is off to a strong start with the first two 20-point games of his college career.

He scored 22 in the opener and followed it up with a 20-point effort Tuesday vs. SFA.

He was Miami's leading scorer over the last 12 games of the 2017-18 season, averaging 12.8 points per game while reaching double figures nine times.

Lykes averaged 11.9 points (second on team) and 3.1 assists per game in conference play. He reached double figures in 12 ACC games and 16 total.

BIG SUCCESS AT 70 POINTS

Miami has eclipsed the 70-point plateau in both games this season after going 16-3 in those contests last season.

UM is 107-15 when scoring 70 or more points under Jim Larrañaga and 46-2 when breaking the 80-point barrier.

VASILJEVIC A TOP 3-POINT THREAT

DJ Vasiljevic is off to a strong start, shooting 8-14 (57.1% from 3-point range.

Vasiljevic led the ACC in 3-point field goal percentage last season, connecting on 41.1 percent (67-for-163) of his attempts from long range.

He led the team with 67 3-pointers and became the fifth Hurricane to lead the conference in 3-point shooting (first since Malcolm Grant in 2011).

Vasiljevic hit on 32 of his 66 3-point attempts over the last 13 games (.485) and connected on at least one 3-pointer in each game in that stretch.

Following offseason foot surgery, Vasiljevic lost 20 pounds during the offseason and entered the season at a svelte 184 pounds.

THE WATSCO ADVANTAGE

Miami has defended its home turf well in recent years, winning 40 of its last 45 games at the Watsco Center. The Hurricanes are 90-25 (.783) at home under Jim Larrañaga and finished 11-3 at home last season.

Miami owns 18 straight home non-conference wins, dating to a 78-77 loss to Northeastern on Nov. 27, 2015.

Entering its 17th year at the Watsco Center (formerly BankUnited Center), Miami is 183-69 (.726) on the home court.

In the first seven seasons under Larrañaga, Miami was 44-18 in ACC action at home and 46-7 in nonconference play. In both 2012-13 and 2015-16, the Canes had just one loss at Watsco Center.

MILLER JR. TO REDSHIRT

Miami junior center Rodney Miller Jr. will redshirt the 2018-19 season.

Miller lost 25 pounds during the offseason.

He averaged 1.1 points in 3.6 minutes per game in 30 games during his first two seasons.

WHO'S BACK

Miami returns seven letterwinners from its 2017-18 team: Hernandez, Lawrence, Vasiljevic, Ebuka Izundu, Chris Lykes, Rodney Miller Jr. and Sam Waardenburg.

Miami also gains the services of forward Deng Gak, who redshirted last year during his freshman season.

EXPERIENCED GROUP RETURNS

Miami's roster features seven upperclassmen – three seniors and four juniors.

They have played in a combined 502 games (average of 71 per player), and each has played in at least one NCAA tournament.

WHO'S DEPARTED

Miami lost three players from its 2017-18 squad, each of whom started at least 18 games: Lonnie Walker IV, Bruce Brown Jr. and Ja'Quan Newton.

Walker was an Honorable Mention All-ACC pick and ACC All-Freshman Team honoree last year. He was selected 18th overall in the NBA Draft by the San Antonio Spurs.

Brown started 19 games before missing the remainder of the season with a foot injury. He was picked 42nd overall in the NBA Draft by Detroit.

Newton played in 127 career games (seventh most in program history) and finished with 1,134 career points (28th in program history).

QUINTET OF NEWBIES

Miami added five newcomers to the program, three of whom came through transfers.

Zach Johnson scored 1,344 points in three seasons at Florida Gulf Coast and was a First-Team All-Atlantic Sun Conference selection last season before coming to UM as a graduate transfer.

Anthony Mack sat out last season at Wyoming and has four years of eligibility remaining at UM.

Junior guard Kameron McGusty is sitting out this season after transferring from Oklahoma. He played in 63 games and averaged 9.4 ppg in two years with the Sooners.

Sophomore guards Willie Herenton and Dominic Proctor have joined the program as walk-ons.

NOTING THE SCHEDULE

Miami's schedule features 13 games against teams that played in the 2018 NCAA Tournament.

The non-conference schedule features games against Stephen F. Austin and Penn, each of whom played in the NCAA Tournament last year.

UM travels to the West Coast for the Wooden Classic for three games during Thanksgiving week.

The Canes' challenging conference schedule features 11 games against teams that competed in the 2018 NCAA Tournament, including home-andhomes with Florida State, North Carolina and Virginia Tech.

HUELL BECOMES HERNANDEZ

The name is unfamiliar, but Dewan Hernandez remains a familiar face for the Canes. Formerly Dewan Huell, Hernandez legally changed his last name in the offseason.

The switch was made to honor his mother, Christina Hernandez, and was officially finalized in mid-October.

HERNANDEZ LOOKS TO BUILD ON BREAKOUT SOPHOMORE SEASON

Dewan Hernandez is looking to take another step in his junior season. Last season, Hernandez more than doubled his numbers in scoring and rebounding from his freshman campaign.

Hernandez entered his name in the NBA Draft following the season but withdrew following consultations with NBA officials.

He finished second on the team in scoring at 11.4 ppg (5.6 as frosh) last year and also averaged 6.6 rebounds per game (3.1 as frosh).

He ranked 14th in the conference in rebounding. Hernandez scored in double figures in 19 games last year and recorded the first five double-doubles of his career.

HIGH SCHOOL TEAMMATES REUNITE

With the transfers of Zach Johnson and Anthony Mack, Miami now has two pairs of high school teammates on its roster this season.

Johnson reunites with Dewan Hernandez, with whom he played two seasons and won two state championships at Norland High School.

Mack is back together with Deng Gak, with whom he played two seasons at Blair Academy in New Jersey.

CANES LOOK TO TOP ACC EXPECTATIONS ONCE AGAIN

Miami was picked 10th in the Operation Basketball 2018-19 Preseason Poll, released Oct. 25 following a vote of the league's media.

In each of Jim Larrañaga's first seven seasons, Miami finished the year in a standing that exceeded its preseason ACC ranking.

UM was picked fourth in the preseason ACC coaches' poll last season (behind Duke, UNC, ND) but concluded the season in a third-place tie.

The Miami men's basketball program earned its first perfect GSR rating, coming in 19 percent above the NCAA average of 81 percent.

The GSR measures graduation rates at Division I institutions and includes students transferring into the institutions. The most recent Division I Graduation Success Rates are based on the four entering classes from 2008-09 to 2011-12

TEAM CAPTAINS

Miami has six team co-captains this season: Dewan Hernandez, Ebuka Izundu, Zach Johnson, Anthony Lawrence II, Chris Lykes and DJ Vasiljevic. Hernandez, Lawrence and Vasiljevic are team captains for the second straight season.

SELLING OUT THE WATSCO CENTER

Miami sold out its season ticket allotment for all home games at the Watsco Center for each of the last three seasons.

Fans bought over 5,500 season tickets for each of the last three years, more than doubling the total number of season tickets sold in Jim Larrañaga's first season in Coral Gables.

PROCTOR JOINS ROSTER AS WALK-ON

Dominic Proctor joined the roster recently as a walk-on.

A 6-foot-6 guard, Proctor played at Bishop Gorman High School in Las Vegas, where he won a pair of state championships.

He was the the 14th-ranked player in Nevada in 2017 according to 24/7 Sports and the 103rd-ranked shooting guard in the nation per 24/7.

COACHING COORDINATORS

Miami's assistant coaching staff is set up in a coordinator system. Adam Fisher serves as the team's offensive coordinator, while Chris Caputo handles the defense. Pooh Williamson manages the scout for every opponent.

ANOTHER 20-WIN CAMPAIGN UNDER LARRAÑAGA

Miami recorded 22 wins last season, its sixth 20win campaign in seven years under Jim Larrañaga, and tied for the 10th most wins in a season in school history.

He is the first coach in program history to post six 20-win seasons. Bruce Hale (1954-67) recorded five 20-win campaigns from 1954-67.

SOLID SEASON IN THE ACC

Miami finished with 11 ACC wins last season, its third-most conference wins since joining the league in 2004-05.

UM earned the No. 3 seed in the ACC Tournament after finishing in a four-way tie with Clemson, North Carolina and NC State in the regular-season standings.

Miami scored 10 or more league victories in five of Larrañaga's first seven years, including four straight seasons. The Canes join Virginia, Duke and UNC as the lone teams to win 10 or more ACC games each of the last four years.

Prior to Larrañaga's arrival, Miami never had won 10 ACC games in a season.

DRAFT SUCCESS

For just the third time in program history, Miami had two student-athletes selected in the NBA Draft last season. The others were 1968 and 1970.

Lonnie Walker IV was chosen 18th overall by the San Antonio Spurs.

Bruce Brown Jr. was picked in the second round by Detroit with the 42nd overall pick.

Brown made his NBA debut on Opening Night with a start against Brooklyn. Walker has yet to play because of injury.




