• With the win over Maryland, Clemson reached nine ACC wins for only the ninth time in 61 seasons as a conference member.

• Clemson looks to break Miami's three-game winning streak in the series; last season, the eventual ACC Champion Hurricanes escaped Littlejohn Coliseum with a 45-43 victory.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson's last win over Miami came in 2010-11; his Tigers swept the Hurricanes that season, winning 79-72 at home and 63-59 in Coral Gables.
- The Tigers are playing their second game in a two-day span, the third time this ACC regular season Clemson has played on one day's preparation.
- The two head coaches, Brownell and Miami's Jim Larrañaga, are old rivals from their days in the Colonial Athletic Association. Brownell coached UNC Wilmington to a pair of CAA titles, while Larrañaga is well known for taking his 2006 George Mason team to the Final Four.
- Clemson is in search of its 10th ACC win Tuesday, a feat that has been accomplished only three times in 61 seasons by the Tiger program.
- K.J. McDaniels posted his fifth "20 & 10" game of the season against Maryland, most by an ACC player this season and most by a Tiger since Sharrod Ford also had five as a senior in 2004-05.
- McDaniels needs 21 to become the 14th player in Clemson history to score at least 500 in a single season. K.C. Rivers (2007-08) was the last to do it.

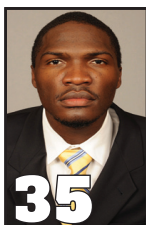

HEAD COACH BRAD BROWNELL

- Named the 21st men's basketball head coach in Clemson history on April 13, 2010.
- Is coaching his 12th season in Division I, having previously coached four years each at UNC Wilmington and Wright State.
- Set Clemson records for total wins (22) and ACC wins (9) by a first-year head coach in 2010-11.
- Led Clemson to first NCAA Tournament win in 14 years when the Tigers topped UAB in the first round in 2011.
- All 11 of his teams have ranked in the top 50 of the NCAA in scoring defense, including his first team at Clemson that led the ACC and was 24th nationally in scoring defense (61.4). Clemson's 2012-13 scoring defense (60.1) was the program's best since 1950.
- Has taken three different teams to NCAA Tournaments, one of only a few select coaches in the country to accomplish the feat.
- Took the UNC Wilmington program to a school-record 25 wins in his final season with the school, 2005-06.
- Named Colonial Athletic Association Coach of the Year in 2003 and 2006. He coached CAA Player of the Year Brett Blizzard in 2002-03, his first season as a Division I head coach.
- Took over Wright State in 2006-07 and guided the school to a record 23 wins in his first season and an NCAA Tournament bid.
- Named NABC District 10 Coach of the Year in 2007 and Horizon League Coach of the Year in 2008.
- Began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Evansville in 1991-92, helping that program to an NCAA berth.
- Served as an assistant coach to Jerry Wainwright at UNC Wilmington from 1994-2002.
- Played Division III ball at DePauw University in Greencastle, IN.
- He and his wife, Paula, have two daughters, Abby (16) and Kate (13).

TIGER TRACKS

LAST TIME THEY MET

- Miami clinched its first ACC title on March 9, 2013 with a 62-49 victory over Clemson in the final regular season game for both.
- The win gave the Hurricanes a sweep over the Tigers, their first since the 2005-06 season.
- Miami shot 43 percent from three and owned the boards, with a +14 rebound margin.
- Miami started all five of its seniors on Senior Day, with Kenny Kadji leading the way with 23 points and 12 rebounds.
- Jordan Roper (12) and Devin Booker (11) led the Tigers.

TIGERS TOOK ACC CHAMPS TO THE WIRE AT HOME LAST SEASON

- In one of Miami's most difficult wins, the eventual ACC Champion Hurricanes survived a scare from Clemson on Feb. 17, 2013.
- Freshman guard Jordan Roper willed Clemson in the game, scoring a career-high 19 points on 8-of-11 shooting while adding four steals.
- In one of the lowest scoring games in Littlejohn history (45-43), neither team shot 35 percent from the floor or 25 percent from three.

CLEMSON 5-2 AT HOME AGAINST MIAMI ALL-TIME

- Prior to last season's home loss, Clemson had racked up four straight wins in Littlejohn Coliseum over Miami. Clemson won the first meeting in the facility, 75-55 in 1994-95. The Hurricanes won the first meeting in Clemson as ACC foes, 83-77 in 2004-05.
- During Clemson's four-game win streak that spanned 2007 to 2011, all four were decided by 10 points or less.

BROWNELL, LARRAÑAGA OLD COACHING RIVALS

- Clemson's Brad Brownell and Miami's Jim Larrañaga have faced off 13 times on opposite benches, dating to their time heading up a pair of programs in the Colonial Athletic Association.
- Larrañaga had a 6-4 advantage as George Mason's coach, when Brownell was at UNC Wilmington. In 2005-06, both coaches had their teams at 15-3 in the regular season. But UNC Wilmington won the CAA Tournament to earn the automatic NCAA Tournament bid.
- The three meetings between the two as ACC rivals have been close games. In 2011-12, Larrañaga's team was victorious 76-73. Last season, his squad won by two at Clemson and by 13 in Coral Gables after a valiant effort by Brownell's overmatched team.

GAME NOTES & MISCELLANEOUS STATISTICS

TIGERS TRYING TO BECOME 4TH CLEMSON TEAM TO WIN 10 ACC GAMES

- In 61 seasons as a member of the Atlantic Coast Conference, Clemson's program has achieved 10 or more ACC wins three times: 1986-87, 1989-90 and 2007-08.
- Tuesday, Clemson's team has a chance to become just the fourth to win at least 10 ACC games in a season. The Tigers were just 5-13 in league play last season.
- In each of the three previous 10-win ACC seasons, Clemson won at least 24 games overall.

TIGERS HAVE IMPROVED ACC RECORD BY FOUR WINS...SO FAR

- Clemson won just five ACC games last season, and is already up to nine with two regular season games remaining this season.
- The biggest improvement in terms of conference wins from one season to the next was 1986-87, when Horace Grant led the Tigers to a 10-4 record after recording just three ACC wins the year before.
- Prior to the ACC, Clemson was a member of the Southern Conference. The Tigers' biggest jump from one season to the next was +5 from a 3-7 mark in 1936-37 to 8-4 in 1937-38.

CARDIAC CATS?

- Clemson has overcome a halftime deficit to win five times, including its most recent game at Georgia Tech on Feb. 22.
- The Tigers have rallied after trailing at the half against Temple, Duke, Florida State and NC State as well.
- The last time Clemson overcame five or more halftime deficits to win in the same season was 2007-08, when the Tigers did it five times.
- The record for halftime rallies for a season was six in 1989-90.

TIGERS SWEEP GEORGIA TECH A FOURTH CONSECUTIVE YEAR

- Clemson achieved its 11th regular season sweep over Georgia Tech with a 63-55 victory on Feb. 22. It gave the Tiger program one sweep shy of the school record over another ACC foe, Virginia.
- The Tigers have swept the Yellow Jackets each of the last four regular seasons under Head Coach Brad Brownell, who is a perfect 8-0 against the Yellow Jackets.
- Clemson has swept Georgia Tech, Miami and Wake Forest under Brownell.

TIGERS BEAT NO. 13 DUKE

- Clemson locked in defensively in the second half and overcame what was a 10-point deficit at one point to rally for a 72-59 win over No. 16/13 Duke on Jan. 11.
- The win was Clemson's first over the Blue Devils since the monumental 74-47 defeat on Littlejohn on Feb. 4, 2009. Duke had won five straight in the series coming into the game.

THREE DOUBLE-DOUBLES IN THE SAME GAME

- Clemson had three players post a double-double in the win over Duke, a feat that had not been accomplished since 1985.
- The last time a Clemson team had three double-doubles in the same game, it was achieved by

Horace Grant, Vincent Hamilton and Raymond Jones in an ACC game against Wake Forest.

- The double-doubles were recorded by K.J. McDaniels (24p, 10r), Jaron Blossomgame (14p, 14r) and Landry Nnoko (10p, 13r).

BROWNELL ESTABLISHES A CLEMSON FIRST

- Brad Brownell is the first Clemson coach to guide the Tigers to at least eight ACC wins in three of his first four seasons.
- His first season, Brownell's team went 9-7 in league play and finished in a tie for fourth. In 2011-12, his team finished .500 with an 8-8 conference record.
- Bobby Roberts came the closest by guiding a pair of eight-win ACC teams in two of his first four seasons at Clemson between 1962-66.

CLEMSON WINS 500TH GAME IN LITTLEJOHN VS. GEORGIA TECH

- The Tiger program achieved its 500th win in the history of Littlejohn Coliseum on Tuesday, Feb. 4, a 45-41 win over Georgia Tech.
- Coincidentally, the first win for Clemson in the arena also came against Georgia Tech. It was 76-72, also a four-point margin.
- The Clemson program has compiled a 501-185 (.730) record in the arena's 46th year of operation.

TIGERS WIN NINTH STRAIGHT OVER GEORGIA TECH

- Clemson upped its winning streak in the series against Georgia Tech to nine games with the Feb. 22 road win over the Yellow Jackets. It is the longest such streak for the Tigers against another ACC team since an 11-game streak over Virginia from 1960-65.
- The win streak started in 2009-10 on Trevor Booker's Senior Day at Littlejohn Coliseum. Clemson

won 91-80 behind a big game from its first-team All-ACC forward.

- The streak is the second-longest in school history.

TIGERS WIN FOURTH STRAIGHT AT GEORGIA TECH

- Clemson has won each of its last four ACC road games played at Georgia Tech, the second-longest road winning streak for the Tigers over another league school.
- The only streak longer was a five-game winning streak over Virginia in Charlottesville from 1960-65.
- Clemson has won three straight on an ACC opponent's home court just seven times in its history.

- During the four-game win streak in Atlanta, the Tigers have held Tech to an average of just 50.3 points per game.

CLEMSON EARNS ITS LONGEST ACC HOME WINNING STREAK

- When the Tigers defeated Georgia Tech 45-41 on Feb. 4, it was their ninth straight win at home over the Yellow Jackets.
- It is the longest home winning streak in Clemson history, breaking the previous record of eight in a row over Virginia from 1959-66.

CLEMSON EARNING HIGH MARKS IN THE ACC STATISTICAL RANKINGS

- Clemson is atop three important categories as a team in the latest statistical rankings released by the ACC.
- The Tigers are No. 1 in three-point percentage defense (.279) and blocks per game (5.9).
- Clemson has never led the ACC in free throw accuracy in 60 previous seasons as a league member. The school record is .734, set in 1981-82. But Clemson is currently No. 2 in the league at .734, slightly behind Boston College for the top spot.
- Clemson's blocks per game average is on pace to be the best by a Tiger team since the 1989-90 squad featuring Elden Campbell and Dale Davis.
- Clemson is also second in scoring defense (56.8) and third in field goal percentage defense (.390). The Tigers' scoring D is on pace to be the program's best in the ACC era (61 seasons).

THREE-POINT DEFENSE ON PACE TO BREAK SCHOOL RECORD

- Clemson's three-point percentage defense not only leads the ACC with two regular season games remaining, it is on pace to establish a school record for the course of a single season.
- The previous best was a .294 figure, set in Oliver Purnell's last season, 2009-10. Clemson is currently sitting on a .279 mark this season.

CRUNCH TIME NUMBERS

- Clemson won its fourth ACC game decided by five points or less on March 2 in double overtime against Maryland, 77-73.
- The Tigers are 4-3 this conference season in games decided by five or less, the most wins under that scenario since the 2006-07 team was 4-6.
- Since 1990, the 2006-07 and 2013-14 teams are the only Clemson groups to win at least four ACC games decided by five points or less.

TIGERS EIGHT SPOTS HIGHER THAN PREDICTED ACC FINISH

- With two games left, Clemson finds itself sixth in the ACC standings, eight positions higher than the predicted order of finish by the league media.
- Clemson's eight-spot improvement is the highest in the ACC, and the next-best jump is only three spots by Virginia (fourth to first).

GAME NOTES

CLEMSON HAS JUMPED 116 SPOTS IN RPI

- Last season, Clemson was 13-18 overall and 5-13 in the ACC. The Tigers were 187th in the final RPI released by the NCAA.
- This season, Clemson is up to 18-10 and 9-7 in league play. The Tigers are No. 71 in the latest RPI, a jump of 116 spots from 2013.
- Clemson's jump is the largest by an ACC team from the end of 2012-13 to now. Virginia is second among league foes with a jump of 73 places to a current standing of No. 10.
- The biggest mover in terms of RPI from last season to now is SMU, who checked in 41st in Monday's RPI release. The Mustangs were 213th in the final ratings last season, a jump of 172 spots.
- Clemson's 116-spot improvement is the largest by a team from one of the BCS equivalent conferences (ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, Big East, Pac-12 and SEC). Texas is second with a 97-spot jump from last season to now.

SATURDAY, IN THE PARK

- Clemson is 5-1 this ACC season when playing Saturday afternoon games. The only loss came to No. 17/16 Virginia in a tight game on Feb. 15.
- The Tigers have achieved wins over Boston College, Duke, Wake Forest, Florida State and Georgia Tech in Saturday games that have started between noon and 4 p.m.
- K.J. McDaniels has been exceptional in Saturday afternoon ACC contests, averaging 20.2 points per game to lead all Tigers.

TIGERS LIVING ON #SCTOP10 THIS SEASON

- Clemson has made five appearances this season on the popular "Top Plays" segment as part of ESPN's SportsCenter.
- K.J. McDaniels has been involved in all five plays, starting with his follow dunk against Delaware State on Nov. 13. He also has appeared on the #SCTop10 countdown with follow dunks against Auburn, Duke and NC State.
- At Virginia Tech, his blocked shot led to a fastbreak jam by Jordan Roper that landed at the No. 5 spot the morning after the Virginia Tech game.
- McDaniels provided the No. 1 play last season at home against Wake Forest when he followed a Devin Booker miss with a dunk and landed on the head of a Demon Deacon.

ROLLINS NAMED CLEMSON'S ACC LEGEND

- Legendary Tiger center Tree Rollins has been named Clemson's ACC Legend in conjunction with the conference tournament this March.
- The 7-footer started all 110 games of his career and owns two of the four triple-doubles in Clemson history.
- He is Clemson's career leader in both rebounds (1,311) and blocked shots (450), ranking in the top five in ACC history in both categories.
- Rollins went on to play 18 seasons in the NBA for five different teams.

McDANIELS A FIVE-TOOL TALENT

- K.J. McDaniels is the ONLY player in the country leading his team in these five categories: scoring, rebounding, blocks, steals and three-point goals.
- The closest category is three-pointers, where he leads teammate Damarcus

- Stephen Madison of Idaho leads his team in scoring, rebounds, blocks and steals, but is a distant third on the Vandal team in three-pointers.

- Shabazz Napier leads UConn in

scoring, rebounds, assists, three-pointers and steals.

- The closest any player has come to leading Clemson in those five categories was Greg Buckner as a freshman in 1994-95. Buckner paced the Tigers in scoring, rebounding, steals and tied for the team lead in blocks. But he was

well behind Bruce Martin in three-point goals.

- Terrell McIntyre led Clemson in four categories in 1998-99: scoring, rebounding, assists and three-point goals.

McDANIELS IN HOT PURSUIT OF 500-POINT CLUB

- Junior forward K.J. McDaniels is 21 points shy of becoming the 14th player in Clemson history to reach 500 for a single season.
- The most recent Tiger to score 500 in a season was K.C. Rivers, who did it in back to back seasons (2006-07, 2007-08).
- Elden Campbell, Clemson's all-time leading scorer, is the only player to do it three times in a career. Bill Yarborough (1954-55) and Horace Grant (1986-87) are tied for the top single-season total with 651.

McDANIELS HAS ELEVEN 20-POINT GAMES

- K.J. McDaniels has 11 games with at least 20 points this season, the most by a Tiger since Will Solomon had 14 in 2001-02 as a junior.
- On Feb. 11, he added his first ever 30-point outing at Notre Dame. It was the first 30-point game by any Clemson player since Trevor Booker posted 31 against Western Carolina in 2009-10 at home.
- McDaniels followed his 30-point effort with a 24-point outing against No. 17/16 Virginia in Clemson's Feb. 15 home game.

McDANIELS POSTS FIFTH "20 & 10" GAME AGAINST MARYLAND

- K.J. McDaniels has recorded five "20 & 10" games (at least 20 points and 10 rebounds) this season, most by any ACC player.
- It is also the most "20 & 10" games by a Tiger since Sharrod Ford also had five in 2004-05.
- The individual Clemson record for "20 & 10" games in a single season is nine, set by Dale Davis in 1989-90.

McDANIELS GOES 30-14-6 IN LOSS TO NOTRE DAME

- Junior forward K.J. McDaniels had his finest all-around game at Notre Dame in a losing cause. He posted game highs with 30 points, 14 rebounds and six blocks.
- He is the first ACC player since Maryland's Lonny Baxter in 2000 to post at least 30 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks in a conference game.
- The last Tiger to post at least 30 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks in a game was Dale Davis against Western Carolina in 1991. Then a senior, he had 32 points, 14 rebounds and six blocks against the Catamounts.

McDANIELS POSTS 54 POINTS IN BACK TO BACK ACC GAMES

- With 54 over two games the week ending Feb. 16, K.J. McDaniels scored the most points in consecutive ACC games by a Clemson player since Edward Scott had 61 in two straight (vs. Virginia, Florida State) in 2002-03.
- McDaniels is the first Clemson player to score 50 total points over consecutive ACC games since Cliff Hammonds posted 53 against North Carolina (31) and Georgia Tech (22) back to back in 2008.
- Technically, K.C. Rivers posted 56 in back to back ACC games, but one was the 2008 ACC Championship game against North Carolina to close one season, and the next was Clemson's 2008-09 league opener at Miami.

HALL'S DEVELOPMENT

- Rod Hall ranks fourth among all ACC players in assist-to-turnover ratio this season, with 108 assists and 41 turnovers in 914 minutes of action.
- Hall's most surprising contribution has come offensively, where he has 15 double figure scoring games so far this season. Entering 2013-14, he had only four in his career spanning 62 games. So, he has 11 more double figure scoring games this season alone than he had his first two seasons.

HALL POSTS CAREER-HIGH 20 AGAINST NC STATE

- Rod Hall was aggressive from the get-go in Clemson's 73-56 win over NC State in Littlejohn Coliseum on Feb. 18.
- The Tiger junior made 6-of-10 field goals and was a perfect 8-for-8 at the free throw line as well, accumulating a career-high 20 points.
- Prior to the game, Hall's career-high was 18 points in an overtime win over Southern Illinois his freshman season in Hawaii.

HALL SCORES 10 POINTS IN OVERTIME VS. MARYLAND

- Rod Hall posted 10 of his 16 points in Clemson's March 2 win over Maryland in the two overtime periods.
- The 10 points were the most by a Tiger in overtime since Tanner Smith also tallied 10 in a win over Southern Illinois at the 2011 Diamond Head Classic in Honolulu, HI. Smith was 2-for-2 from the field and 6-for-7 at the free throw line in Clemson's 83-75 win.
- Hall made 3-of-4 field goals and all four of his free throws while playing all 10 minutes of the two overtime periods against the Terrapins.

SIX ASSISTS AND NO TURNOVERS

- Clemson point guard Rod Hall was adept at protecting the basketball in a 63-55 win at Georgia Tech on Feb. 22.
- The junior posted a game-high six assists without a turnover in 30 minutes. It was his first game without a turnover since the VMI game on Dec. 30.
- The six assists were the most in an ACC game for Hall without a turnover.

NNOKO PRODUCTIVE AS A SOPHOMORE

- Landry Nnoko's productivity can be measured in a number of ways.
- This season, he has scored five times as many points (168-31) and made over five times as many field goals (68-12) as his freshman year.
- He has 42 more offensive rebounds this season than in 2012-13, and 34 more blocked shots as well.

MOVIN' ON UP

- With 81 blocked shots on the season, K.J. McDaniels is now eighth in the Clemson record books with 159 career blocks.
- He passed John "Moose" Campbell for eighth in the Tigers' Jan. 26 game at North Carolina with two swats.
- Sharrod Ford is next in position to be caught by McDaniels. Ford had 177 from 2001-05.

- One of the best indicators of Nnoko's value is the plus-minus figure; Clemson outscores its opponent by an average of 5.5 points per game with him on the floor, the third-best mark on the team this season.

- Nnoko has increased his points, rebounds, offensive rebounds and blocked shots all by at least 250 percent this season.

NNOKO MISSED VIRGINIA GAME, RETURNED VS. NC STATE

- Starting center Landry Nnoko missed his first game as a Tiger and his first start of the 2013-14 season against 16th-ranked Virginia due to the flu. He had a fever as high as 103 degrees the day before the game.
- As Nnoko sat out, backup center Sidy Djitte returned to action for the Tigers. He missed the game before at Notre Dame due to an ankle injury suffered in the Syracuse loss on Feb. 9.
- Nnoko returned to the lineup on Tuesday, Feb. 18 against NC State. He came off the bench but played 29 minutes, posting nine points, six rebounds and three blocked shots.

HARRISON PICKS GOOD TIME TO FIND A RHYTHM

- Clemson has been in search of a consistent No. 2 or 3 scoring option all season, and found one in Damarcus Harrison the last four games.
- For the first time in his career, Harrison has produced four consecutive double figure scoring outputs.
- Harrison has averaged 13.5 points over the last four games. He scored 14 and added four rebounds against the 'Pack, and followed with 15-point efforts on a combined 11-of-19 field goals at Georgia Tech and Wake Forest.
- Harrison has made at least one three-pointer each of the last seven games, a career-long streak for the Tiger junior.

BLOSSOMGAME NAMED ACC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

- Jaron Blossomgame was named the conference's top rookie on Monday, Jan. 13 after his double-double against Duke.
- Blossomgame was Clemson's first ACC Rookie of the Week since Terrence Oglesby twice earned the honor in 2007-08.
- He set a single-game rebound high (14) by an ACC freshman in 2013-14.

BLOSSOMGAME GOES FOR 14 POINTS AND 14 REBOUNDS

- Jaron Blossomgame had 14 points and 14 rebounds against Duke and was the first Tiger freshman to post at least 14 of both since Sharone Wright did it against Georgia Tech in 1991-92.
- He is the fourth Clemson freshman on record to post at least 14 of both, joining Tree Rollins, Dale Davis and Wright.
- Like Davis, Blossomgame also achieved it against a top-15 Duke team. Davis posted 23 and 17 vs. the Blue Devils in 1987-88.
- Blossomgame's effort was only the fifth time a Clemson freshman recorded at least 14 points and 14 rebounds against an ACC team.
