THE FACTS...

Miami comes into this weekend with a pair of wins last week to build upon. The Hurricanes now venture back into ACC waters with opponents Boston College and Maryland this weekend. The 'Canes enter 3-2 in league play, but are just 1-2 in their last three ACC matches, recently ending a two-match skid with a victory at Georgia Tech.

Boston College comes calling on Friday night where the Eagles have split their last two meetings in Coral Gables, winning in 2007 by a count of 3-0. In fact, that match kick-started a current eight-match home winning streak for the Orange and Green.

Hurricanes head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch hosts her alma mater, the University of Maryland to the James L. Knight Sports Complex on Sunday in a day of UM sports, with the soccer team playing at Cobb Stadium as well.

Miami shutout their eighth opponent this season this past Tuesday night with a victory over south Florida opponent Florida Atlantic University. The Hurricanes put just one player in double-digits for kills as Mayhew had 10. But the defense of the Hurricanes was as solid as ever, holding their 12th opponent this season below a .200 clip in hitting. The 'Canes held just 10 opponents under that mark last year altogether.

Miami has lost to the Eagles of Boston College in three of the last five matches, including a home-and-home split last season, with the home team winning the respective match. Against Maryland, Miami has fell in the last three matches, including 3-0 sweeps in two of them.

The last win for the Hurricanes over the Terrapins came back on Sept. 24, 2006 in Coral Gables. UM took the match, 3-0.

ON BOSTON COLLEGE...

Boston College is 6-11 overall, but just 0-5 in the ACC at this point in the year. The Eagles are led by a star-studded duo with Jordan Meredith and Taylor Williams. Meredith leads the Eagles in kills (193), sits second in service aces (19) and second in digs (142). Behind her is Williams with a team second-best 162 kills and a team-leading 20 aces. The Eagles are set-up by setters Dan Moskitis (293 assists) and Brittany Pierpont (257 assists). The defense is spurred by Brennan Clark with 245 digs.

ON MARYLAND...

The terrapins of Maryland are in unusual waters with just a 5-12 record (1-4 ACC). Maryland is led by Katie Usher with 156 kills and 12 service aces. Assisting Usher is Maggie Schmelzle with 117 kills and 165 digs. Two players for the Terps have 116 kills--Michelle Kenning and Lisa Scott. Bethany Springer has a team-best 235 digs while teammate Hayley Hanson has 291 assists.

All Miami home matches this year will feature live stats through Gametracker on www.hurricanesports.com. A select number of games will feature radio broadcast through WVUM...the official student radio station for the University of Miami.

MIAMI VS. BC SERIES...

Miami leads the all-time series with Boston College, 6-2. However, the Eagles split a series last year with the home teams prevailing each time. Miami has won three of the last five meetings.

MIAMI VS. UMD SERIES...

Maryland dominates the series between the Terps and 'Canes, 7-2. The Orange and Green hasn't defeated Maryland in their last three tries, but did win one of their last two home matches. Both of UM's wins against Maryland have come since joining the ACC in 2004.

Head Coach ... Nicole Lantagne Welch



Nicole Lantagne Welch enters her eighth season at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in five of the last seven seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

In the 2006 season-opener, Lantagne Welch recorded her 100th career win with a 3-2 victory over Alabama. In 2007, UM finished 14-17 overall and 8-14 in ACC play, pushing Lantagne Welch's career record to 125-81 overall in seven seasons as a head coach, all at Miami.

Her career at UM is highlighted by two consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins (2003 & 2004) and a trip to the Sweet 16 in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her seven seasons at the helm, the Hurricanes have averaged 17.8 wins per season.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. As a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered first-team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and 1993, and earned second-team honors in 1991. She was also named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

As team captain her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career at Maryland, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

Under Lantagne Welch's training, Aggie setter Jenna Moscovic was named the 1999 Big 12 Conference Freshman of the Year and named to the All-American Freshman Team by Volleyball Magazine. As a sophomore, Moscovic was selected to the 2000 All-Big 12 Team and All-District 5 Team. Lantagne Welch also played a major role in bringing the Aggies back-to-back Top 10 recruiting classes. The 1999 class was ranked in the Top 10 by Student Sports Magazine and the 1998 class was ranked sixth by Volleyball Magazine.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7th, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

HURRICANES VB MEDIA POLICY**KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX**

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Information Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

INTERVIEWS

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

Telephone lines at the Knight Sports Complex are limited to home radio and the visiting teams' "official" sports administrator/Media relations contact. All media wishing to file stories should contact Bryan J. Harvey prior to the conclusion of the game in order to make arrangements to be escorted back to the Sports Media Relations Office in order to work in a work-friendly environment. Any and all questions will be addressed in this designated area.

OUT OF THE WOODS...

Redshirt senior right side hitter Ashley Woods (Round Rock, Texas) tied a career-high over the weekend with 15 kills in a win at Georgia Tech. Her previous career-high was a 15-kill outing at Maryland back on Oct. 13, 2007. On Saturday, Woods assisted the Hurricanes in winning their first match against the Yellow Jackets in four tries, including their first win at Georgia Tech since 2005.

WIN TOTAL SURPASSED...

With their victory over Florida Atlantic on Tuesday night, the Hurricanes surpassed their win total from 2006 and 2007 with one final kill from Genny Mayhew. The 'Canes won just 14 matches in 2007, and just 12 in 2006. The last time UM had a winning season came in 2005 (16-14), and they need just two more wins to assure a winning record in 2008.

SHUTTING THE DOOR...

Miami has shutout eight opponents this season in their first 17 matches. Last year, the Hurricanes managed eight shutouts in 2007 altogether. The 2006 class had just four and 2005 with six. The most shutouts for the Hurricanes since joining the ACC is 11 back in 2004--their first season in the league. The most under head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch is 17 back in 2002, the last year UM made it to the NCAA Tournament.

HOME IS WHERE THE HITS ARE...

At home this year in the friendly confines of the James L. Knight Sports Complex, the 'Canes have yet to hit below a .200 clip. In fact, they are averaging a .276 hitting percentage (236-76-580) at home. Meanwhile, opponents are being held to just .139 hitting at "The Knight."

STEPPING IT UP A NOTCH...

Junior outside hitter Genny Mayhew (Clovis, Calif.) has increased her hitting percentage by .057 in the last three matches. Mayhew now has punched in a .245 clip (190-58-550) on the campaign. That ranks her sixth on the team in that category with players holding more than 75 kills. However, take into account that Mayhew leads the team in attacks (550).

SPOTLIGHT ON THE STATS...

Miami is ranked in several statistical categories in the latest national polls. The 'Canes are 34th nationally in blocks per set (2.55); 42nd in aces per set (1.67); 39th in digs per set (15.78); 21st in hitting percentage (.268); and ultimately 6th in winning percentage at 13-1 (.929). TRACKING LOESSBERG AND THE DIGS...

Junior libero Cassie Loessberg continues to jump up the charts this season as she now has 271 digs on the campaign, upping her career total to 1,142. That sets Loessberg at second place all-time in UM history behind Jamie Grass (2001-04) with 1,621 digs under her belt. Throughout the year, we will continue to track Loessberg in her goal to become the all-time leading digs collector at UM.

MAYHEW NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-ACC TEAM...

Junior outside hitter Genny Mayhew was named to the Preseason All-ACC Team as voted on by head coaches around the Atlantic Coast Conference. Mayhew, a 5-foot-11 junior from Clovis, Calif. (Clovis HS), finished ninth in the conference in both kills (428) and points (465) a year ago. She also finished fourth on the squad in digs (224) and tied for fifth in blocks (43) alongside teammate Ariell Cooke while playing in 111 games for the 'Canes.

CLEMSON PREDICTED TO WIN ACC ... AGAIN...

After finishing atop the league last season, the Clemson Tigers have been predicted to repeat as conference champs after collecting 11 of a possible 12 first place votes. Georgia Tech received the other first place vote while being predicted to finish second. Duke and North Carolina were third and fourth, while Florida State and Virginia tied for fifth, respectively.

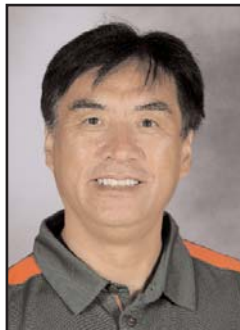
