THE OPENING TIP

- Duke travels to Coral Gables, Fla., to take on Miami in the BankUnited Center on Wednesday, Jan. 22, at 7:30 p.m. The game will air on ESPN2, the Blue Devil IMG Sports Network and Compass Media Networks.
- Duke is ranked No. 18 in the AP Poll and No. 18 in the USA Today Coaches' Poll. Duke is 7-4 all-time when ranked No. 18 in the AP Poll.
- Saturday's game will be Duke's 237th consecutive as a ranked team. Duke is 196-40 (.831) during that run.
- Duke is looking for its first ACC road win of the season after dropping previous away games at Notre Dame (79-77) and Clemson (72-59). Duke is 3-4 away from Cameron Indoor Stadium this season.
- Duke routed NC State 95-60 Saturday for the Blue Devils' fifth game scoring at least 90 points this season. Duke leads the ACC and ranks 19th nationally with 82.6 points per game.

THE LAST TIME OUT

- **Jabari Parker** scored 23 points and was one of five Blue Devils in double figures as Duke handled NC State, 95-60, Saturday at Cameron Indoor Stadium.
- Parker hit 7-of-14 shots from the field and both three-point attempts en route to his 11th 20-point game of the season.
- Duke scored 33 points off turnovers, forcing the Wolfpack into 21 giveaways, including 14 Duke steals. The 33 points off turnovers were a season-high for the Blue Devils.
- **Rasheed Sulaimon** scored 13 points, **Andre Dawkins** and **Rodney Hood** scored 11 and **Quinn Cook** added 10 as Duke had five players score in double figures for the fifth time this season.
- Former President George H.W. Bush was in attendance for the game to honor head coach **Mike Krzyzewski** for his commitment and leadership in working toward eliminating cancer as a public health threat.

By The Numbers

• Coach K is two wins shy of becoming the second coach in NCAA Division I history to record 900 wins at one school. Already the NCAA Division I all-time leader with 971 wins, he trails only Syracuse's Jim Boeheim (936) for the most wins at one school.

• Duke has topped 90 points five times this season for the program's most 90-point games since the 2010-11 team reached that plateau six times. Duke is 5-0 this season and 273-8 under **Mike Krzyzewski** when scoring 90 points.

• Duke has lost back-to-back road games to the same ACC opponent just once since the 2003-04 season when Wake Forest defeated the Blue Devils in back-to-back meetings at Lawrence Joel Coliseum on Feb. 17, 2008 (86-73) and Jan. 28, 2009 (68-70). Duke fell, 90-63, to Miami in the last meeting at BankUnited Center on Jan. 23, 2013.

• **Rodney Hood** leads the ACC in field goal percentage (.517 – 107-of-207) and three-point field goal percentage (.457 – 37-of-81). Hood is the only player in the country to lead his conference in both of those categories.

• Hood has hit a three-pointer in 15 consecutive games and has at least one trey in 17 of 18 games this season.

• Duke has at least one 20-point scorer in 17 of 18 games this season. **Jabari Parker** has a team-high 11 20-point games, followed by **Rodney Hood** (8, plus one 30-point game), **Quinn Cook** (3), **Rasheed Sulaimon** (2) and **Andre Dawkins** (1). Parker has scored 20 or more points 11 times this season, which is tied for the most 20-point games by a Duke freshman, matching the mark set by **Gene Banks** in 1977-78.

• Reigning ACC Player of the Week **Rasheed Sulaimon** is Duke's leading scorer off the bench, averaging 10.4 points per game when not in the starting lineup. Six of his seven double-figure scoring games this season have come from the bench.

• **Amile Jefferson** is third in ACC play with 9.6 rebounds per game. He has led the team in rebounds in four of Duke's five league games with a pair of double-figure efforts. Jefferson recorded a career-best 15 boards versus Virginia.

• **Quinn Cook** has a 3.03:1 assist-to-turnover ratio and is averaging an ACC-leading 5.7 assists per game. His 3.03:1 assist-to-turnover ratio is on pace to tie the school record set by **Steve Wojciechowski** in 1996-97.

The Last Meeting

Duke avenged an early-season road loss to the Hurricanes with a 79-76 win in Cameron Indoor Stadium on March 2, 2013 in a showdown of top-five teams. **Ryan Kelly**, who missed the previous game against Miami while recovering from a foot injury, made his return to the court after a 13-game hiatus and scored a career-high 36 points on 10-of-14 shooting, including 7-of-9 from three-point range. Kelly scored 20 points in the first half.

Notes

- Duke has won six of the past eight meetings against Miami.
- Three of Duke's four losses to Miami have come on the road.

109th Season of Basketball

- Duke is in its 109th season of basketball in 2013-14. The Blue Devils have compiled a 2,015-844 record to rank fourth all-time in victories.
- Only Kentucky (2,222), Kansas (2,113) and North Carolina (2,100) have more wins than Duke.

Sustained Success

- Duke has won 20 or more games 48 times in its 108 years of basketball. Including its 30-6 mark a year ago, Duke has won at least 20 games in 17 consecutive seasons.
- The Blue Devils have recorded 30 or more wins 13 times under Coach K, including four of the past five seasons.

K & Boeheim Sit Atop All-Time Wins Lists

- **Mike Krzyzewski** became the winningest coach in NCAA history on Nov. 15, 2011 with Duke's 74-69 win over Michigan State at Madison Square Garden. Coach K has registered 971 career victories, including 898 wins at Duke.
- Krzyzewski's win total in Durham ranks second all-time in wins at one school behind Syracuse's Jim Boeheim. He is two wins shy of becoming the second coach in NCAA history to record 900 wins at one school.
- Krzyzewski is 17 ACC wins shy of matching Dean Smith for most league victories.

Non-Conference Home Win Streak

- Duke has won an NCAA-best 109 consecutive non-conference home games. Duke's last home loss against a non-conference foe was an 83-82 decision against St. John's on Feb. 26, 2000.
- The Blue Devils won 95 consecutive non-conference home games from Feb. 2, 1983 through Dec. 2, 1995. Illinois snapped that streak with a 75-65 win over Duke.
- Duke has also won 101 straight games at Cameron against unranked non-conference opponents (also dating back to the 83-82 loss to St. John's on Feb. 26, 2000).

Wins this Decade

- Duke has won 138 games since the start of the 2009-10 season, the fourth most in the NCAA over that span behind only Kansas, Ohio State and Syracuse.
- The Blue Devils have won 63 games in ACC-play this decade.
- Duke is 19-6 this decade against the top 20 teams in terms of wins since the start of the 2009-10 season.
- The Blue Devils are 26-13 against teams ranked in the top 25 of the AP Poll this decade.

- Overall, the Blue Devils continue to be one of the nation's most popular draws, playing in front of sellout crowds in all venues in 378 of their last 465 games.

• **Jabari Parker** and **Rodney Hood** combine for 37.0 points per game, the seventh-highest combined scoring average in Duke history. The tandem has 19 20-point games on the year and at least 35 combined points in 12 of 18 games.

• Parker ranks second in the ACC in scoring with 19.1 points per game while Hood is fourth at 17.9. Duke is the only ACC team with two players inside the league's top 10 in scoring.

What's Under the Hood

• **Rodney Hood** leads the ACC in field goal percentage (.517 (107-of-207)) and three-point percentage (.457 (37-of-81)) and ranks fourth in scoring (17.9 ppg.), fifth in free throw percentage (.847 – 72-of-85) and eighth in made three-pointers per game (2.1).

• Hood is the only ACC player to rank in the top five in scoring, field goal percentage, free throw percentage and three-point field goal percentage.

• Hood's ACC numbers are even more impressive, as he leads the league in scoring (19.8 ppg.), ranks second in three-point field goals (3.2 3pg.) and free throw percentage (.895 – 17-of-19), third in field goal percentage (.500 – 33-of-66) and fourth in three-point percentage (.500 – 16-of-32).

• Hood has scored in double figures 16 times with one 30-point outing and eight 20-point games.

• At home, Hood averages 19.0 points per game with 5.0 rebounds. He is shooting 57.1 percent (68-of-119) from the field, 45.1 percent (23-of-51) from three-point range and 90.9 percent (50-of-55) from the free throw line at Cameron Indoor Stadium.

• Hood hit five three-pointers in back-to-back games against Notre Dame and Georgia Tech, becoming the 10th Duke player to do so.

Parker Living Up to Top Billing

• **Jabari Parker** ranks second in the ACC in scoring at 19.1 points per game, which would rank as the highest scoring average by a freshman in Duke history. He is third in scoring among NCAA freshmen and is tied for the most 20-point games by a Duke freshman in school history (11).

• Parker is one of three ACC players (joined by Clemson's K.J. McDaniels and Notre Dame's Garrick Sherman) leading his team in points, rebounds and blocks.

• In addition to his scoring, Parker ranks fifth in the ACC in field goal percentage (.486 – 123-of-253) and tied for fifth in rebounds (7.3 rpg.).

• Parker opened the season with seven straight 20-point games, the second most in school history. **Art Heyman** opened the 1961-62 season with 10 straight 20-point games.

• Parker became the NCAA's first freshman to begin the season with seven straight 20-point games since Kevin Durant (Texas) during the 2006-07 season.

• Parker opened the season with 13 straight double-figure scoring games, third-most to start a Duke career. He has scored 10 or more points in 16 of the Blue Devils' 18 games this season.

Cook Among Nation's Top Point Guards

- **Quinn Cook** has continued his rise to the top of the college basketball point guard crop, averaging 13.1 points, 5.7 assists, 2.8 rebounds and 1.7 steals per game.
- Cook leads the ACC and ranks 30th nationally in assists and has delivered eight or more assists on six occasions.
- Cook owns a 3.03:1 assist-to-turnover ratio, which would tie the school record set by Steve Wojciechowski in 1997.
- Cook has posted 14 double-figure scoring games, including three 20+ point outings.
- Cook ranks sixth in the ACC in steals (1.7 spg.). With eight steals against UCLA and five against Eastern Michigan, Cook became the fifth player in Duke history with at least five steals in consecutive games.

Jefferson Producing in the Paint

- **Amile Jefferson** is averaging 6.6 points and 6.8 rebounds per game while shooting a team-high 65.8 percent (48-of-73) from the field. He has four double-figure scoring games, including a career-high 17 points on 7-of-9 shooting against Kansas.
- Jefferson has led Duke in rebounding in seven of the past 10 games, including a career-high 15-rebound performance in a 69-64 win over Virginia on Jan. 13. That performance was part of Jefferson's first career double-double.
- Jefferson is averaging 7.3 points and 9.1 rebounds over the past 10 games. He has five or more rebounds in all 10 games, including four double-figure rebounding efforts.
- Jefferson has raised his rebound average by 3.9 rebounds per game (fifth largest increase in the ACC) from a season ago.
- Jefferson is third in conference play in rebounds (9.6 rpg.) and leads the league in defensive rebounds (7.0 drpg.) in ACC play.

Dawkins Continues to Hit from Long Range

- **Andre Dawkins** is averaging a career-best 8.9 points per game while shooting 45.0 percent (36-of-80) from three-point range this season.
- Dawkins is fifth in the Duke record books (tied for 17th in ACC history) with a .409 three-point field goal percentage (203-of-496).
- Dawkins hit his 200th career three-pointer this season against Virginia on Jan. 13, becoming the 13th Blue Devil to reach that mark.
- Dawkins has scored 903 career points and is 97 shy of becoming the 63rd Duke 1,000-point scorer.
- Dawkins ranks second in ACC in three-point percentage (.450) and sixth in three-point field goals (2.1 3pg.).
- Dawkins has scored in double figures eight times this season with one 20-point game.

• Hood is the first player under **Mike Krzyzewski** to be named team captain prior to competing in a game for the Blue Devils.

• Thornton, a vocal leader throughout his career in Durham, is a hard-nosed defender with a knack for making big plays at key moments on either end of the floor. He owns career averages of 3.1 points, 1.7 rebounds, 1.8 assists and 0.9 steals in 119 games with 38 starts.

• Hairston, added as a team captain Nov. 6, is Duke's top weak side defender and a vocal presence in the paint.

Duke Offense Explodes vs. Davidson

• The Blue Devils racked up 111 points in a season-opening win over Davidson. Duke shot 70.4 percent (38-of-54) from the floor, including 13-of-21 (.619) from three-point range, for the sixth-highest field goal percentage in a game in school history.

• Duke had four players (**Jabari Parker** [22], **Rodney Hood** [22], **Quinn Cook** [21] and **Rasheed Sulaimon** [20]) score at least 20 points in a game for the first time in school history.

• Duke scored 59 points in the first half for the Blue Devils' highest scoring half since a 66-point second half against Colgate on Nov. 19, 2010.

ACC Dominance

• Duke has dominated the ACC regular season like no other program since 1997. The Blue Devils have won 221 league games and eight regular season ACC championships in that span.

• Duke has won 10 or more regular season ACC contests in 16 of the past 17 seasons. The Blue Devils have won at least 12 league games 13 times in that span.

• Duke has also dominated ACC Tournament play with 10 tournament crowns in the past 15 seasons. The Blue Devils captured a league-record five straight ACC titles from 1999-2003.

Parker Named National FOTW

• **Jabari Parker** was named Wayman Tisdale National Freshman of the Week Dec. 24. Parker topped the 20-point mark in both contests as Duke topped Gardner-Webb and UCLA to improve to 9-2 on the year.

• Parker began the week by going 7-of-12 from the field against Gardner-Webb, scoring 21 points and grabbing six rebounds. It was his performance against UCLA that helped him secure this week's honor. Parker had 23 points, 10 rebounds and five assists, knocking down 7-of-13 from the field, 4-of-8 from three-point range, and 5-of-5 from the free-throw line. He made multiple big shots in the second half against the Bruins, helping Duke pull away for a 17-point win.

• For the week, he averaged 22.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 2.5 assists – while shooting 50 percent or better from both the field and the three-point line. He also was perfect from the charity stripe in two games, hitting all 11 of his attempts. Parker has scored at least 15 points in every game this season, eclipsing the 20-point mark in nine of the 11 contests.

Duke Inks Four Five-Star Recruits

• Duke signed the nation's No. 1 recruiting class, bringing in four top-40 and five-star recruits. The group includes 6-4 shooting guard **Grayson Allen** (Jacksonville, Fla./ Providence School of Jacksonville), 6-1 point guard **Tyus Jones** (Apple Valley, Minn./ Apple Valley High School), 6-10 center **Jahlil Okafor** (Chicago, Ill./Whitney Young High School) and 6-5 forward **Justise Winslow** (Houston, Texas/Saint John's High School) Thursday.

• All four players rank among the top 40 high school recruits nationally according to the ESPN, Rivals, Scout and 247Sports recruiting rankings. Okafor is the consensus No. 1 overall prospect, Jones is a consensus top-five selection, Winslow is unanimous top-15 player and Allen is inside the top 40 on all lists.

• Jones, Okafor and Winslow were members of the Team USA Boys' U17 World Championship Team in 2012, helping the squad win gold at the FIBA Championship along with current Duke freshman Jabari Parker. Okafor and Winslow went on to win FIBA gold with the 2013 USA Men's U19 Team alongside current Duke sophomore Rasheed Sulaimon. Each owns multiple FIBA Championship gold medals, as Jones and Okafor also won the FIBA U16 Championship in 2011 with the USA Boy's U16 Team.

• Allen averaged 19.3 points per game in 2012-13 to lead Providence to Florida Class 3A State Championship. He scored 27 points in the state semifinal and 31 in the championship game, shooting a combined 15-of-29 (.517) from the field in those two games along with a 7-of-13 (.538) clip from three-point range.

• Jones was the Gatorade Minnesota Boys Basketball Player of the Year twice, receiving the award as a sophomore and junior when he averaged over 20.0 points and 7.0 assists per game at Apple Valley. He has also been a steady member of USA Basketball, directing the U16 and U17 teams to gold medals at the FIBA Championships in 2011 and 2012.

• Okafor averaged 20.9 points, 8.8 rebounds and 2.9 blocks during his junior season when he led Whitney Young to the Chicago Public League championship. A three-year member of the USA Basketball program, he was named MVP of the 2012 FIBA U17 World Championship tournament when he posted 13.6 points and 8.3 rebounds per game to lead Team USA to an 8-0 record and FIBA gold.

• Winslow was the 2013 Gatorade Texas Player of the Year, averaging 28.6 points, 15.7 rebounds, 3.0 assists, 2.7 steals and 1.5 blocks per game for Saint John's. He followed that performance by joining the USA U19 World Championship team this past summer where, as the youngest member of the team, he averaged 9.8 points, 6.0 rebounds, 1.6 assists and 1.1 blocks per game to help the group capture the gold medal at the FIBA Championship.

Mike Krzyzewski

Head Coach • Army '69 • 39th season (34th season at Duke)

971-301 overall • 898-242 at Duke

Winning seasons, superb graduation rates for his players and a basketball team that is as close as family are all attributes that reflect on the man who has spent over three decades as the head coach of the Duke Blue Devils, Hall of Famer **Mike Krzyzewski**.

Coach K, the winningest coach in NCAA Division I history after passing his mentor Bob Knight with a 74-69 win over Michigan State on Nov. 15, 2011, now has 971 career wins, while also ranking second in wins at one school (898), second in career ACC wins (405) and first in NCAA Tournament victories (82).

Krzyzewski's record as Duke's all-time winningest coach offers further evidence of his success: 898 total wins; 517 weeks ranked in the top 25; 454 weeks ranked in the top 10; 109 weeks ranked No. 1; 11 Final Four berths in the last 27 years, including five straight appearances from 1988-92; 29 seasons with at least 20 wins; 12 regular season ACC crowns and 13 Atlantic Coast Conference Tournament titles, including 10 of the last 15 years (a record five in succession from 1999-2003). Coach K has also led the Blue Devils to an NCAA-best 13 seasons with 30 or more wins.

But most impressive are the four National Championships (1991, 1992, 2001 and 2010) that make Coach K one of only three coaches in NCAA history to earn four or more NCAA titles. In addition to Krzyzewski, only John Wooden (10), and Adolph Rupp (4) have accomplished that feat. With back-to-back national championships in 1991 and 1992, Coach K became the first coach since Wooden in 1972-73 to earn consecutive NCAA crowns. The Blue Devils grabbed their third title in 2001 with an 82-72 win over Arizona in Minneapolis, Minn. Duke defeated Butler, 61-59, in the 2010 championship game in Indianapolis, Ind. to give Krzyzewski his fourth NCAA Championship.

Krzyzewski and the Blue Devils have been a fixture on the national basketball scene with 18 consecutive NCAA Tournament berths from 1996-2013 and 29 in the last 30 years. Overall, he has taken his program to postseason play in 30 of his 33 years and is the winningest active coach in NCAA Tournament play with a stunning 82-25 record for a .766 winning percentage. He also ranks first in NCAA Tournament history in wins (82) and games (107).

From 1999-2002, Duke finished number one in the nation in the final Associated Press poll for a record four consecutive seasons. In 2003-04, the Blue Devils reached the nation's top spot in the AP poll, marking the seventh straight year they had been number one (only UCLA's string of 12 consecutive years reaching No. 1 from 1964-75 was longer).

Krzyzewski has mentored seven National Players of the Year (nine selections), 27 All-Americans (41 selections), eight ACC Players of the Year (10 selections) and 81 All-ACC selections during his tenure at Duke.

Coach K has coached 47 NBA Draft picks, including a record 26 first round selections. An NCAA-best 17 Blue Devils have been NBA Lottery picks with Elton Brand (1999) and Kyrie Irving (2011) being taken No. 1 overall in their respective drafts.

Krzyzewski earned his 900th career victory on March 20, 2011 with a 73-71 win over Michigan in the third round of the NCAA Tournament. On March 1, 2008, Krzyzewski became the sixth coach in Division I history to reach 800 wins with an 87-86 victory at NC State. Coach K became just the fifth coach in NCAA history to record 800 wins at one school with a win over Kansas State on Nov. 23, 2010. On Nov. 17, 2000, Krzyzewski earned his 500th win at Duke with a 98-85 triumph over Villanova. That night, the fabled floor of Cameron Indoor Stadium was dedicated as Coach K Court. On Feb. 13, 2010, Krzyzewski became the eighth coach in Division I history to coach 1,000 games at one school.

In all, Coach K has been named the National Coach of the Year 12 times in eight different seasons, including *Basketball Times*, UPI and Chevrolet (1986), Naismith (1989), the NABC (1991), *The Sporting News* and Naismith (1992), *Basketball Times* (1997), the NABC and Naismith (1999), Chevrolet (2000) and the Victor Awards (2001). He was named Coach of the Decade for the 1990s by the NABC and was the second recipient of the John R. Wooden Legends of Coaching Award. On October 5, 2001, Coach K was presented by his college coach Bob Knight as one of three members of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame class of 2001.

Krzyzewski was named *Sports Illustrated* Sportsman of the Year on Dec. 5, 2011. In 1992, *The Sporting News* named him the Sportsman of the Year, becoming the first college coach to win the honor. Krzyzewski also received another prestigious honor in 2001 as he was named "America's Best Coach" by *Time* magazine and CNN.

On the court, Coach K has averaged more than 25 wins a season during his career at Duke. The Blue Devils have won at least 30 games in 11 of the past 22 seasons. He directed his teams to nine straight trips to the NCAA Sweet 16 from 1998-2006, as well as joining Wooden as the only coach to guide a team to the Final Four five consecutive years.

Krzyzewski added to his already impressive list of accomplishments on Oct. 26, 2005 when he was named head coach of the USA Basketball Men's Senior National Team program for 2006-2008. With Krzyzewski at the helm, Team USA won the gold medal at the 2008 Beijing Summer Olympics with a 118-107 victory over Spain. In the summer of 2007, he guided the USA squad to a gold medal victory and an unblemished 10-0 record in the FIBA Americas Championship. Krzyzewski has been honored by USA Basketball as the National Coach of the Year four times.

On July 21, 2009, he resumed his role as head coach of the USA Basketball Men's Senior National Team through 2012. Coach K guided Team USA to a 9-0 record and gold medal at the 2010 FIBA World Championships.

Krzyzewski guided Team USA to an 8-0 and a gold medal at the 2012 London Olympics to become the first coach since Henry Iba (1964 & 1968) to lead the program to back-to-back Olympic gold medals.

On May 23, 2013, Krzyzewski was again tabbed to lead the USA Men's Senior National Team for the 2013-2016 quadrennium. In his first two stints as head coach of Team USA, Coach K posted a 62-1 record, including an active 50-game win streak. He has guided the program to a pair of Olympic gold medals as well as the 2010 FIBA World Championship.

Duke Basketball in the Polls

The Duke basketball program has held a prominent spot in the national basketball scene since the beginning of the post-World War II era. The final national rankings are just one measuring stick in which the Blue Devils are among the elite in the history of the sport.

In the Coach K era, which began in 1980-81, Duke has finished in the Associated Press top 25 a total of 26 seasons, including seven times as the No. 1 team in the nation. With consecutive AP number one finishes from 1999-2002, Duke became the first school in college basketball history to be ranked at the top of the final AP poll for four straight years.

- Duke has been ranked No. 1 in 18 of the past 28 years (AP & USA Today polls).
- **Mike Krzyzewski** has spent more weeks ranked in the top 25 (517 weeks), top 10 (454) and No. 1 (109) than any other active coach (AP poll only).
- Duke has been ranked No. 1 in 96 weeks since 1990, the most by any school in the nation. The next closest school is North Carolina at 52 weeks during the same time period.
- Duke has been No. 1 109 weeks (218 games, 190-28) in the AP poll since 1986.
- Of the 1,140 games coached at Duke by **Mike Krzyzewski**, 999 of them have come as a ranked team (87.6 percent). Duke's record as a ranked team since 1981 is 821-178.
- Under Coach K, Duke has played more games as a No. 1 team (218) than it has as an unranked team (141).
- The Blue Devils were ranked in the top 25 of the AP poll in 380 consecutive games (Nov. 20, 1996-Feb. 11, 2007).
- Duke has been ranked No. 1 in the nation 127 weeks overall, the second-highest figure in NCAA history behind only UCLA (134).
- Duke finished in the top 10 for 10 consecutive seasons from 1997-2006 — second all-time behind UCLA (13 straight years - 1967-79).
- Duke's 1991-92 team is one of only 12 schools in college basketball history to be ranked No. 1 for the entire season.
- Duke has been ranked in 329 of the last 331 AP polls (dating back to the start of the 1996-97 season) The Blue Devils have been ranked in the top 10 for 301 weeks in that span.

The Blue Devils reached the top ranking seven consecutive seasons from 1998-2004, becoming just the second program in NCAA history to accomplish that feat.
