THE FACTS...

The Hurricanes of the University of Miami come into this weekend's road series with a six-match winning streak, five in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC). The Hurricanes are tied atop the league standings after the Duke Blue Devils defeated the Virginia Tech Hokies. There is a log jam atop the standings with Miami, Virginia Tech and Clemson all sharing a similar 7-2 league mark. This weekend's state of Virginia trip will be huge for the Orange and Green.

The Hurricanes lost two of their last three road matches in league play, but are seeking redemption this time around.

After being picked to finish ninth in the ACC Preseason poll, the 'Canes are one of two surprises in the league so far. The other, one of their opponents this weekend, Virginia Tech. The Hokies were picked to finish eighth.

Miami comes into this weekend with no injuries to report, and the 'Canes are really surging after sweeping their five-match home stand to run their home court record to 9-0 on the year. Production has been coming in a variety of areas for the 'Canes, with Lane Carico and Genny Mayhew supplying a brutal "1-2 punch" for UM. At the net, it has been the blocking ability of Angelica Ellis (62 blocks) and Lici McGee (45 blocks) that has been dominant. But added redshirt senior Ashley Woods (43 blocks), and the Hurricanes have been playing good volleyball in a variety of ways.

UM comes into this weekend seeking their first 20-win season since 2003, their last year in the Big East Conference. The Hurricanes went 22-9 that year, and enjoyed back-to-back 20-win campaigns in that stretch, with a 27-6 mark coming in 2002--their only appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

With no ACC Volleyball Tournament, and the regular season champion earning the automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, this weekend's matchups for the 'Canes will be huge. The battle between the eighth and ninth place preseason teams, respectively, could push someone to the top of the pile, at least for a week.

ON VIRGINIA...

The Virginia Cavaliers are just 4-5 in the league (12-9 overall), but did capture their first ACC home win last week in an upset of against Wake Forest. The Cavaliers are 4-3 overall at home, and are led by a number of players on the court. Among them is Lauren Dickson with 234 kills and a team-best 26 service aces. She also has a team second-best 254 digs and 36 blocks. Behind her is Shannon Davis with 164 kills and a team second-best 73 blocks (70 assisted). The setter for the Cavaliers is Marlow Bruneau with 499 assists, while teammate Kelli Irvin (257 assists) will see plenty of action as well. The libero is Brittani Rendina with 324 digs to her credit.

ON VIRGINIA TECH...

Despite being picked to finish eighth in the ACC Preseason poll, the Hokies of Virginia Tech are tied atop the league standings just before the midway point of the ACC campaign. The Hokies are 16-4 overall, 7-2 ACC. They just lost their first home ACC match of the year last weekend to Duke, but are still on a tremendous ride. The Hokies are paced by Felicia Willoughby with 201 kills, and Justine Record is right behind her with 174 kills. Overall, the Hokies have five players with 100-plus kills. Also helping out with the blocks are Willoughby with a team-leading 79 (65 assists), while Betsy Horowitz sits with 57 (50 assists). The defense is led by Jill Gergen's 267 digs, and setter Erin Leaser has 678 assists.

Head Coach ... Nicole Lantagne Welch



Nicole Lantagne Welch enters her eighth season at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in five of the last seven seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

In the 2006 season-opener, Lantagne Welch recorded her 100th career win with a 3-2 victory over Alabama. In 2007, UM finished 14-17 overall and 8-14 in ACC play, pushing Lantagne Welch's career

record to 125-81 overall in seven seasons as a head coach, all at Miami.

Her career at UM is highlighted by two consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins (2003 & 2004) and a trip to the Sweet 16 in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her seven seasons at the helm, the Hurricanes have averaged 17.8 wins per season.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. As a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered first-team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and 1993, and earned second-team honors in 1991. She was also named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

As team captain her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career at Maryland, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

Under Lantagne Welch's training, Aggie setter Jenna Moscovic was named the 1999 Big 12 Conference Freshman of the Year and named to the All-American Freshman Team by Volleyball Magazine. As a sophomore, Moscovic was selected to the 2000 All-Big 12 Team and All-District 5 Team. Lantagne Welch also played a major role in bringing the Aggies back-to-back Top 10 recruiting classes. The 1999 class was ranked in the Top 10 by Student Sports Magazine and the 1998 class was ranked sixth by Volleyball Magazine.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7th, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

HURRICANES VB MEDIA POLICY**KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX**

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Information Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

INTERVIEWS

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

for the University of Miami. That is also followed by a pair of matches on ACC Select sponsored through the Atlantic Coast Conference. The matches to be shown on ACC Select include home stands against Duke (Oct. 31) and a match at home against Clemson (Nov. 16).

MIAMI VS. UVA SERIES...

The series with Miami and UVA has belonged to the Cavaliers, holding a slight 5-3 advantage since UM joined the ACC. The 'Canes and Cavaliers split last year, with the road teams winning both contests. However, UVA has won four of the last five meetings.

MIAMI VS. VIRGINIA TECH SERIES...

The 'Canes lead this series with the Hokies of Virginia Tech, 8-3, dating back to their days in the Big East Conference. Since joining the ACC, Miami has won five-of-seven matches against the Hokies, including a streak of three-straight matches.

CARICO NAMED ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Freshman outside hitter Lane Carico picked up her second ACC Player of the Week honor this week as she became the first player in the league this year to grab the honors twice. On the week, Carico registered 30 kills on 75 swings for a hitting percentage of .347 (30-4-75). She also picked up four assists and 28 digs with an assisted block.

On Friday night, Carico recorded 12 kills in UM's 3-0 sweep over N.C. State. She hit .273 in the tilt with seven digs as well. On Saturday, she posted her 10th double-double of the season with an 18-kill, 21-dig performance in the 'Canes 3-1 win over the Tar Heels. Her 18 kills rank second amongst four set matches and mark the sixth time this season she has hit for more than 15 kills.

Carico averaged .405 in the match, making only one error in 42 attempts. The 21 digs in the North Carolina match are a season high for her in that category.

ON THESE DATES IN HISTORY...

On the upcoming dates (Oct. 24 and 25) for the Miami Hurricanes, UM is a whopping 10-3-1 all-time, including a win over Virginia Tech back on Oct. 24, 2004 in Coral Gables. The most matches played throughout the course of these two dates occurred back in 1980 when UM took part in the Jacksonville Tournament in Jacksonville, Fla. The 'Canes played nine matches during that two-day stretch, collecting a record of 7-1-1.

WIN TOTAL SURPASSED; WINNING SEASON ASSURED...

The Hurricanes assured themselves a winning season and have the best record they've enjoyed since joining the ACC in 2004. Currently holding a 19-2 overall mark, the Orange and Green are just one win away from a 20-win season, which would be their first since 2003. The 'Canes won just 14 matches in 2007, and just 12 in 2006. They had a 17-9 performance in 2004, and collected a 16-14 record in 2005.

MIAMI RECEIVING OTHER VOTES...

With their impressive 19-2 record so far, the Hurricanes have yet to crack the AVCA Top 25, but have received other votes in all but one poll this year. The 'Canes received eight votes to try and break into the national ranking for the first time since 2002 this week, but still sit behind eight teams, and are tied with six others, for the honor.

SHUTTING THE DOOR...

Miami has shutout 10 opponents this season in their first 21 matches. Last year, the Hurricanes managed eight shutouts in 2007 altogether. The 2006 class had just four and 2005 with six. The most shutouts for the Hurricanes since joining the ACC is 11 back in 2004--their first season in the league. The most under head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch is 17 back in 2002, the last year UM made it to the NCAA Tournament.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS...

Miami is 9-0 on the year at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, and they are

currently riding a 12-match home winning streak dating back to last year. The Hurricanes are hitting a solid ENTER HERE at home, and own five shutouts at home.

SPOTLIGHT ON THE STATS...

Miami is currently ranked 13th as a team in service aces per set (1.82) nationally. Grambling State university leads the nation in that category (2.64). The 'Canes are also ranked 28th in digs per set (16.34), 26th in hitting percentage (.262) and 36th in kills per set (13.77). They are seventh in win-loss percentage, sitting at .905 (19-2) beside Army. Individually, the 'Canes has a player ranked nationally as well with Cassie Loessberg ranked 35th in digs per set (4.81).

TRACKING LOESSBERG AND THE DIGS...

Junior libero Cassie Loessberg continues to jump up the charts this season as she now has 351 digs on the campaign, upping her career total to 1,221. The Sacramento, Calif. junior is just 400 digs behind the all-time leader, Jamie Grass (2001-04) for the top place in school history.

MAYHEW NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-ACC TEAM...

Junior outside hitter Genny Mayhew was named to the Preseason All-ACC Team as voted on by head coaches around the Atlantic Coast Conference. Mayhew, a 5-foot-11 junior from Clovis, Calif. (Clovis HS), finished ninth in the conference in both kills (428) and points (465) a year ago. She also finished fourth on the squad in digs (224) and tied for fifth in blocks (43) alongside teammate Ariell Cooke while playing in 111 games for the 'Canes.

CLEMSON PREDICTED TO WIN ACC ... AGAIN...

After finishing atop the league last season, the Clemson Tigers have been predicted to repeat as conference champs after collecting 11 of a possible 12 first place votes. Georgia Tech received the other first place vote while being predicted to finish second. Duke and North Carolina were third and fourth, while Florida State and Virginia tied for fifth, respectively.
