**Hurricanes Prepare for ACC Foes in Virginia and Virginia Tech...**

The University of Miami will look to snap a two-match losing streak, including a loss in Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) play, this weekend when the Hurricanes host ACC foes Virginia and Virginia Tech to the James L. Knight Sports Complex.

Miami did not host the Cavaliers or Hokies last season, instead making a trip to Virginia for a pair of match-ups. UM lost both matches in what turned out to be key conference meetings in the middle of the season. The 'Canes lost back-to-back matches twice in 2008, the latter being the road trip to Virginia and Virginia Tech.

Genny Mayhew enters the match against Virginia looking to become just the fifth player in Miami history to eclipse the 1,000-kills plateau. The Preseason All-ACC Team member has 997 kills under her belt—good enough to rank her fifth place all-time for kills in school history. She trails Elizabeth Tyson (2001-04) by five kills overall.

Miami will look to move onto the up-side of the ACC standings if they can string together a pair of wins, currently sitting 0-1 after a setback (L, 0-3) at 19th-ranked Florida State last Friday in Tallahassee.

Quick Hits on Virginia...

The Virginia Cavaliers come into the weekend with an even 6-6 record overall, and a 1-0 record in the ACC. They are led by the play of Lauren Dickson and Simone Asque. Dickson has a team-best 149 kills, while Asque is just behind with 127 kills. The setter for Virginia is Rachel Gray, holding 379 assists. Three Cavaliers have 100-or more digs, led primarily by AJ Cushman with 153.

Virginia has already defeated in-state rival Virginia Tech in its only other ACC match to this point.

Series Against Virginia...

The University of Virginia leads the all-time series between these two teams by a count of 6-3, including winning the last two consecutively. The last UM win came back on Sept. 21, 2007 in a 3-2 decision for the 'Canes. Virginia took last year's meeting in one of the most exciting matches of the year courtesy a 3-2 decision, using the last three sets to earn the come-from-behind victory over the Hurricanes in Charlottesville, Va.

Dickson ranks third in the ACC for kills, and Asque enters the weekend seventh.

Quick Hits on Virginia Tech...

Before traveling to Coral Gables, the Virginia

Tech Hokies have a meeting at #18 Florida State in Tallahassee, Fla. The Hokies enter the weekend sporting a 10-2 record, and a 0-1 record in the league after a tough loss against in-state foe Virginia. They hold the fourth-best hitting percentage as a team (.259) and are holding opponents to just .155 hitting—third-best in the ACC.

The Hokies are led by Taylor Parrish with 116 kills, and Felicia Willoughby with 111 kills. The setter position is handled by Erin Leaser with a league-leading 463 assists (10.77 aps). The libero position is charged by Jill Gergen with 171 digs; while Willoughby leads the Hokies in blocks with 56 (10 solo).

Series Against Virginia Tech...

Miami leads the all-time series between these two one-time BIG EAST foes, now ACC competitors, by an 8-4 count. Before dropping the last meeting with a 3-1 count last season in Blacksburg, Va., the Hurricanes had won three-straight against the Hokies. The last win for UM over Virginia Tech was a 3-2 decision in Coral Gables on Oct. 27, 2007.

Loessberg Takes the Top Spot...

With 20 kills in her last match versus Notre Dame, senior libero Cassie Loessberg became Miami's all-time leader in digs with 1,640. In the process, she passed Jamie Grass (2001-04) for the all-time lead in the digs category.

Cassie Setting Records...Again...

Senior libero Cassie Loessberg registered a new school record for digs in a three-set match last weekend, pulling in 39 in a 3-0 victory over Eastern Michigan. In posting a new record, she broke her own school record for that category, having previously set the bar at 23 versus UT-Arlington in 2007.

Mayhew Shooting for 1,000...

Senior outside hitter Genny Mayhew is closing in on 1,000 kills as she now has 997 kills in her career. If she cracks the 1,000-kill plateau, she will be just the fifth UM player all-time to have eclipsed that mark. Currently, she ranks fifth all-time at UM in career kills.

McGee Sitting on the Blocks...

Redshirt junior Lici McGee was noted to be a "player to watch" coming into the season for Miami, and

# Nicole Lantagne Welch

**Head Coach**  
**Ninth Year at Miami**  
**Maryland, 1994**  
**Record at Miami: 158-91**

This season marks Nicole Lantagne Welch's ninth year at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in six

of the last eight seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

Last season, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002. During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the 'Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama.

The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the 'Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif.

For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.



Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team.

Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by three seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her eight years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 18.9 wins per seasons with a career record of 151-87.

While new records were set during the 2007 campaign, the 2008 season saw even those records fall as Lantagne Welch and her staff assembled one of the best records in school history. Lantagne Welch led Miami to its best ACC record in school history. It was also the second-best record in school history on the Division I level of athletics.

Katie Gallagher moved in sole possession of second place all-time at UM for assists in a career during the 2008 season, while Cassie Loessberg placed herself in second place for digs in a career. In addition, Loessberg broke her own school record from a year ago for digs in a single-season, upping the new record to 554—besting her old school-record mark by two.

As for Gallagher, she etched her name once again as one of the Top 10 single-season assists leaders in school history. Already sitting at third place in school history from the 2007 season where she collected 1,243 assists, Gallagher added to that total with 1,202 in 2008—good enough for sixth place all-time in school history.

Freshman Lane Carico broke the freshman record for kills in a single-season for UM with 369, adding her name to 10th all-time for single-season kills. Meanwhile, Miami tied a school-record for hitting percentage in a five-set match, collecting a .329 percentage at Florida State on Nov. 26, 2008. The 'Canes would also collect the second-best single-set hitting mark in school history with a .615 clip against Boston College in the third set on Oct. 10, 2008.

Lantagne Welch would see two more student-athletes graduate following the 2008 season. Angelica Ellis and Bridget Bomhack both earned their Bachelor's Degree, while Ashley Woods completed her Master's Degree.

Woods placed her name eighth all-time in sets played (367), as well as eighth place all-time in total attacks (1,764). Ellis now ranks ninth in attacks (1,209), while also collecting the third-highest individual single-season hitting percentage (.350) from the 2008 campaign. Overall, Ellis is third in school history in career hitting percentage with a .275 clip through 318 sets and 1,209 attacks. Woods is tied for fifth in career hitting percentage, holding a .256 clip, sitting alongside Ciara Michel (2004-07).

The eighth-year head coach also coached three All-ACC Second Team members with

Lane Carico, Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. In addition, Carico and Ellis were each named as AVCA All-America honorable mention, while Carico was selected the 2008 AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico was also the true definition of "student-athlete" as she was named to the All-ACC Academic Team.

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

## Hurricanes VB Media Policy

### KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

### MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

### MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Media Relations Director Bryan J. Harvey.

### WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

### INTERVIEWS

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

Telephone lines at the Knight Sports Complex are limited to home radio and the visiting teams' "official" sports administrator/media relations contact. All media wishing to file stories should contact Bryan J. that has proven true right from the spot. Not only does the Oklahoma native have a team-leading 42 blocks, but she also sits fourth on the team in kills with 81. McGee has collected five or more blocks in three matches this year, including seven in a 3-0 sweep of Albany (N.Y.).

### Hurricanes Top the League in Digs...

Miami owns 594 digs as a team for an average of 15.23 digs per set. That is the best mark in the ACC to date. The average is high because of Loessberg supplying a league-leading 216 digs thus far. Clemson's Didem Ege sits second with 211 digs of her own.

### It's Becker at the Net...

Sophomore Ali Becker may have tailed off a bit after starting strong for Miami in 2008, but she is back and playing better than ever for the 'Canes as a sophomore. The Katy, Texas native is second on the team in blocks (39) while adding a team third-best 82 kills. That goes along with 12 digs from her middle blocker position. Becker is at the net, and making plays for UM.

### All In the Family...

While Lane Carico leads the Hurricanes in kills (138) on the year and is the reigning ACC and AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year, her sister has done quite well for herself in volleyball as well. Taylor Carico, a senior setter at the University of Minnesota—formerly a three-time All-Conference performer at the University of Southern California (PAC-10) leads the Golden Gophers in assists (322), while adding 86 digs and 26 blocks. Thus proving, it's all in the family for volleyball with the Carico sisters.

### On These Dates in History...

The University of Miami is 3-1 all-time in matches played on Sept. 25 and 27, respectively. The Hurricanes last match on either of these dates was probably one of the most important in history—a 3-1 victory over Duke on Sept. 25, 2008 in Durham, N.C. It marked Miami's first-ever victory over Duke in Durham, and just the second all-time against the Blue Devils.

### K.L.C.G is on the Air...

The station K (Katie), L (Lane), C (Cassie), G (Genny) is making its inaugural debut on the airwaves as all four players are set to hit the floor in possible record-breaking performances. All but one (Katie Gallagher) student-athlete is from the west coast where the call letters begin with "K" and the people are eagerly watching K.L.C.G each and every match.

### Let's Play 'Em All at Knight?...

The Miami Hurricanes are eager to go home of late after collecting a record of 12-1 inside the James L. Knight Sports Complex in 2008. The 'Canes lone loss was a setback to ACC foe Wake Forest. UM is already 4-1 on the year at home.

### UM Present on All-ACC Preseason Team...

Three student-athletes from Miami are on this year's Preseason All-ACC Team for head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch. Seniors Genny Mayhew and Cassie Loessberg headline the list for UM, while sophomore Lane Carico earns her first Preseason nod as well. For Mayhew, this is her second consecutive ACC Preseason accolade.

Duke Predicted to Win ACC Regular Season...

The Duke University volleyball team is predicted to win the 2009 Atlantic Coast Conference championship and headlines a list of 18 student-athletes selected to the 2009 Preseason All-ACC volleyball team, as announced today by Commissioner John D. Swofford.

Duke takes in 116 of a possible 121 points, including seven of 12 first place votes. Coaches' votes for the predicted order of finish were tallied with 11 points being applied to a first-place vote, 10 points for a second-place vote, etc. Coaches were not permitted to predict their own team's order of finish.

Just 17 points separate the top-four teams as Florida State, Miami, and North Carolina also take in first-place votes. Florida State follows Duke in second place with 104 points and three first-place votes, while Miami is tabbed to finish in third with 101 points and one first-place vote. North Carolina lands in fourth with 99 points and one first-place vote.

Clemson is tabbed fifth with 75 points, and is followed by Virginia Tech (71), Virginia (62), Georgia Tech (49), Wake Forest (47), Maryland (33), NC State (21), and Boston College (14).

Last Time Out - vs. Notre Dame (9/19/09)...

Senior libero Cassie Loessberg became Miami's all-time leader in digs Saturday afternoon as the University of Miami volleyball team dropped a 3-2 decision (25-17, 25-23, 21-25, 15-25, 13-15) to Notre Dame in the final match of the Seminole Tri-Match at Tully Gym in Tallahassee, Fla.

Miami (7-4) led 2-0 heading into the third set after collecting 25-17 and 25-23 wins in the opening sets.

In the third set, UM led 9-5 until Notre Dame (6-3) went on a 4-0 run to tie the set, 9-9. The Fighting Irish used Hurricanes attack errors and a service ace from Megan Dunne to take a 14-10 lead.

The Irish would use blocks from Kellie Sciacca and Serinity Phillips down the stretch to close-out the 25-21 win, forcing the match to a fourth set.

Notre Dame trailed for a total of two serves in the fourth set as Phillips, Sciacca and Kristen Dealy all tallied four kills apiece to help the Fighting Irish to a 25-15 victory, tying the match at two sets apiece.

With the match on the line heading into the fifth and decisive set, Miami led 3-2 following a kill from Carico off a Gallagher assist. Notre Dame immediately answered with back-to-back blocks from Christina Kaelin and Sciacca to go up 5-4.

An attack error by the Irish tied the set, 6-6.

The Irish extended their lead to 10-7 with more blocks from Dealy and Sciacca, as well as Megan Fesl. But the Hurricanes bounced back to within 11-10 when Lici McGee and Genny Mayhew combined for a block at the net, as well as another kill from Carico.

Dealy and Phillips came back for kills to push the Irish further in front, 13-10.

A final block from Phillips and Tara Enzweiler closed the match, giving the Irish a 15-13 decision en route to the 3-2 match victory.

Notre Dame had four players in double-digits for kills, led by Serinity Phillips with 18 kills, 13 digs and four block assists. Sciacca added 14 kills and a match-high seven blocks. Matching Sciacca's 14 kills was teammate Dealy—also posting 11 digs.

Notre Dame's Christina Kelin had 11 kills and six digs.

Miami was led by Carico's double-double effort of 16 kills and 23 digs. She also tallied two service aces and two block assists. Senior Genny Mayhew recorded 15 kills and 15 digs for her first double-double of the year, also tallying three blocks.

Sophomore middle blocker Ali Becker registered 14 kills and four block assists. Mayhew remains three kills shy of adding her name to the list of players in UM history with 1,000 kills.

But the story of the day for UM, statistically, was Cassie Loessberg tallying 20 digs from her libero position to become the school's all-time leader in digs. She now has 1,640 digs in her career wearing Orange and Green.
