

2002-03 Season Review

Expectations were high heading into the 2002-03 season. Miami was coming off a record-breaking season in 2001-02 in which the Hurricanes finished 24-8 and advanced to the NCAA tournament for the fourth time in five seasons. In addition, Miami would be moving into its new \$48 million on-campus arena. Unfortunately, the Hurricanes returned just two starters from the 2001-02 team and would be forced to rely on freshmen during key stretches throughout the season. Miami was without three key components to its success the previous season.

Point guard John Salmons was taken in the first round of the 2002 NBA draft, center Elton Tyler was playing professional basketball overseas, and shooting guard Marcus Barnes was dismissed from the team for violation of team rules during the summer.

The Hurricanes' two returning starters were Darius Rice and James Jones. Rice (18.7 ppg) and Jones (16.9 ppg) were forced to carry the scoring load for the Hurricanes, and the two averaged a combined 35.6 points per game or 50 percent of the team's total points.

In addition, Miami freshmen Robert Hite (18 games), Armondo Surraitt (15 games), Eric Wilkins (9 games) and Gary Hamilton (8 games) started a combined 50 games during the season marking the most combined starts by a group of UM freshmen since the 1985-86 season.

Miami's youth showed as the Hurricanes struggled to win the close games going 3-11 in games decided by five points or less, and 1-4 in overtime contests.

Despite the 11-17 record Miami had several highlights during the season. The Hurricanes christened their new on-campus arena with a thrilling 64-61 overtime win versus North Carolina on January 4. Rice, who scored 17 points, nailed a three-pointer at the end of regulation to tie the score, then provided the only field goal in overtime to lead Miami to the win.

Miami's next home game against 11th-ranked Connecticut saw Rice put on a scoring display that caught the attention of the nation. Rice poured in a career-high 43 points including a steal and three-point basket as time expired to give Miami the improbable come-from-behind win. The 43 points tied him for third on the BIG EAST all-time single-game scoring list.

The win over the Huskies marked the ninth consecutive season in which the Hurricanes had defeated a ranked opponent.

In 2002-03 Rice was "Mr. Clutch" for the Hurricanes hitting three-pointers at the end of four games to either win the game or send the game to overtime.

The season also saw Rice and Jones join the 1,000-point club. Jones posted 26 points against Arkansas-Pine Bluff on December 18 to become the 25th player in UM history to surpass 1,000 career points. In Miami's double-overtime defeat to Florida on December 21 Rice poured in 32 points becoming the 26th player in UM history to reach the 1,000-point plateau.

Rice was named first-team All-District 6 for the second consecutive season by the National Association of Basketball Coaches joining former Hurricane great Tim James (1998, 1999) as the only Hurricanes to earn first-team All-District honors in consecutive seasons. Rice was also named third-team All-BIG EAST by a vote of the league's coaches.

Jones also took home hardware during the season. Jones was named to the 2002-03 Verizon Academic All-America second-team becoming the first Hurricane basketball player to garner Academic All-America distinction.

James Jones recorded 14 points and eight rebounds to lead five Hurricanes in double-figures as the University of Miami knocked off Texas A&M, 78-72, at Miami Arena.

Jones, who was in foul trouble most of the game, scored nine of his points in the second-half including the go-ahead basket with 1:14 to play.

Darius Rice and Robert Hite each added 13 points, Rafael Berumen netted a career-high 12 and Rodrigue Diahue registered 10, his first double-figure scoring game since the 2000-01 season.

Hite, who scored 13 in Miami's opener, is the first freshman since Steven Edwards in 1992 to open the season with consecutive double-figure scoring games.

James Jones scored a career-high 26 points to lead the University of Miami to a 79-42 win over Arkansas Pine-Bluff at Miami Arena snapping the Hurricanes' three-game losing streak.

Miami began the game on a 20-2 run and led 28-6 with 8:56 left in the first half. The Hurricanes shot 57 percent in the half compared to the Golden Lions' 27 percent, and won the rebounding battle, 26-10.

Jones, who surpassed the 1,000-point total for his career, scored 10 points as part of a 16-0 Miami run to end the half. The Hurricanes led 57-16, the lowest first half total for a Miami opponent since Lehigh scored 12 on Dec. 30, 1996.

The Hurricanes were outscored in the second half, 26-22, mostly playing with reserves. Arkansas Pine-Bluff sank just 6-of-16 free throws and made only one 3-point shot.

Robert Hite recorded his first career double-double for Miami, scoring 13 points and grabbing a team season-high 13 rebounds. Darius Rice added 18 points. Kory McKee led UAPB with 14.

Justin Hamilton's free throw with six seconds left in the second overtime period lifted 13th-ranked Florida to a 94-93 win over the University of Miami in the Wachovia Orange Bowl Basketball Classic at American Airlines Arena.

Freshman Matt Walsh scored an Orange Bowl Classic record 33 points, pulled down 11 rebounds and dished out five assists to pace the Gators. Matt Bonner added 16 points and 12 rebounds and Hamilton contributed 15 points for Florida. Miami rallied from a 43-29 halftime deficit to force overtime. Darius Rice's three-pointer with 26.4 seconds left in regulation forged a 72-72 tie and sent the game to overtime.

Rice finished with 32 points for the Hurricanes, while James Jones scored 26 and Armondo Surraat added 13. Jones scored five points in the first overtime. His three-pointer with 54.9 seconds left put Miami ahead 81-80. His layup with 3.2 seconds to go forged an 83-83 tie and forced another five-minute extra period.

In the second overtime session, a basket by Jones with 35.9 seconds to go pulled Miami into a 93-93 tie, the ninth deadlock in the two overtimes. Then Hamilton broke the tie at the foul line for Florida by hitting the first of two shots.

Miami's final shot, a three-point attempt by Surraat from the right wing, missed as time expired.
