NEWS & NOTES

- La Salle takes a short trip to Reading, Pa., for a pre-Thanksgiving matchup with No. 11 Miami at Santander Arena on Wednesday.
- The game will be considered a neutral-site contest, with the game being played 60 miles from La Salle's campus.
- The Explorers will face a Power 5 opponent for the third straight game, and will play a nationally-ranked team for the second time over that same span.
- This past weekend, La Salle traveled to Uncasville, Conn., for the Basketball Hall of Fame Tip-Off Tournament at Mohegan Sun Arena.
- Senior B.J. Johnson earned a spot on the All-Tournament Team by averaging 24.5 points and 6.0 rebounds over two games.
- Johnson also recorded 2.5 steals per outing while shooting 17-for-31 from the field (54.8%) and an even 50.0% from three-point range.
- On Saturday, the Explorers cut what was once a 26-point deficit to seven midway through the second half but could not muster enough energy to complete the comeback against No. 20 Northwestern.
- In addition to Johnson's 22 points, sophomore Isiah Deas added nine points and freshman Miles Brookins came off the bench to add eight on 3-of-3 shooting.
- La Salle shot 67.9 percent during the entire second half against the Wildcats, outscoring them 50-36.
- Despite not shooting the ball particularly well on Sunday against Boston College, the Explorers trailed by just 40-34 with 13:15 remaining before their offensive struggles caught up to them.
- Johnson was once again the catalyst at the offensive end, going for 27 points in 36 minutes.
- Redshirt junior Pookie Powell added 16 points but struggled from the floor, going 6-for-18 overall and 2-for-11 from three-point range.

SCOUTING THE HURRICANES

- No. 11 Miami is a perfect 3-0 to start the season, defeating its first three opponents by an average of 32.3 points per game.
- Eight different players are averaging at least 18 minutes per game, with Bruce Brown leading the way at 31.3 minutes per contest.
- Senior Ja'Quan Newton, a Philadelphia native who played his high school ball at Neumann-Goretti, paces a group of four players in double figures with 14.0 ppg.
- Bowen is grabbing a team-high 8.3 rebounds per game and is also leading the squad in assists at 6.7 apg.
- Miami freshman Lonnie Walker will be returning to his hometown for Wednesday's game. Walker, a 2017 McDonald's All-American who is averaging 7.7 ppg through three contests for the Hurricanes, is a Reading native and led Reading High to its first Pennsylvania 6A State Championship.

**DR. JOHN GIANNINI****North Central '84****14th season at La Salle****29th season as Head Coach**

Record breaking success and consistent winning. Those two phrases can sum up the career of La Salle head coach Dr. John Giannini, who enters his 14th season at the school in 2017-18. Giannini is La Salle's all-time winningest coach in Atlantic 10 play and has produced the program's only winning A-10 records since joining the league in 1995-96. He is also the winningest coach in the University of Maine's history. When he left Rowan University, Giannini was the winningest active NCAA Division III head coach.

In 2012-13, Giannini guided the Explorers to a NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 appearance with three wins in five days and a #24 national ranking in the final USA Today/Coaches Poll. La Salle's 24 wins were the seventh most in the program's rich 82-year history and the most since 1990. The Blue and Gold knocked off three nationally-ranked teams during the 2012-13 season, including #9/9 Butler, #19/16 VCU and #12/14 Kansas State. A program-record 11 Atlantic 10 wins tied for third in the nation's seventh-best conference. Giannini was named the Big 5 Coach of the Year in 2013 after leading the Explorers to a share of the Big 5 title. In 2011-12, Giannini led La Salle to its first postseason appearance in 20 years with an appearance in the NIT. The 21 wins were the most in 22 years.

The recent back-to-back 20-win seasons, however, have not been the only success for the Explorers during Giannini's tenure. After accepting what most observers believed would be a major rebuilding job, Giannini's Explorers have finished in the top half of the Atlantic 10 five of the past nine years. This established a new level of consistent success for a program that previously had experienced no winning A-10 records since joining the highly-regarded league.

Academic success is also a major emphasis of Giannini's coaching philosophy. La Salle's Yves Mekongo was a two-time Academic All-American and 2010 NACDA I-AAA Scholar Athlete of the Year. Steve Weingarten also earned Academic All-District recognition in 2009-10. Mekongo and Weingarten were also the A-10 Student-Athletes of the Year in 2010 and 2011, respectively, and this past year current redshirt junior Amar Stukes was named Big 5 Scholar-Athlete of the Year. The team's APR (Academic Progress Rate) has improved each season and is ranked in the top 10% nationally.

Giannini is involved in many leadership activities. He has served as a member of the board of trustees at his alma mater, North Central College, and served on the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Congress and on the NABC Committee for Recruiting Rules and Access. At Rowan University, he was a member of the faculty senate. He authored Court Sense: Winning Basketball's Mental Game, published by Human Kinetics in 2008 and published articles for academic research journals and practical coaching publications. He has also taught courses at the University of Maine and Rowan University.

Giannini was introduced as the 18th head coach in the history of Explorer men's basketball on August 23, 2004. "John Giannini has earned respect as a coach and as a person wherever he has been," said former La Salle President Brother Michael J. McGinniss, F.S.C., Ph.D. "He recognizes, and believes in, the prominent place that values and academics have at La Salle."

He came to Philadelphia after an impressive eight year run at the University of Maine where he built the Black Bears into a perennial force in the America East Conference. During his tenure, Giannini compiled the best record of any coach in UMaine history. His teams made five trips to the America East semifinals or better in his final six seasons and made appearances in the AEC's championship in game two of his last three seasons in Orono. Giannini's two 20-win campaigns are the only two on record in program history.

Giannini's knack for winning began much closer to the Philadelphia area, however, having spent seven seasons as head coach at Rowan University in nearby Glassboro, N.J. During his run as the Profs head coach, he amassed a 168-38 record and a Division III National Championship in 1996 with a team that went 28-4. He left Rowan with the best winning percentage in the nation (.814) among all active NCAA coaches. He was inducted into the Rowan Sports Hall of Fame in 2004.

Before becoming the head coach at Rowan, Giannini served on Lou Henson's staff at the University of Illinois from 1987-89. In his two seasons as a graduate assistant, the Illini made two trips to the NCAA Tournament including a Final Four appearance in 1989 with a team that went 31-5 in the regular season. He also assisted at Parkland Community College (Champaign, Ill.) and North Texas.

The Chicago, Ill. native (Fenwick High) earned his bachelor of arts degree in psychology from North Central College (Naperville, Ill.) in 1984 and his master of science degree in physical education with a specialization in sports psychology from North Texas in 1986. "Dr. John" also earned a Ph.D. in kinesiology with a specialization in sports psychology from Illinois in 1992. Giannini was a two-time all-conference player at North Central and remains sixth on the school's all-time rebounding list. He is the all-time leader in games played and his 21 rebounds in a game remain fifth in program history.

He resides in Mullica Hill, N.J. with his wife Donna and daughters Brianna and Jamie.

OFFENSE STRUGGLES AT MOHEGAN SUN

- La Salle squared off against two Power 5 opponents at the Basketball Tip-Off Tournament on Nov. 18-19.
- Against then-No. 20 Northwestern, the Explorers shot 31.3 percent from the floor through the first 20 minutes of play.
- La Salle did fight back and had a hot second half before falling, 82-74.
- In the second game of the event against Boston College, the offensive woes continued to plague the Explorers.
- The team connected on 34.4% of its shots in a 82-61 loss to the Eagles.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

- Senior B.J. Johnson and sophomore Saul Phiri were key players in La Salle's 3-0 start.
- The duo combined for five double-doubles through the first three games, with both accomplishing the feat against Penn and South Alabama.
- Johnson has three double-doubles on the year, which matches his total over the first three years of his collegiate career.

BIG 5 THRILLER

- In a game that did not lack on drama, La Salle and Penn slugged it out for 50 minutes on Monday at the famed Palestra.
- The Explorers used a strong defensive performance that limited the Quakers to just 33.8 percent shooting, to take home a 75-71, double-overtime win.
- La Salle also outrebounded its opponent by an impressive 53-40 margin.
- The double-overtime game was the first for the Explorers at the Palestra since Dec. 4, 2011, when Oklahoma State earned a 92-87 win.
- It was the first Big 5 game for La Salle that has gone two extra periods since a 98-95 win over Saint Joseph's at the Spectrum on Jan. 23, 1999.

JOHNSON SET FOR STRONG SENIOR YEAR

- One of the most versatile players in the Atlantic 10, B.J. Johnson briefly tested the NBA Draft waters before deciding to return to La Salle for his senior campaign.
- The leading scorer on the team last season at 17.6 points per game, Johnson also led the Explorers in rebounding (6.3 rpg) and was second in blocked shots (14), third in steals (33) and three-point percentage (36.2%).
- The 6-7 lefty was rated preseason as the No. 7 projected scorer in the country by Sports Illustrated.
- Johnson has recorded double-doubles in three contests this year and has scored 20 or more points in each of his last four outings.
- The Philadelphia native was named to the All-Tournament Team at Mohegan Sun Arena after averaging 24.5 points and 6.0 rebounds over two games.
- Against South Alabama, he became the first collegiate player since 2010 to score 30 points, record 10 or more rebounds (11) and pilfer three steals.
- Johnson leads La Salle in scoring, rebounding, steals, field goal percentage and three-point percentage in 2016-17.

BETTER CALL SAUL

- Sophomore Saul Phiri has stepped up to the challenge of a starting role thus far in 2017-18.
- The sophomore swingman set new career marks for points two straight games, including 14 against South Alabama on Nov. 16.
- Phiri tallied his first career double-double at Penn, scoring 12 points and grabbing 11 boards.
- Against the Quakers, the 6-4 guard was matched up for a large portion of the game against Penn's 6-8 forward AJ Brodeur.
- Brodeur, who scored 35 points in Penn's 77-74 win over the Explorers last season, was held to 12 points and just seven field goal attempts this year.

"D" IS THE KEY

- Last season, La Salle ranked at the bottom of the Atlantic 10 in scoring defense (76.6), field goal defense (46.7%) and three-point field goal defense (39.4%).
- After an offseason of stressing defensive principles, the Explorers showed the capability to defend at a high level over their first two games.
- In the season opener against Saint Peter's, La Salle held the Peacocks to 40 points -- the lowest point total for an opponent since the 1973-74 season (Lehigh, 37 pts.)
- Two nights later, Penn shot just 33.8 percent from the field and 25.0 percent from three-point range.
- The last time La Salle held consecutive opponents to under 35 percent shooting was in January of 2016, which included a win over nationally-ranked Dayton.

WASHINGTON MANS THE MIDDLE

- Redshirt senior Tony Washington is expected to start at center for the Explorers in 2017-18.
- One of the most efficient players in the league offensively, Washington connected on 58.5 percent of his field-goal attempts last season and has shot nearly 60 percent (59.7) from the floor for his career.
- Against Penn on Nov. 13, Washington grabbed nine rebounds and swatted three Penn shots in 36 minutes before fouling out in overtime.
- The 6-10 center tallied eight points on 4-of-6 shooting against Northwestern and shot 60.0 percent at Mohegan Sun Arena over the weekend.

BROOKINS IMPRESSES EARLY

- Freshman Miles Brookins has come off the bench to provide La Salle a reliable player in the paint.
- Brookins is averaging 12.0 minutes per outing through five games and is an efficient 10-for-14 (71.4%) from the floor.
- The 6-10 player from California, who played his high school basketball at powerhouse Mater Dei, scored a career-high eight points in the game against No. 20 Northwestern on Nov. 18.

DEAS PROVIDES "O" vs. USA

- Sophomore Isiah Deas showed off his scoring prowess in La Salle's 81-73 win over South Alabama on Nov. 16.
- The 6-6 guard totaled a career-high 15 points off the bench, including a big three-pointer in the second half that helped seal the win.
- Deas' previous career high came in the first game he ever played for La Salle, the season opener last season against Temple in which he had 12 points.

CANNON GIVES BLESSING TO B.J.

- La Salle great Larry Cannon had his No. 20 jersey retired in a ceremony at the Palestra last December.
- The number, however, is still in circulation for one final season as Cannon has given senior B.J. Johnson his blessing to wear the number.
- A three-time First Team All-Big 5 selection, Cannon was drafted fifth overall by the Chicago Bulls in the 1969 National Basketball Association (NBA) Draft and was also a first-round selection of the Miami Floridians of the American Basketball Association.
- He would go on to play professionally for eight seasons before injuries forced him to retire from the sport.

TOUGH NON-LEAGUE SLATE TO NAVIGATE

- As is the case every year, the La Salle men's basketball team will test itself against a number of top teams during its non-league slate.
- Over the last five years, the Explorers have averaged the second-toughest non-league schedule in the A-10, with opponents averaging a 73.0 RPI (NCAA). Only VCU has faced a tougher schedule (53.6).
- The Explorers face five teams that advanced to postseason play last year, including Northwestern, Miami (Fla.) and Villanova.
- Bucknell also made the Big Dance last year after winning the Patriot League Tournament, while Saint Peter's -- who La Salle defeated 61-40 in the season opener -- earned the CollegeInsiders.com Tournament title and won 23 games.

LA SALLE ANNOUNCES FOUR SIGNEES

- On Tuesday, Dr. John Giannini announced the signing of four student-athletes to National Letters of Intent.
- Jack Clark is a 6-7 guard from Cheltenham, Pa., who averaged over 18 points per game as a junior at Cheltenham High School.
- Ed Croswell is a 6-8 power forward from St. Joseph's Prep in Philadelphia.
- Croswell plays for former Explorer head coach Speedy Morris and was a Second Team All-Catholic League pick last year.
- Jared Kimbrough is a versatile 6-7 forward that was an All-Shore League Second Team selection last year.
- Osun Osunniyi is a 6-10 center known for his shot blocking ability.
- Osunniyi averaged nearly six blocks per game at Mainland Regional last year, and is currently attending prep school at Putnam Science Academy in Connecticut.

GIANNINI HITS WIN MILESTONE

- La Salle University head men's basketball coach Dr. John Giannini is approaching a pair of milestone wins in 2017-18.
- In his 14th season at the helm of the Explorers, Giannini won the 200th game of his La Salle career on Saturday.
- Including his prior stops at Rowan and Maine, Giannini has amassed 494 victories over 28 seasons -- just six shy of 500.

TRUMARK DEDICATION

- The home of the La Salle men's basketball team was officially re-named "Tom Gola Arena at TruMark Financial Center" during a halftime ceremony against Saint Peter's on Nov. 11.
- TruMark Financial Credit Union partnered with La Salle University for naming rights of the arena, installed a new open a branch on campus and will offer financial literacy education programs to the university's students.

MOMENT OF SILENCE

- La Salle University and the men's basketball program continues to mourn the loss of a pair of students who passed away last week.
- Emily Hanycz, the daughter of University President Colleen Hanycz, and Sami Bienkowski, a senior nursing major were honored prior to the game against Saint Peter's.
- Senior B.J. Johnson wore special sneakers with "Family is Forever" written on the sole, and dedicated the game to the Hanycz family following the win.

SIX NEWCOMERS ADDED TO ROSTER

- Five freshmen and a transfer have been added to the roster for 2017-18.
- Miles Brookins, Dajour Joseph and Jamir Moultrie enter their first season of collegiate basketball, while Traci Carter comes to the Explorers after spending two years at Marquette.
- Brookins is a 6-10 frontcourt player from California who could see immediate action.
- Joseph is an athletic 6-6 wing from Florida, while Moultrie was a top performer at Bishop McNamara in the Washington, D.C. area during high school.
- Carter, who started 19 games as a freshman for the Golden Eagles, must sit out the 2017-18 season due to NCAA transfer requirements.
- A pair of walk-ons -- Kyle Cooney and Chris Kuhar -- were also added prior to the year.

FAMILY TIES FOR JOHNSON

- After spending two seasons in upstate N.Y. at Syracuse University, senior B.J. Johnson preps for his final season at La Salle.
- Johnson joined a program that his father, Bobby, was a part of from 1986-90.
- The elder Johnson scored 878 career points and helped the Explorers to three NCAA Tournament appearances.
- B.J. Johnson played at Lower Merion School and helped the Aces to a Class AAAA state championship as a senior.
- In his final high school game, he had 22 points and 11 rebounds to snap Chester's string of 78 consecutive wins over in-state opponents.

THERE'S A DOCTOR IN THE HOUSE

- La Salle head men's basketball coach Dr. John Giannini is one of just two active Division I coaches who have earned a Ph.D.
- Lehigh's Brett Reed is the other and, interestingly enough, the two teams played each other earlier this season with the Explorers coming out on top, 89-81.
- Giannini, who is one win away from 200 for his La Salle career, earned his bachelor's from North Central in 1984, his master's from North Texas in 1986 & a Ph.D. in kinesiology with a specialization in sports psych from Illinois in '92.

WHY ARE WE THE EXPLORERS?

- La Salle University's nickname - the Explorers - was announced by the Collegian in March 1932 as the winning entry to a student contest.
- However, in the fall of 1931, a Baltimore sportswriter covering the La Salle/St. John's (Md.) football game erroneously alluded to La Salle as being named for French explorer La Salle, not St. John Baptist de La Salle.
- Were the two events related? We'll never know for sure.

LAST TIME WE MET

- La Salle and Miami squared off at the famed Palestra right before Christmas in 2015.
- The Explorers suffered a 95-49 defeat at the hands of No. 13 Miami, with now-senior Tony Washington totaling eight points and 10 rebounds in the game.
- Two other players that are currently on La Salle's roster started in that game - senior Johnnie Shuler (9 pts., 5 asts.) and grad student Amar Stukes (4 pts., 2 asts.).
- For Miami, Ja'Quan Newton had 10 points and three assists off the bench.
- Newton is joined by five other players that remain on the roster from that game, including Ebuka Izundu (6 pts., 4 rebs.) and Anthony Lawrence (2 pts., 3 asts.).

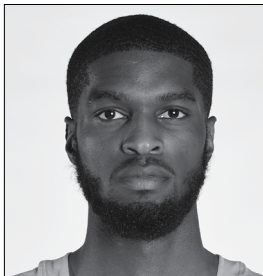

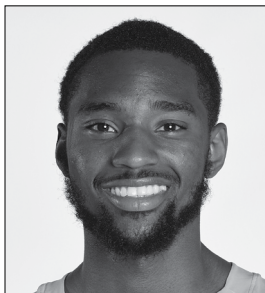
