2017-18 FAMU Men's Basketball Preview Rattler Hoops under new leadership

The Florida A&M University Men's Basketball program heads into the coming 2017-18 season under new leadership, as veteran coach Robert McCullum will lead the Rattlers into one of the more challenging campaigns during his first season.

FAMU, which posted a 7-21 mark a year ago, has high hopes for the coming season, aiming for their first Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference title since 2007.

Coach McCullum, who won 84 games in seven seasons during head coaching stints at Western Michigan and USF, comes to FAMU after a Final Four run as a member of the coaching staff at the University of Oregon.

His extensive resume of work includes international experience, as well as a plethora of NCAA Tournament experience, making him the ideal man to lead the Rattler program out of the Division One doldrums to a competitive place among the mid major elites.

Joining him in his **Rattler Basketball Renaissance movement** will be assistants **Carlos Biggs** (Baylor, '93), **Jarrett Stephens** (Lemoyne Owen, 2000), and **Patrick Benson** (Oregon, 2017).

Players returning to lead the Rattlers' bid for the 2018 Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference title, will be two Preseason All-MEAC Men's Basketball All-Stars, senior forward **Desmond Williams**, and senior wing player **Marcus Barham**.

Williams, a 6-6, 205-pound native of Atmore, Ala., was an All-MEAC selection last season after averaging 16.2 points and 6.1 rebounds per game. He shot 48.3 percent from the floor, finishing with 44 assists, 35 blocked shots and 29 steals.

Barham, a 6-5, 185-pound sharpshooting wing from Melbourne, Fla., returns after averaging 12.6 points per game, shooting 37.8 percent (68 of 180) from distance. He also had 49 assists, 33 steals, 14 blocked shots, while averaging 3.6 rebounds per game.

FAMU also has a trio of veteran backcourt aces returning, headed by junior three-point gunner **Justin Ravenel**, a 6-1, 175-pound product from Lithonia, Georgia, who shot a nifty 40.1 percent from distance (55 of 137), averaging 9.8 points per game and 2.4 boards per outing, with a superb 86.4 percent showing from the foul line; senior point guard **Elijah Mayes**, a 6-0, 175 pounder from Orlando, who scored at a 6.1 per game clip, averaged 2.2 rebounds, to go with 90 assists and 27 steals; and versatile senior guard **Craig Bowman** (St. Petersburg, Fla.), a 6-4, 180 pound performer, who averaged 5.9 points, while shooting 28.1 percent from beyond the arc in 19 games.

Also back for the Rattlers are 6-8, 185-pound junior forward **Nick Severado** from Savannah, Ga., talented point guard **Nasir Core,** a 6-2, 205-pound Tampa, Fla., product, **Brendon Myles,** a 6-4, 195 guard from Atlanta, Ga.,

The cast of newcomers joining the Rattler fold this season includes freshmen like **Kamron Reaves**, a 6-1, 172 guard from Champaign, Ill., and **Bryce Moragne**, a 6-5, 195 guard from Tampa, Fla.; sophomores **John Clayton**, a 6-5, 215-pound wing player Lithonia, Ga., and **Rashad Austin**, a 6-8, 220 forward from Tampa, Fla.,, and junior college transfers **Javonni Harrell**, a 6-7, 205 forward from Chicago, Ill., and 7-0, 210 center **Isaish Martin** from Denver, Colo.

Two future Rattlers redshirting due to transfer rules are 6-10, 245-pound post player **Ifyeani Umezurike** from Lagos, Nigeria, and 6-9, 195-pound forward **D.J. Jones** from Brusly, La.

The 2017-18 schedule features 17 non-conference games in November and December, featuring collegiate heavyweights Texas, Miami (Fla.), Mississippi State, UNLV, Murray State, and Georgia Tech.

FAMU opens the season at home on Monday, November 6 against Johnson University (7:00 p.m.) in the Al Lawson Center, and opens their 14-game preconference road slate on November 10 at Grand Canyon (Ariz.) University.

MEAC play begins at home this season, as the Rattlers host the Howard University Bison, on Wednesday, January 3 (8:00 p.m.).

ROBERT McCULLUM

Head Men's Basketball Coach

Birmingham Southern, 1976 * First Season At Florida A&M

A seasoned veteran with an impressive résuméspanning more than 30 years, McCullum comes to FAMU after spending the last three seasons at Oregon, which made its first trip to the Final Four in 78 years this past April.

McCullum's career, which is highlighted by head coaching assignments at Western Michigan and the University of South Florida, has been defined by the successful total development of his student-athletes in the classroom and on the court.

Milton Overton Jr., FAMU's Director of Athletics, says he's excited about the possibilities for Rattler basketball under McCullum's leadership.

"Coach McCullum has a successful history of recruiting Final Four-level talent in two of the states important to FAMU's Basketball success – Georgia and Florida.," Overton said. "McCullum's international connections will allow FAMU to expand its recruiting base globally and provide professional basketball opportunities for our exiting players."

He added, "McCullum has also demonstrated success winning in a low resource mid-level college conference while graduating players and raising money for his program. Coach McCullum has a proven ability to develop players to reach their full basketball and academic potential. These key attributes make him the best fit and right man to lead the FAMU men's basketball program."

McCullum outlined his plan to get the team back to championship caliber.

"First and foremost my job, as I see it, is to help each student-athlete become a well-rounded graduate of FAMU, prepared for the challenges of the 21st-century," he said. "We will play extremely hard, and with a level of toughness that our opponents will always know they're in for a fight. Simply put, I want to be known as the 'Fighting



Rattlers."

He added that in addition to focusing on rebounding the ball, which is "near and dear" to his heart, attacking offensively with three-pointers, and being physical inside, he wants to develop a culture of fun with the team

"On the court we want to be fun to watch – it's extremely important that the coaching staff emphasize the importance of our players having fun," McCullum said. "Our job is to be good teachers. The best teachers in any discipline make

learning fun for their students."

At both Western Michigan and South Florida, he implemented class attendance policies and procedures that resulted in dramatic improvements in academic performance, earning both schools recognition on the conference level for highest team GPA and individual academic achievement.

In seven seasons as a head coach, 18 of the 23 players he recruited into his programs finished their eligibility and graduated within five years. During his career, he developed more than a dozen players who advanced to the NBA, including a number of first and second round draft picks.

FAMU Interim President Larry Robinson, Ph.D., said he welcomes the wealth of knowledge and experience that McCollum brings to FAMU.

"I commend Athletic Director Overton for working to bring this search to a close and identify a new coach for our basketball program. We look forward to Coach McCullum providing the type of support needed to create a winning program in and out of the classroom that our students, fans and supporters deserve," Robinson said.

While at Western Michigan (2000-03), McCullum built the Broncos program into one of

the best in the Mid-American Conference (MAC) during his three seasons (2000-03), leading them to 20 wins and aNational Invitational Tournament berth in 2003.

From there, he served as the head coach at South Florida (2003-07), overseeing the Bulls' transition from Conference USA to the Big East.

His résumé also includes a second Final Four appearance (1994), where he played a vital role in the recruitment and development of student-athletes at the University of Florida as an assistant on Lon Kruger's staff.

McCullum's association with Kruger began when he joined the staff at Kansas State (1989-90), where the school made a NCAA Tournament appearance in 1990, continuing at Florida (1990-96), where the Gators made two NCAA appearances, including a run to the Final Four in 1994, and at Illinois (1996-2000), which won a Big Ten title and played in the NCAA Tournament three times.

McCullum has had an international impact on the game, serving as the Nigerian National Team head coach in 2007, which posted a 5-1 record at the All-Africa Games.

In addition to his time as Nigeria's head coach, he was an assistant for the Forshan Long Lions of the Chinese Basketball Association (2011-12), directed the first professional player camp in Russia from 2012-13 (Revolution Basketball Camp in Kazan) and was the director of the NBA's "Train the Trainer" program in Johannesburg, South Africa.

His coaching history also includes stops at San Francisco (2007-08), Central Florida (2009-10) and Georgia Tech (2010-11).

The new FAMU coach also served two stints as an assistant at South Alabama (1982-83 and 1984-

87) and one year at Samford (1983-84). He moved on to Southern Illinois from 1987-89, where he helped the Salukis achieve a 20-win season and the school's first post-season bid in 11 years.

McCULLUM PERSONAL: The Birmingham, Alabama native earned his bachelor's degree at Birmingham Southern College in 1976 and his master's degree from Alabama State in 1980.

He played two seasons at Seminole Community College in Sanford, Florida, where he was the team captain as a sophomore and earned his associate's degree there in 1974.

He and his wife Cheryl have two children, Richelle and Rashid.

Road Warrior Tour Continues Thursday: The Rattler Men's Basketball team heads south and west this week for a two-game set as part of their 17-game non-conference schedule for November and December... Thursday, the Rattlers face off against the Miami Hurricanes in Coral Gables (7:00), then Saturday, they take on the Mississippi State Bulldogs in Starkville (4:00 ET)....

Desmond Williams Off To The Races: Senior forward Desmond Williams is off to a hot starting scoring wise, as the Atmore, Alabama native is averaging 18.0 points per game, following Saturday's 21-point effort at UNLV... Williams is also the number two rebounder at 7.5 per game, and is auditioning for the next Ironman saga, averaging 38 minutes per game... Williams is the first FAMU player who was the leading scorer the previous season to return, as the two previous top scorers transferred while the Rattlers were under

APR sanctions.

Isaiah Martin Did It In Vegas: What happened in Vegas Saturday night won't stay in Vegas, after the singular performance jUCO transfer Isaiah Martin put on... The 7-0 center had 20 points on 8-of-10 shooting, with 10 rebounds, two blocks and three assists, facing off against UNLV's projected Lottery pick, Brandon McCoy, who finished with 25 points, 18 boards and a pair of blocks.... Martin is giving the Rattlers the inside presence they have lacked for several years...

Barham Doing It From Distance: Senior Marcus Barham, one of the two Preseason All-MEAC selections from FAMU (Desmond Williams is the other), has knocked down four three-pointers so far (13 tries) for a .308 percentage... Barham and junior Justin Ravenel were both above 36-37% from distance a year ago, and the hope is they will both find the range again this season...

Rattlers Rebuilding Under McCullum: First-year head coach Robert McCullum can certainly tell anyone first hand what swift change is like... Just last April, he was a part of the Oregon staff that led the Ducks to the NCAA title game... Six weeks or so later, he was accepting the FAMU post, taking over a program that had recorded 17 wins in the previous three seasons, and had not had a winning campaign since 2006-07... The veteran coach has been a part of rebuilding programs at Western Michigan and USF, as well as several national title winners including Florida... FAMU is confident that wide range of experience will be the catalyst for a Rattler Hoops Revival.

Newcomers Showing Flashes: Isaiah Martin is just one of the fresh faces Coach McCullum imported into the Orange and Green regime over the summer... Freshman Kamron Reaves, who is averaging 8.0 points per game and 4.0 rebounds, has been pleasant surprise, but FAMU is expecting better performances as the season wears on....
