Hurricanes Travel to Wake Forest and Duke for ACC Matches...

The University of Miami travels to the state of North Carolina this week, set for matches with Wake Forest and Duke in a critical ACC road stretch for the Hurricanes. Miami is seeking to get above the .500 mark in the ACC this week, and will need a sweep of Wake Forest and ACC-unbeaten Duke to do so.

Last year, Miami knocked off Duke for the first time in Durham before then falling at Wake Forest in a stunning loss. Wake Forest was the only team to sweep the Hurricanes in league play last season.

UM is currently led by Lane Carico leads the conference in both kills (243) and kills per set (4.19). Her 36 kills against Clemson and 30 against Georgia Tech are the top-two performances in the ACC this season, and her 83 attacks against Clemson and 72 against Georgia Tech are also the two best marks in the league.

The Hurricanes bounced back from tough consecutive five-set losses to take down previously ACC-unbeaten Georgia Tech at home last weekend. The 'Canes are hoping to keep that momentum alive when they travel north this weekend.

Quick Hits on Wake Forest

The Wake Forest Demon Deacons come into Thursday night's match sporting just a 6-10 overall record, but holding a 4-1 record in ACC play. After starting the season 0-10, the Demon Deacons are surging, winning six consecutive matches—including four conference matches. Those ACC wins include 3-1 wins over Virginia, Virginia Tech and Maryland, respectively.

WFU is led by five players who have topped 100 kills on the year, most notably Kadijah Fornah (145) and Carlin Salmon (134). Setter Kelsey Jones is leading the way in assists with 497, and libero Abby Miller leads the defensive charge with 218 digs. Salmon is the leader in blocks, collecting 60 (50 assisted) on the campaign.

Series Against Wake Forest

Miami leads the all-time series between these two schools by the narrowest of margins, 5-4. Wake Forest swept the Hurricanes last season, both coming by 3-0 decisions. The last UM win was a 3-0 victory back on Nov. 3, 2007.

Quick Hits on Duke ...

Duke is currently 14-2 on the year, and a perfect 5-0 in ACC (the only remaining unbeaten team in

league play). Of the Blue Devils two losses, one came at the hands of top-ranked and defending national champion Penn State. Since that loss, Duke has rolled off six consecutive wins.

The Blue Devils are led by Becci Burling and Sophia Dunworth, each with 143 kills on the year. Burling also has a team-leading 56 total blocks (49 assisted). Behind them is Rachael Moss with 125 kills. The assists are handled by Kellie Catanach, currently leading the ACC with 569. The libero for the Blue Devils is Claire Smalzer, topping the team with 152 digs.

Series Against Duke

Duke leads the all-time series against the Hurricanes by a count of 7-3. Last season, Miami swept the Blue Devils for the first time, and collected their first win over Duke since Dec. 6, 2002 as part of the NCAA Tournament. UM swept the Blue Devils at home, while taking a 3-1 win in Durham.

<u>Carico Named ACC & CVU.com</u> <u>Player of the Week...</u>

Lane Carico was named this week's ACC Volleyball Player of the Week (Oct. 5-11), as well as CVU.com National Player of the Week announced this week. In two matches last weekend, Carico totaled 66 kills for a 6.60 kills per set average, a .303 hitting percentage, 33 digs for a 3.30 digs per set average, one service ace, and two total blocks.

Carico Sets School Records...

Sophomore Lane Carico shattered two school records in two matches for the Hurricanes last weekend. She eclipsed the UM school record for kills in a match with 36 coming against Clemson on Friday, Oct. 2. Carico bested the old mark of 31 previously set by Karla Johnson (vs. Wake Forest – 10/22/05). She also set a new record at UM for points in a match, posting 37.5 against Clemson, adding a service ace and a block assists to go along with her 36 kills. Carico would also break the school record for attacks in a match with 83 against the Clemson Tigers. Two days later, Carico set yet another school record in becoming the first player in UM history to register back-to-back 30-kill performances, picking up an even 30 in a 3-2 victory over Georgia Tech.

Loessberg Takes the Top Spot ...

marks Nicole Lantagne Welch's ninth year at the helm of the University Miami of women's volleyball program. Under guidance her since 2001, the team has posted winning records in six

season

of the last eight seasons, including a secondplace finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

Last season, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002. During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the 'Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama.

The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the 'Canes to three inseason tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif.

For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.



Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named t the All-ACC Volleyball Team.

Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by three seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her eight years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 18.9 wins per seasons with a career record of 151-87.

While new records were set during the 2007 campaign, the 2008 season saw even those records fall as Lantagne Welch and her staff assembled one of the best records in school history. Lantagne Welch led Miami to its best ACC record in school history. It was also the second-best record in school history on the Division I level of athletics.

Katie Gallagher moved in sole possession of second place all-time at UM for assists in a career during the 2008 season, while Cassie Loessberg placed herself in second place for digs in a career. In addition, Loessberg broke her own school record from a year ago for digs in a single-season, upping the new record to 554—besting her old school-record mark by two.

As for Gallagher, she etched her name once again as one of the Top 10 single-season assists leaders in school history. Already sitting at third place in school history from the 2007 season where she collected 1,243 assists, Gallagher added to that total with 1,202 in 2008—good enough for sixth place all-time in school history.

Freshman Lane Carico broke the freshman record for kills in a single-season for UM with 369, adding her name to 10th all-time for single-season kills. Meanwhile, Miami tied a school-record for hitting percentage in a five-set match, collecting a .329 percentage at Florida State on Nov. 26, 2008. The 'Canes would also collect the second-best single-set hitting mark in school history with a .615 clip against Boston College in the third set on Oct. 10, 2008.

Lantagne Welch would see two more 2 student-athletes graduate following the 2008 season. Angelica Ellis and Bridget Bomhack both earned their Bachelor's Degree, while 2 Ashley Woods completed her Master's 2 Degree. 2

Woods placed her name eighth all-time in sets played (367), as well as eighth place alltime in total attacks (1,764). Ellis now ranks ninth in attacks (1,209), while also collecting the third-highest individual single-season hitting percentage (.350) from the 2008 campaign. Overall, Ellis is third in school history in career hitting percentage with a .275 clip through 318 sets and 1,209 attacks. Woods is tied for fifth in career hitting percentage, holding a .256 clip, sitting alongside Ciara Michel (2004-07).

The eighth-year head coach also coached three All-ACC Second Team members with

Lane Carico, Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. In addition, Carico and Ellis were each named as AVCA All-America honorable mention, while Carico was selected the 2008 AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico was also the true definition of "student-athlete" as she was named to the All-ACC Academic Team.

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Media Relations Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fanbased features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

Sundararaman Already Moving Up...

Freshman setter/right side hitter Nrithya Sundararaman has quickly made a move on the all-time assists charts at UM, placing herself sixth with 307 assists. She has shared time with Katie Gallagher to quickly vault her way near the middle of the UM all-time list.

On These Dates in History...

On the dates for Oct. 8 and 9 throughout UM volleyball history, the Hurricanes hold a combined record of 6-3 overall. For matches played on Oct. 8, Miami is 4-1, with -9/5 vs. North Dakota State (50 assists, 15 digs) the last match being a 3-0 defeat to North Carolina in 2005 in Coral Gables. For Oct. 9 matches, UM is an even 2-2, with the last match played being a 3-2 setback at Maryland | - 9/19 vs. Notre Dame (15 kills, 15 digs) in 2004.

ACC Double Trouble ...

ACC teams have combined for 121 doubledoubles this season. NC State leads with 19 double-doubles, and is followed by Clemson with 17, and Miami with 13. Miami sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico has recorded a double-double in five straight matches, the longest streak in the ACC this season.

Mayhew Shooting for 1,000...

Senior outside hitter Genny Mayhew is closing in on 1,000 kills as she now has 997 kills in her career. If she cracks the 1,000-kill plateau, she will be just the fifth UM player all-time to have eclipsed that mark. Currently, she ranks fifth alltime at UM in career kills.

UM Present on All-ACC Preseason Team ...

Three student-athletes from Miami are on this year's Preseason All-ACC Team for head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch. For Mayhew, this is her second consecutive ACC Preseason accolade.

Duke Predicted to Win ACC Regular Season...

The Duke University volleyball team is predicted to win the 2009 Atlantic Coast Conference championship and headlines a list of 18 student-athletes selected to the 2009 Preseason All-ACC volleyball team, as announced today by Commissioner John D. Swofford.

Duke takes in 116 of a possible 121 points, including seven of 12 first place votes. Coaches' votes for the predicted order of finish were tallied with 11 points being applied to a firstplace vote, 10 points for a second-place vote, etc. Coaches were not permitted to predict their own team's order of finish.






















Just 17 points separate the top-four teams as Florida State, Miami, and North Carolina also take in first-place votes. Florida State follows Duke in second place with 104 points and three first-place votes, while Miami is tabbed to finish in third with 101 points and one first-place vote. North Carolina lands in fourth with 99 points and one first-place vote.

Clemson is tabbed fifth with 75 points, and is followed by Virginia Tech (71), Virginia (62), Georgia Tech (49), Wake Forest (47), Maryland (33), NC State (21), and Boston College (14).

Last Time Out - vs. Georgia Tech (10/4/09)...

Sophomore Lane Carico tallied a match-high 30 kills to help lead the University of Miami past visiting Georgia Tech, 3-2 (25-22, 24-26, 31-29, 25-27, 15-9), Sunday afternoon in an ACC volleyball matchup held at the James L. Knight Sports Complex in Coral Gables, Fla.

Two days after suffering its third heartbreaking five-set defeat of the season, Miami (9-6, 2-3 ACC) had to try and bounce back against ACC-unbeaten Georgia Tech on Sunday. The outcome was yet another five-set thriller—this time going in the direction of the Hurricanes.

UM jumped out to a quick 10-4 advantage in the opening set behind the play of Christine Williamson and Lici McGee. A kill from McGee, one of five for the Warr Acres, Okla. native in the opening set, provided the 'Canes with the six-point edge early-on. Williamson's kill seven points later gave the 'Canes a 13-8 advantage.

Georgia Tech (10-5, 4-1 ACC) came roaring back behind three of Miami's 10 attack errors in the opener, earning a 13-13 tie. The Yellow Jackets took their second lead of the set with a kill from Monique Mead, giving Georgia Tech the 14-13 lead.

Following five more ties and three lead changes, McGee stamped back-to-back kills to push Miami ahead, 20-18. With UM serving at 23-22, Georgia Tech collected blocks from Asia Stawicka and Mary Ashley Tippins to cut the Hurricanes lead at 23-22. The 'Canes earned the 25-22 win with an attack error charged to GT, as well as a kill from senior outside hitter Maria Andersson.

In the second, UM led late, 20-18, following an attack error charged to the Yellow Jackets. Lane Carico registered 11 kills in the set, including one that broke a 20-all tie to give UM the one-point edge. UM served for set-point at 24-22 after a kill from Williamson.

However, Georgia Tech stormed back with a kill from Chrissy DeMichelis and Mead, tying the match at 24-24. The Yellow Jackets earned the win, 26-24, on kills from Bailey Hunter and Brittany Roderick.

Georgia Tech went up 3-0 in the third set before Miami

used a 4-0 run to take the lead, assisted by blocks from Andersson and Ali Becker. Miami later used a kill from Ariell Cooke to vault to a 16-10 advantage. However, Georgia Tech would fight back to tie the set, 21-21 with a kill from Susan Carlson and strong play from Mead.

There would be 13 ties and seven lead changes in the set.

With UM trailing 28-27, Georgia Tech was charged with a service error that tied the set, before once again serving for set-point, 29-28. A kill from Williamson put UM back in a tie at 29-all, while blocks from Becker and setter Nrithya Sundararaman gave the 'Canes the lead, 30-29.

An attack error charged to GT was how the set ended, giving UM the 31-29 edge, and the 2-1 lead in the match.

In the fourth set, Georgia Tech's Mead posted one of her four kills in the set to tie the score at 24-24 as UM's Lizzie Hale served for set-point moments prior. A kill from Carico, and an attack error on the 'Canes, tied the set again at 25-25.

GT took the lead and the set-point, 27-25, courtesy consecutive attack errors on Miami.

With Miami playing its third-straight Sunday of fiveset volleyball, and the fourth in the last five matches, McGee and Carico put the 'Canes on their back to try and end the five-set jinx that had previously haunted the Hurricanes.

Carico broke open a 3-3 tie with consecutive kills, while later combining with McGee for a block to stretch the UM lead at 8-4 when the two teams traded sides of the court.

McGee recorded two kills to widen the UM lead, 10-4, before the Yellow Jackets' DeMichelis posted a kill to decrease the UM lead, 12-7. An attack error called on UM would bring GT to within 12-8 before UM head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch called timeout.

Two costly errors on Georgia Tech pushed Miami's lead to 14-8, and a kill from Ali Becker sealed the win for the Hurricanes, 15-9.

Miami was paced by Carico's 30 kills, now giving her back-to-back matches with at least 30 kills. She becomes just the second player in UM history to eclipse 30 kills in two or more matches in her career, joining Karla Johnson in that feat. Carico also had 16 digs for her seventh double-double of the year—and her fifth consecutive. Sophomore Christine Williamson registered a careerhigh 14 kills and one solo block. Also hitting doubledigits in kills was McGee with 12. McGee would add six blocks (five assists) in the process.

Libero Cassie Loessberg picked up a match-high 32 digs, giving her five matches in her career with 30-or more digs. That's tops in school history for that category. Setter Sundararaman led the offense with 54 assists and nine digs, adding five blocks (four assists).


