Miami Reaches NCAA Tournament for Third Consecutive Year...

The 25th-ranked University of Miami Hurricanes will participate in their third consecutive NCAA Tournament when traveling to Ames, Iowa for first and second round action of the Minneapolis [Minn.] Regional. The Hurricanes will join fourth overall seed and host Iowa State, Northern Illinois and Wisconsin-Milwaukee in the bracket.

Miami (25-4) finished the regular season with its highest finish ever since joining the Atlantic Coast Conference with a second place showing in the final standings. The Hurricanes ended the slate with a 16-4 mark in league play, and finished the year with an 11-1 record overall inside the James L. Knight Sports Complex.

In first round action, Miami will take on the Northern Illinois Huskies on Friday, Dec. 2 at 5 p.m. (CST). If the Canes advance, they would face the winner of Iowa State/Milwaukee on Saturday, Dec. 3 at 6:30 p.m. (CST).

Scouting Northern Illinois...

Opening opponent NIU holds a record of 28-6 overall and ended the year 14-2 in the Mid-American Conference. The Huskies lost in the MAC Tournament title match against Central Michigan while the team is receiving votes in this week's AVCA Coaches Poll Top 25.

The Huskies are charged by the nation's leader in kills and points, Lauren Wicinski. The outside hitter has accumulated 639 kills (5.32) and hits at a .304 clip. As a team, the Huskies hit at a .282 clip under the guidance of MAC Coach of the Year, Ray Gooden.

Series against the Huskies...

This will be the first ever meeting between UMiami and UNI.

Scouting Iowa State...

The Iowa State Cyclones will host the first two rounds of the Minneapolis [Minn.] Regional as the fourth overall seed in this year's tournament. The Cyclones are making their sixth consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance. They enter having lost their last match of the regular season to future SEC member Texas A&M.

Kristen Hahn paces the defensive efforts of the team, recently tabbed Big 12 Libero of the Year while pulling in a team-best 537 digs. Teammate Carly Jenson was voted as a unanimous selection to the All-Big 12 First Team after amassing a team-high 372 kills on the

campaign.

Joining Jenson on the All-Big 12 Team were teammates Jamie Straube (236 kills, 87 blocks) and Alison Landwehr (1,103 assists).

Series against the Cyclones...

The Hurricanes have never played the Cyclones in volleyball. It will be the first meeting between the two schools should they advance to play each other in Saturday's bracket title match.

Scouting UW-Milwaukee...

Milwaukee is making its ninth NCAA Tournament appearance, though the Panthers have never won a tournament match and no team from the Horizon League has ever won a match in the tournament. Milwaukee was last in the NCAA Tournament in 2009, losing in five sets to Dayton.

The Panthers hold an overall record of 25-4 and finished their conference season unblemished at 16-0 in the Horizon League. The Panthers enter working on an 18-match winning streak, certainly entering as one of the hottest teams in the nation.

Series against the Panthers...

Miami leads the all-time series against UW-Milwaukee by a 1-0 count, with the Canes taking a 3-0 decision over the Panthers back on Sept. 18, 2004.

Carico Named ACC Player of the Year...

Carico, a senior from Manhattan Beach, Calif., becomes the school's first ACC Volleyball Player of the Year after being named the school's first AVCA All-America performer in 2010. She was tabbed to the AVCA Third Team after helping the Canes to consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances.

During the 2011 campaign, Carico was named ACC Player of the Week four times – Sept. 5, Sept. 12, Oct. 3 and Nov. 28. Carico is the school's all-time leader in kills (1,727), while ranking second in digs (1,696) and fourth in service aces (120). She is also the school's leader in points with 1,948 altogether.

Becker, Carico and Gallagher Earn All-ACC Honors...

In addition to Lane Carico being named ACC Player of the Year, she made her third consecutive appearance on the All-ACC Team, joined by teammates Ali Becker and Katie Gallagher.

Nicole Lantagne Welch

Nicole Lantagne Welch is in her 11th season as head coach of the University of Miami volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in eight of the last 10 seasons,

including ending the 2010 campaign ranked No. 26 in the RPI polls and No. 28 in the Pabo rankings.

Last season, Lantagne Welch helped guide the Canes to their second 20-win season in the last three years, and the second consecutive year in which UMiami advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Miami ended the season with a 23-9 overall mark (13-7 Atlantic Coast Conference) and finished third in the conference regular season standings. Along the way, the Hurricanes defeated NCAA Tournament participants Florida State, Middle Tennessee State, Georgia Southern, Wichita State and North Carolina.

At the end of the year, Lantagne Welch saw her first-ever AVCA All-American honored in the form of Lane Carico, collecting third team accolades following a record-breaking year. Carico became the first player in school history with 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs in a career, as well as leading the ACC in double-doubles – and later being the only player in the league to amass at least 400 kills and 400 digs on the campaign.

Carico and teammate Katie Gallagher each claimed AVCA All-East Region Team honors, while freshman libero Ryan Shaffer set a new school record for digs by a freshman (539 / 4.53 per set). As for Carico, she would also earn her



third consecutive All-ACC Team nod and All-East Region honor.

In 2009, Lantagne Welch helped the Hurricanes to their second NCAA Tournament appearance, competing in the Gainesville [Fla.] Regional. UM earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament after holding the 33rd toughest schedule in the nation according to the end-of-year RPI rankings. Earlier in the season, Lantagne Welch guided the Hurricanes to the Hampton Inn & Suites Northern Colorado Classic championship.

She would add to her growing list of All-Atlantic Coast Conference student-athletes, as well as All-America honorable mention performers, seeing senior libero Cassie Loessberg and sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico named to both lists. Carico and Loessberg each collected AVCA All-America Honorable Mention selections, while both were tabbed to the AVCA All-East Region Team.

During the 2008 campaign, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002. During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama.

The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif.

For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.

Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team.

Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by four seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08, '10) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her 10 years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 19.2 wins per seasons with a career record of 192-109.

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a

major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Coral Gables.

Hurricanes VB Media Policy

KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, in-between the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Alex Rodriguez Park, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Office of Athletic Communications. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-set and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post match notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Athletic Communications Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Becker leads the ACC with a .398 hitting percentage and ranks second on the Hurricanes squad with 92 blocks this season. She also ranks second on the team with 314 kills (2.99 k/s). In her career, Becker is fourth all-time at UMiami in total blocks (309), tied for fifth in block solos (38) and sits in sole possessions of fifth place in assisted blocks (271). She is also eighth all-time in points (1,008.5) and ninth in kills (828).

Redshirt senior setter Katie Gallagher became the school's all-time leader in assists in early-November, now holding 5,105 in her career. This is her second All-ACC recognition after being named to the All-Freshman Team in 2007. Gallagher sat out a majority of the 2009 season with injury, earning the Winter Park, Fla. native a medical hardship waiver to compete this season.

Miami Seeking First NCAA Win Since 2002...

Three consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament for the University of Miami volleyball team was not the goal at the beginning of the year. Advancing past the opening round and beyond was the goal. The Canes have not won an NCAA match since advancing to the Sweet 16 of the 2002 tournament. UMiami has been defeated in five-set thrillers each of the past two seasons in Gainesville [Fla.] and Bloomington [Ind.].

20 Wins, No Problem...

With a 25-4 overall record, the Hurricanes have won at least 20 matches in consecutive years, as well as the third time in the last four seasons.

Carico Sets Another School Record...

Lane Carico was named as this past week's Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Week, giving the All-America senior her fourth of its kind this season. For Carico, the award is a record for UMiami since joining the ACC in 2004. Overall, Carico has now tallied seven ACC Player of the Week awards since 2009. She also ties Jill Robinson for the most conference weekly awards in one season after Robinson grabbed four BIG EAST Rookie of the Week awards in 2003.

Always Bet on Becker...

Senior middle blocker Ali Becker has surged onto the scene this year for the Hurricanes. The Katy, Texas native leads the league in hitting percentage and ranks 10th nationally in that category as she hits at a .398 clip. She leads the UMiami history books in that department, and is the highest ranked Hurricane ever in the NCAA for hitting percentage.

Miami Says Farewell to Special Quartet...

In its match against NC State on Sunday, Nov. 6, the University of Miami celebrated "Senior Day" for a special group of players that have undoubtedly been one of the best groups to ever play for the Orange and Green. The Hurricanes bid farewell to seniors Ali Becker, Lane Carico, Katie Gallagher and Christine Williamson—a group that has taken UM to three consecutive NCAA Tournaments (2009-11).

Since 2008, the Hurricanes have a record of 92-32 (.742).

Gallagher Sets the Mark...

Redshirt senior setter Katie Gallagher is UMiami's all-time leader in assists, now holding

5,105 in her career. Earlier in November, the Winter Park, Fla. native passed Jill Robinson (2003-06) on the all-time list.

Carico Named Lowe's Senior CLASS Finalist...

Lane Carico of the University of Miami has been selected as one of 10 finalists for this year's Lowe's Senior CLASS Award for volleyball. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition.

Carico, an outside hitter from Manhattan Beach, Calif., became Miami's all-time leader in kills during the second set of the Hurricanes' 3-0 win over Duke on Sunday, Oct. 2. The 2010 AVCA Third Team All-America player currently has 1,532 kills throughout her career. She also ranks second all-time in points (1,733), third in kills per set (3.75), third in digs (1,505), fourth in service aces (109) and eighth in sets played (409).

On the campaign, Carico has helped the Hurricanes to their first-ever regular season ranking with the Canes getting as high as No. 20 in Week Five. Carico is fourth in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) in kills with 186 (3.44 per set), fifth in digs with 233 (4.31 per set) and fourth in points with 212.5 (3.94 per set). She's also second on the team with 15 service aces.

Carico Sets School Record for Kills...

Senior outside hitter Lane Carico's fourth kill of the match versus Duke on October 2 allowed her to etch her name as the school's all-time leader in

kills, surpassing Karla Johnson (2002-05) atop the list. Currently, Carico has 1,589 career kills.

Coaching Milestone Achieved...

UMiami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch collected her 200th career win following the Hurricanes 3-0 win over Auburn. Lantagne Welch is already the winningest coach in UM volleyball history, and has served as the only coach since the program was brought back in 2001.

Miami on the National Stage...

In a pair of nationally televised games this year, UM went 1-1 against Florida State and Virginia Tech, respectively. The Canes dropped a tough decision at FSU on ESPNU, while bouncing back to sweep Virginia Tech last weekend on Fox Sports at home in Coral Gables.

Miami Takes Hurricane Invitational Title...

With wins against FAMU, Auburn and nationally ranked Oklahoma, the Hurricanes collected their second consecutive Hurricane Invite title inside the James L. Knight Sports Complex. Overall, the Canes have won four of the last five Hurricane Invitational titles. The win over No. 18 Oklahoma was the first win for the Hurricanes over a ranked team since Dec. 7, 2002 when they defeated No. 15 Wisconsin in the Madison [Wis.] Regional of the NCAA Tournament.

Carico, Gallagher, Johnson All-Tournament...

Lane Carico, Katie Gallagher and Alex Johnson were all named to the Hurricane Invitational All-Tournament Team after helping UMiami to the tournament title. Carico picked up Hurricane Invitational MVP honors in staking a season-high 19 kills and posting 16 digs in the championship match win over the Sooners.

Gallagher Moves Into Record Books...

During the Hurricane Invitational, redshirt senior setter Katie Gallagher became just the second player in UMiami volleyball history to post at least 4,000 assists and 1,000 digs in a career. She joins Jill Robinson (2003-06) as the only other Hurricanes player to do so.

Carico Takes Top Honors...

Senior All-America outside hitter Lane Carico finished as the top offensive performer at the *Pepperdine Asics Classic*. She was named the Tournament MVP after helping Miami to the tournament title.

Canes Take Tiger Classic Title...

UMiami took down LSU in the title match of the Tiger Classic to begin the 2011 regular season inside the Maravich Center in Baton Rouge, La. For the Canes, it marked the fourth consecutive year they have won a regular season tournament on the road.

Carico & Gallagher Named Preseason All-ACC...

Senior outside hitter **Lane Carico** and redshirt senior **Katie Gallagher** were named to the Preseason All-ACC Team announced Tuesday by the ACC Office. Carico has been named to the All-ACC Team the last two years and the All-ACC Freshman Team in 2008.

Last Time Out - vs. #21 Florida State (Nov. 26)...

Lane Carico staked a season-high 29 kills as the 25th-ranked University of Miami Hurricanes upset the No. 21 Florida State Seminoles, 3-1, in Atlantic Coast Conference volleyball action on Saturday inside the James L. Knight Sports Complex. The Canes won the match on scores of 25-16, 33-31, 21-25 and 25-22.

The Hurricanes dominated the opening set by a 25-16 decision.

UMiami limited FSU to just .212 hitting in the opening frame while using a match-high .481 clip themselves. Redshirt freshman middle blocker Emani Sims and outside hitter Carico each posted five kills in the opening set, while Sims went on to collect three blocks and sophomore right side Alex Johnson contributed five assists.

The second set saw 13 ties and four lead changes – three of which came with at least one team serving for set-point down the stretch. The

end result would be the longest set played inside the Knight Sports Complex since moving to the 25-point set system in 2008.

Miami raced out to an early 8-2 run behind kills from senior middle blocker Ali Becker, Johnson and Carico. The Seminoles chipped into the lead and eventually took their first lead of the match at 19-18 on the strength of a kill from Elise Walch. Teammate Visnja Djurdjevic was a spark behind the run, rallying her team with four kills during the comeback. FSU served for set-point, 24-23, before Miami sophomore outside hitter Taylor Hollins punched home a kill followed by a kill from Carico. That allowed the Canes to serve their first chance at set-point.

The Canes would serve for set-point five more times down the stretch until Sims put the Canes ahead on a block, 32-31. The match stretched to 2-0 in favor of the Canes after Carico placed a kill for the 33-31 edge.

After FSU collected a 25-21 victory in the third set, Miami appeared determined in the final frame.

Player of the Year Lane Carico put down 10 kills and redshirt senior setter and All-ACC performer Katie Gallagher setup 16 assists in the final frame. Added four kills from Johnson and two more All-ACC player Ali Becker and redshirt senior outside hitter Christine Williamson, and

the Hurricanes evened the yearly series against the Seminoles, 25-22, in the final set.

Florida State was led in the match by five players reaching double figures for kills. Djurdjevic collected 16, followed by Sareea Freeman (12), Rachael Morgan (13), Jekaterina Stepanova (10) and Ashley Neff (10). Stepanova added 20 digs for a double-double performance, as well as Djurdjevic with 18 digs to collect her double-double.

Miami used blocking as the key to the match as they took a commanding 11-4 advantage at the net. Sims picked up a season-high tying nine blocks, while Carico collected five and Johnson three.

Carico's match-high and season-high 29 kills led all players while she also accounted for 17 digs and a double-double – her 11th consecutive. Carico also staked a .410 hitting percentage in the match. Sims produced 14 kills and hit .333 in the match, while Tampa native Williamson tallied 11 kills. Johnson had 10 digs and nine kills, combined with Gallagher's double-double effort of 56 assists and 16 digs.

It was sophomore libero Ryan Shaffer of the Hurricanes collecting a team-high 19 digs.

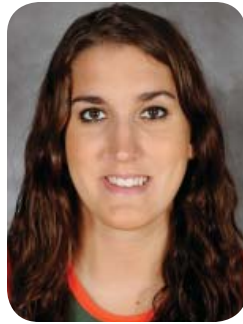

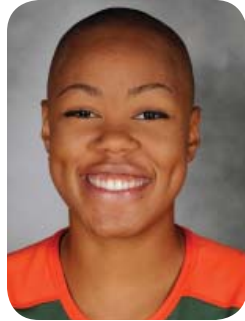
