THE GAME

- The #18/#18 Miami Hurricanes kick off the 2017 season against **Bethune-Cookman** at Hard Rock Stadium on Sept. 2, 2017 at 12:30 p.m.
- The Hurricanes open their 10th season at newly renovated Hard Rock Stadium this fall; Miami holds a perfect 9-0 all-time mark in home openers at the stadium, having outscored opponents 382-56 for an average margin of victory of 36.2 points.
- The game will be broadcast on **RSN** with Wes Durham (play by play), James Bates (color) and Rebecca Kaple (sideline). Joe Zagacki (pxp) and partner Don Bailey, Jr. (color) return to the **560 WQAM** radio booth for their 16th season together on the call, while Josh Darrow will handle sideline duties. Jose "Chamby" Campos (pxp) and Jose Martinez (color) are broadcasting on **990AM ESPN Deportes**.

THE SERIES

- Miami is **3-0** all-time against the Wildcats and will be opening its season against Bethune-Cookman for the fourth time; Miami won its three previous season openers against Bethune-Cookman in 2011 (45-14), 2012 (38-10) and 2015 (45-0).

THE TEAM

- For the first time since 2010, Miami enters the season ranked by both the Associated Press (#18) and in the Amway Coaches Poll (#18).
- The Hurricanes were picked to win the ACC's Coastal Division in a media poll at the 2017 ACC Football Kickoff in Charlotte, N.C., in late July.
- Leading statistical returners include junior running back **Mark Walton** (1,117 rushing yards, 14 rush TDs), sophomore wide receiver **Ahmon Richards** (49 receptions, 934 yards, 3 TDs), sophomore linebacker **Shaquille Quarterman** (84 tackles, 10.0 tackles for loss) and sophomore defensive lineman **Joe Jackson** (8.5 sacks).

THE OPPONENT

- Bethune-Cookman is under the direction of third-year head coach **Terry Sims**, who has compiled a 13-8 mark in his first two seasons. Sims was an assistant coach on the Wildcats staff for the previous five seasons before taking over prior to 2015.
- The Wildcats, who were picked to finish fourth in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) in the preseason conference poll, feature preseason All-MEAC selections wide receiver **Frank Brown** (439 receiving yards) and safety **Diqan Richardson** (60 tackles, four INTs).

THE COACH

- Miami is beginning its second season under the direction of head coach **Mark Richt**; in his first season at the helm, the Hurricanes finished with a 9-4 record and won their first bowl game since 2006 with a 31-14 victory over West Virginia in the Russell Athletic Bowl.
- Richt, who grew up in nearby Boca Raton, Fla., played quarterback as a student-athlete at Miami and is a 1982 graduate of the university, was named the 24th head coach in the history of the Hurricanes football program on Dec. 4, 2015.
- In 15 seasons as head coach at the University of Georgia, Richt compiled a 145-51 overall record and an 85-40 record in Southeastern Conference play. He won two SEC Championships, six SEC East titles and nine bowl games. Richt ranks eighth in active FBS wins with 154.

QUICK HITS

CANES OPEN YEAR 2 UNDER RICHT

- The #18/#18 Hurricanes kick off the 2017 season against **Bethune-Cookman** at Hard Rock Stadium on Sept. 2, 2017 at 12:30 p.m.
- Miami has not lost a home opener since 2006, having won its last 10 home openers - including a 70-3 win over Florida A&M in 2016.
- In the modern era of Hurricanes Football (since 1979), Miami has opened the season at home 17 times and is 15-2 in those games - its only losses coming in 1985 and 2006. Miami is 29-9 in regular season openers dating to the start of the 1979 season.

WALTON TO CARRY THE LOAD IN 2017

- Junior running back **Mark Walton** figures to be among the top offensive backs in the ACC in 2017 after posting a 1,117-yard, 14-rush TD campaign as a sophomore in 2016.
- Walton is looking to become just the second running back in Miami's storied history at the position to post two 1,000-yard seasons; **Edgerrin James** did it in 1997 (1,098) and in 1998 (1,416).
- Walton's 23 career rushing touchdowns are the ninth-most in Miami history; he needs 13 rushing scores this year to become the all-time leader in the category (**Stephen McGuire** - 35).

DEFENSE LOOKING TO TAKE NEXT STEP

- Miami shined on defense in 2016, its first season under the direction of coordinator **Manny Diaz**, eliciting nostalgia from longtime Canes fans with a standout unit.
- The Hurricanes ranked No. 20 nationally in total defense in 2016 (up from No. 69 the previous season), No. 9 in yards per play (No. 86 in 2015), No. 12 in scoring defense (No. 77 in 2015), No. 5 in tackles for loss (No. 105 in 2015) and No. 22 in team sacks (No. 70 in 2015).
- Miami was the only team in the country to start three true freshmen linebackers in 2016: **Shaquille Quarterman**, **Michael Pinckney** and **Zach McCloud**.

HURRICANES OPEN YEAR 2 UNDER COACH MARK RICHT

- #18/#18 Miami will open its 2017 season on Sept. 2 against Bethune-Cookman under the direction of head coach **Mark Richt**. Kickoff is set for 12:30 p.m. from Hard Rock Stadium.
- In his first season at the helm of the Hurricanes, Richt led Miami to a 9-4 record and its first bowl win since 2006 - a 31-14 rout of ranked West Virginia at the Russell Athletic Bowl in Orlando, Fla.
- In 15 seasons as head coach at the University of Georgia, Richt compiled a 145-51 overall record and an 85-40 record in Southeastern Conference play. His teams won two SEC Championships, six SEC East titles and nine bowl games, and finished the season ranked in the Associated Press top 10 seven times. His Bulldogs teams finished nine of 15 seasons with 10 or more wins.

HOME, SWEET HOME OPENERS

- The Miami Hurricanes open their 10th season at newly renovated Hard Rock Stadium on Sept. 2 vs. Bethune-Cookman; Miami holds a 9-0 all-time mark in home openers at the stadium, having outscored opponents 382-56 for an average margin of victory of 36.2 points.
- The Hurricanes have not lost a home opener since 2006, when they fell to Florida State 13-10 at the Orange Bowl (Sept. 4, 2006); Miami has won 10 straight home openers since.
- Since the start of the 2001 season, Miami has opened the season nine times at home and seven times on the road; the Hurricanes are 8-1 in those home games.
- Since joining the ACC prior to the 2004 season, Miami has played a conference opponent in only three of its 14 home openers: Florida State twice (2004, 2006) and Georgia Tech once (2009).
- Miami has played Bethune-Cookman three times and is a perfect 3-0 in those games. All three prior matchups also served as season openers (2011, 2012, 2015). The Hurricanes shut out Bethune-Cookman, 45-0, in their 2015 season opener at then-Sun Life Stadium.
- In the modern era of Miami Hurricanes football (since 1979), UM has opened the season at home 17 times and is 15-2 in those games. Miami is 29-9 in regular season openers dating to 1979.

WALTON TO CARRY THE LOAD IN JUNIOR SEASON

- In 2016, **Mark Walton** became just the 10th running back in Miami's storied history to rush for over 1,000 yards, totaling 1,117 yards and 14 rushing scores in a sparkling sophomore campaign.
- The impressive feat marked the 11th 1,000-yard rushing season in Miami's storied history at the position and the third straight year the Hurricanes had a 1,000-yard rusher; **Duke Johnson** rushed for 1,652 yards in 2014 while **Joe Yearby** finished with 1,002 yards on the ground in 2015.
- The only player in Miami history with two 1,000-yard seasons is **Edgerrin James** (1997, 1998).
- **James Jackson** (1,006 in 2000), **Clinton Portis** (1,200 in 2001) and **Willis McGahee** (1,753 in 2002) recorded the only other stretch of three straight 1,000-yard rushers in Miami history.
- Walton was named to the preseason watch lists for several major college football awards: the Maxwell Award, the Doak Walker Award and the Walter Camp Player of the Year Award.
- Walton has 25 career touchdowns in 26 career games and is ninth in rushing scores with 23.
- The Miami native was also one of just two running backs named to the All-ACC Preseason Team.

DEFENSE LOOKING TO TAKE THE NEXT STEP IN 2017

- Miami shined on defense in 2016, its first season under the direction of defensive coordinator **Manny Diaz**, eliciting nostalgia from longtime Hurricanes fans with a standout unit.
- At the conclusion of the 2016 season, Miami was ranked No. 20 nationally in total defense (up from No. 69 the previous season), No. 9 in yards per play (No. 86 in 2015), No. 12 in scoring defense (No. 77 in 2015), No. 5 in tackles for loss (No. 105 in 2015), No. 22 in team sacks (No. 70 in 2015) and tied for No. 8 in defensive touchdowns allowed (No. 61 in 2015).
- Miami was the only team in the country to start three true freshmen linebackers in 2016.
- Diaz is the son of the former mayor of Miami, **Manny Diaz, Sr.**

BADG-O-MATIC

- Senior kicker **Michael Badgley** enjoyed another impressive season in 2016, finishing 21-of-26 on field goal attempts and earning third-team All-ACC honors for the second straight year.
- Badgley, who was named to the preseason watch list for the Lou Groza Award, ranks third in Miami history in career made field goals (60). He hit a Miami-record 25 field goals in 2015.
- Badgley needs just 13 field goals to tie **Carlos Huerta's** (1988-91) Miami career record of 73.
- Badgley is a perfect 21-for-21 on field goal attempts between 40 and 49 yards for his career.

#TIGHTENDU TRADITION ALIVE AND WELL

- The Hurricanes are expecting a big year from senior tight end **Christopher Herndon IV**, who hauled in 28 receptions for 334 yards and two touchdowns as a junior a season ago.
- In 29 career games, Herndon has made 15 career starts and totaled 46 receptions, 571 yards and three touchdowns. He started 12 of 13 games at tight end in 2016.
- After a redshirt sophomore season in which he posted career-high totals in catches (43), receiving yards (698) and touchdowns (eight), **David Njoku** was selected in the first round of the 2017 NFL Draft by the Cleveland Browns (No. 29 overall).
- Njoku became the fifth Hurricane tight end drafted in the first round since 2000, joining **Bubba Franks** (2000), **Jeremy Shockey** (2002), **Kellen Winslow** (2004) and **Greg Olsen** (2007).
- Sophomore **Michael Irvin II**, freshman **Brian Polendey** and sophomore Malik Curry are in the mix.

ROSIER NAMED MIAMI'S STARTING QUARTERBACK

- Redshirt junior quarterback **Malik Rosier** was announced as Miami's starting quarterback by head coach **Mark Richt** on Aug. 22, during the final week of Hurricanes fall camp.
- Rosier will be making just the second start of his career when he lines up under center against Bethune-Cookman on Sept. 2; his only other start came Oct. 31, 2015, in a road win at Duke.
- Rosier, who replaces three-year starter and Miami all-time passing yards leader **Brad Kaaya**, finished 20-for-29 for 272 yards and two touchdowns in that 30-27 victory over the Blue Devils.
- Rosier won a four-man quarterback race during training camp, besting redshirt sophomore **Evan Shirreffs** - who was named backup QB - and freshmen **N'Kosi Perry** and **Cade Weldon**.

RICHARDS A RECORD RECEIVER IN FRESHMAN SEASON

- In his freshman season of 2016, wide receiver **Ahmmon Richards** led the Hurricanes with 934 yards receiving - the most ever by a freshman wide receiver at Miami and a figure that ranks as sixth most receiving yards by any Hurricanes player all-time in a single season.
- Richards' 934 yards broke **Michael Irvin's** 31-year-old record of 840, set in 1985.
- Richards' 19.06 yards per reception were tops among all FBS freshman nationally. Richards' 19.06 yards per reception ranked 18th nationally overall, while his 934 receiving yards led all FBS freshmen nationally. Richards was honored as the ACC Rookie of the Week twice in 2016.
- After the year, Richards was named to the All-ACC Second Team and a Freshman All-American.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- Under first-year defensive coordinator **Manny Diaz**, the Hurricanes held opponents to just 4.75 yards per play - a figure that ranked ninth among teams at the FBS level in 2016
- The Hurricanes ranked in the top 25 nationally in four different defensive categories: scoring defense (No. 12/18.5), team sacks (No. 22/2.85), tackles for loss (No. 5/8.3) and total defense (No. 20/345.5). Miami held 11 of its 13 opponents under their 2016 scoring average, including West Virginia in the Russell Athletic Bowl on Dec. 28.
- Miami started and finished games strong in 2016, as it outscored opponents by a combined 166-95 count in the first and fourth quarters of games.
- The Hurricanes held three opponents scoreless in the second half of games last season (Florida A&M, North Carolina and Virginia).
- In its ACC opener against Georgia Tech, Miami's defense accounted for 12 points, as then-freshmen **Shaquille Quarterman** and **Joe Jackson** each returned a fumble for a touchdown.
- In 2016, nine Miami Hurricanes had at least 5.0 tackles for loss on defense. In 2015, just four players finished the season (13 games) with at least 5.0 tackles for loss.

CANES PLAYING IT "KOOL"

- Craig Kuligowski**, who is widely regarded as one of the top defensive line coaches in the country, made an immediate impact in his first season at Miami.
- The Hurricanes finished the regular season fifth in the nation in tackles for loss per game (8.3) and ranked 22nd in sacks per game (2.85).
- Miami finished the regular season with 108 tackles for loss and 38 sacks. In 2015, the Hurricanes recorded 66 tackles for loss and 26 sacks.
- Following the season, Kuligowski - known by players and staff alike as "Coach Kool" - was promoted to Assistant Head Coach/Defensive Line.
- Prior to arriving at Miami, Kuligowski spent 15 years at Missouri, where his defensive line units frequently ranked among the nation's best in tackles for loss and sacks.

MARK RICHT

HEAD COACH | SECOND SEASON AT MIAMI (17TH OVERALL) | 154-55 (.736)

Hurricane alumnus Mark Richt was named the 24th head football coach at The University of Miami on Dec. 4, 2015, by Director of Athletics Blake James.

Richt's 2016 season in Coral Gables was one to remember as he helped guide Miami to its first bowl victory in 10 years, as the Hurricanes captured the 2016 Russell Athletic Bowl, defeating nationally-ranked West Virginia 31-14.

Miami had 10 players earned ACSMA All-ACC honors in 2016, while quarterback Brad Kaaya became Miami's all-time passing yards leader under his tutelage. Freshman wide receiver Ahmmon Richards broke the 31-year-old freshman receiving record at Miami originally set by Michael Irvin, while sophomore running back Mark Walton became the 11th 1,000-yard rusher in program history.

In addition, four Hurricanes earned freshman All-America honors under Richt's watchful eye.

At the conclusion of the regular season, Miami was ranked No. 20 nationally in total defense (up from No. 69 a season ago), No. 9 in yards allowed per play (No. 86 in 2015), No. 12 in scoring defense (No. 77 in 2015), No. 5 in tackles for loss (No. 105 in 2015) No. 22 in offensive yards per play (No. 48 in 2015), No. 37 in offensive touchdowns (No. 80 in 2015), No. 37 in scoring offense (No. 71 in 2015) and No. 22 in team sacks (No. 70 in 2015).

Richt, born in Omaha, Neb., and raised in Boca Raton, Fla., returned to his alma mater after leading the University of Georgia football program for the previous 15 years. He compiled a 145-51 overall record and an 85-40 mark in Southeastern Conference play, won two SEC championships, six SEC East titles and nine bowl games and finished the season in the Associated Press Top-10 rankings seven times.

Richt's .736 winning percentage ranks fifth-best among active FBS head coaches. Richt is one of only seven head coaches in SEC history to record four straight 10-win seasons (2002-05).

During his tenure on the sidelines in Athens, 77 of Richt's players were selected in the NFL Draft over the last 14 years, including eight chosen in the 2002 and 2013 NFL Drafts – the most Georgia players ever selected in a single year.

Off the field, Richt places a strong emphasis on academics and 292 Georgia players earned their degrees during his tenure.

Richt was the 2013 recipient of the Stallings Award given for commitment to humanitarian and community service efforts, and in 2010, he was named to the American Football Coaches Association Board of Trustees.

Before his arrival at Georgia, Richt spent seven seasons as the offensive coordinator at Florida State. In his time in Tallahassee, the Seminoles finished in the nation's top five in scoring offense on five occasions, top 12 in total offense five times and top 12 in passing offense five times.

The 2000 team, which played in the National Championship game against Oklahoma, finished the regular season ranked first nationally in total offense (549.0 ypg), first in passing offense (384.0 ypg), and third in scoring offense (42.4 ppg).

Richt sent six FSU quarterbacks into the NFL between 1987 and 2000. In 2000, Richt coached Chris Weinke to the Heisman Trophy, and in 1991, he coached Casey Weldon to the runner-up for the Heisman. Brad Johnson (now Richt's brother-in-law), was a Pro Bowl selection for Washington in 2000 and led the Tampa Bay Bucs to the Super Bowl title in 2003. Other Richt pro protégés include Danny Kanell (New York Giants), Danny McManus (Kansas City Chiefs) and Peter Tom Willis (Chicago Bears).

Richt played quarterback for the Miami Hurricanes under legendary head coach Howard Schnellenberger.

He spent most of his career at Miami as a backup to Pro Football Hall of Famer and former Buffalo Bills star Jim Kelly. In one of Richt's years at Miami, his teammates included Kelly, Vinny Testaverde and Bernie Kosar and quarterbacks coach Earl Morrall.

Richt is married to the former Katharyn Francis of Tallahassee. The couple has four children – Jonathan, David, Zach, and Anya. Jon, the Miami quarterbacks coach, was married to the former Anna Cearley, in May 2010.
