## NEWS & NOTES

#### NON-CONFERENCE ACTION

Miami closes out its non-conference slate this week with two games over the next two days. The Canes have the opportunity to finish the non-conference schedule at 8-3 should they tally two more wins this week. Miami is 674-436 (.607) all-time in non-conference games and 150-41 (.748) under current head coach Katie Meier.

#### BACK IN ACTION

Redshirt junior Iggy Allen suited up for the first time as a Cane on Tuesday night, seeing seven minutes of action in her first game at the Watson Center. Allen transferred from Mississippi State following the fall 2018 semester and sat out the past year due to NCAA transfer rules.

#### TOUGH SLATE

The Canes are no stranger to tough competition having faced three top-20 opponents so far this season. Miami's only three losses this year have come to teams who rank in the top-15 in RPI (rating percentage index) in the nation (Oregon St. - 4, DePaul - 11, Indiana - 15). The Hurricanes sit at No. 14 in the nation for strength of schedule this season.

#### WELCOME TO MIAMI

The Hurricanes have historically succeeded when playing in front of the home crowd. Miami is just six wins away from the 500-home win mark, sitting at 495-186 (.715) all-time at home. Under Katie Meier, the Canes have historically dominated teams in Coral Gables, boasting a .732 win percentage (188-68). Over the past five years, Miami has lost just 18 games when playing at home.

#### HOLIDAY TOURNEY TIME

Miami competes in its third tournament of the season on Friday, hosting the 20th annual Miami Holiday Classic. The Canes have also appeared in the Maggie Dixon Classic and the Miami Thanksgiving Tournament this season. Miami is 2-2 in tournament games so far, and has placed two players on All-Tournament Teams (Beatrice Mompremier - Maggie Dixon and Miami Thanksgiving, Kelsey Marshall - Maggie Dixon.)

### the matchup

• Miami returns to the Watsco Center on Friday to tipoff the Miami Holiday Classic. The Canes will face the UNC-Asheville Bulldogs at 12 p.m. on Dec. 20 with the game airing on ACC Network Extra (Alex Schwartz - play-by-play, Megan Perry - color analyst). Fans can also listen to the game on WVUM 90.5.

• The Hurricanes and the Bulldogs are meeting for the first time in program history on Friday. Miami is 48-49 all-time against teams from the state of North Carolina and 1-0 against North Carolina teams this season.

### last time out

• The Canes handed the Binghamton Bearcats their first loss of the season when they defeated the Bearcats, 79-56, on Tuesday night. The Canes used a 13-0 run, capped by a 3-pointer by Jamir Huston at the buzzer, to take a double-digit lead into the locker room at halftime, a lead that they would maintain for the rest of the game.

• Four Canes recorded double-digit outings in the win for Miami led by redshirt senior Beatrice Mompremier who paced Miami with 18 points. Juniors Mykea Gray (15), Endia Banks (12) and Kelsey Marshall (11) also posted double-figures.

• The Canes were dominant inside, tallying 52 points in the paint, compared to Binghamton's 18. On the boards, Miami could not be contained, outrebounding the Bearcats, 58-30, setting a new season-high for rebounds in a game.

### scouting the bulldogs

• UNC-Asheville sits at 5-2 on this season, posting a 2-2 record over the last four games. The Bulldogs enter Friday's contest looking to bounce back after dropping a tough game at Wofford, 75-38, on Sunday, December 15.

• UNC-Asheville has a pair of players averaging double-figures this season, Nadiria Evans (13.6) and Sonora Dengokl (11.6). As a team, the Bulldogs are pouring in 64.7 points per game, while limiting their opponents to just 55.3 points per contest.

• The Bulldogs are shooting at a .401 clip from the field this season but have struggled to knock down the three-ball, shooting just 27.1 percent from distance so far this year. Brooke Jordan-Brown paces the team in shooting, knocking down 59.1 percent of her shots.

### #QueenBea

• Miami forward Beatrice Mompremier has dominated the court so far this season, averaging 17.3 points and 9.3 rebounds per game in 2019-20. The redshirt senior is one of two players in the ACC to rank in the top six in both scoring (fourth) and rebounding (sixth). Mompremier also sits in the top 10 among league players in field goal percentage (fifth - .522), blocks per game (seventh - 1.44) and offensive rebounds per game (second - 3.78).

• The Miami native is one of five ACC players to eclipse the 30-point mark in a game this season, pouring in 31 points at DePaul on Nov. 23, 2019.

• Mompremier has earned several accolades this season including ACC Co-Player of the Week, Maggie Dixon Classic All-Tournament Team and Miami Thanksgiving Tournament All-Tournament Team.

### happy holiday classic

- Miami welcomes UNC-Asheville, Southern and Washington State to the Watsco Center this week-end for the 20th annual Miami Holiday Classic.
- The Canes are 31-7 since the inception of the classic in 1999-00. Three of Miami's seven losses have come to ranked opponents, including No. 4 Baylor and No. 9 Auburn.
- Miami has emerged as the winner of the Miami Holiday Classic in 12 of the 19 tournaments, most recently coming out on top during the 2016-17 season.

### besting the big south

- The Hurricanes boast a perfect 4-0 record against opponents from the Big South Conference. The most recent victory for Miami came in 2013 when the Canes defeated Radford 75-58 in Coral Gables.
- Three of the four games against Big South teams have occurred since head coach Katie Meier took over the reins of the Miami program.
- Against Big South teams, the Canes are outscoring their opponents by an averaged of 25.5 points per game. Miami is averaging 81.5 points per outing, while limiting its opposition to 56.0 points per game.

### bounce back

- The Canes have faced some challenges on the court over the last few weeks with three losses to top-20 opponents. However, Miami knows how to bounce back from losses.
- The Canes are 2-1 this season following a loss, posting double-digits in both of their victories (23 points - Binghamton, 18 - Miami (OH)).
- In 2018-19, Miami recorded a win following a loss on seven occasions. The Canes were tagged with back-to-back losses on just one instance last season.

### december darlings

- Since the beginning of the 1979-80 season, Miami has historically been successful in December games. The Hurricanes boast a .663 win-percentage in November games with a 193-98 record.
- In Meier's 15 years with the Canes, Miami holds a 74-25 record (.752) in games in December. The Canes are 1-1 in December this season.

### crash the boards

- Miami eclipsed the 50-rebound mark for the third time this season, totaling 58 boards against Binghamton. The Canes' 58 rebounds were the most by a Miami team since Dec. 15, 2017 when the Hurricanes hauled in 59 against Alabama State.
- The Canes rank fifth in the ACC in rebounds this season, averaging 43.6 boards per game. On the offensive glass, Miami sits tied for third with 15.2 offensive rebounds per game. Redshirt senior Beatrice Mompremier ranks sixth in the ACC in rebounds with 9.3 boards per game.

### #tough20

- Head coach Katie Meier signed three 2020 prospects to NLI's on November 13:
- **Nyayongah Gony:** A 6-foot, 3-inch forward from Lincoln, Nebraska, Gony is ranked as the No. 56 overall player in the class of 2020 by espnW HoopGuriz. The forward comes in at No. 13 among forwards in the 2020 class and is considered the top recruit in the state of Nebraska.
- **Paula Fraile Ruiz:** Standing tall at 6-feet, 4-inches, Fraile Ruiz has a wealth of international experience, most recently competing at the FIBA U18 Women's European Championship – Division B in Sarajevo, Bosnia.
- **Naomi Mbandu:** Mbandu is currently playing at Gulf Coast State College and is considered the No. 2 junior college prospect in the nation by ASGR Basketball. A native of Tobes, France, Mbandu represented her country at the 2019 FIBA U20 Women's European Championship.

### USA basketball

- USA Basketball was full of the Canes this summer as Beatrice Mompremier represented Miami at the Pan American Games in Lima, Peru. Mompremier was one of 12 players on the U.S. team and the only ACC representative.
- The U.S. took home the silver medal from Lima after posting a 4-1 record during the competition, falling to Brazil in the gold medal game, 79-73. Mompremier started all five games, averaging 12.2 points and 7.6 rebounds across the five outings.
- Mompremier and junior Mykea Gray also had the opportunity to train with USA Basketball during their training camp in Coral Gables ahead of the AmeriCup in Puerto Rico. Training camp attendees included Sue Bird, Diana Taurasi and Tina Charles.

Katie Meier completed her 14th season at the helm of the Hurricanes' women's basketball program in 2018-19. A well-known and respected figure in women's basketball with 18 years of head coaching experience, Meier has worked tirelessly to put her mark on Miami's program and to build a winning tradition.

In 2018-19, Meier guided her team to a 10th consecutive postseason appearance, including an eighth trip to the NCAA Tournament in the last nine years and fifth straight NCAA Tournament bid. Miami also reached 20-plus wins for the ninth time in 10 years and double-digit ACC victories for the seventh time in nine years.

Through the 2017-18 campaign, Meier has a career record of 353-217, including a 277-172 mark at Miami.

## Honors and Accolades

Meier has been recognized for her coaching success numerous times throughout her career. From being named a co-recipient of the 2013 USA Basketball National Coach of the Year award following a 9-0 record and gold medal at the 2013 FIBA U19 World Championship, to being inducted into the University of Miami Sports Hall of Fame in 2017, Meier's name has become synonymous with elite basketball.

One of the most prestigious honors bestowed on Meier came at the conclusion of the 2010-11 season when she was named the Associated Press National Coach of the Year - sharing the award with Connecticut's Geno Auriemma and Stanford's Tara VanDerveer. That season, Meier led the Hurricanes into the NCAA tournament for the first time since 2004 and coached the Canes to their first NCAA Tournament win since 1993.

The Canes entered the 2010-11 season with high internal expectations, but were picked eighth in the Preseason ACC Poll. Miami exceeded all outside expectations posting a perfect 20-0 record inside BankUnited Center and finished conference play with a 12-2 record, earning their first regular season conference title since joining the league in 2004. As a result, Meier was named the ACC Coach of the Year and later would be selected as the WBCA/RUSSELL ATHLETIC Region 2 Coach of the Year, as voted on by her peers.

During the 2011-12 season, Meier coached the Canes to their highest ranking in program history at No. 5. Miami went undefeated at home for the second consecutive season, pushing the home win streak to 40 games.

Five people who have been assistants for Meier during her head coaching career have gone on to earn Division I head coaching positions: Lynn Bria (Stetson), Amanda Butler (Florida and Clemson), Darrick Gibbs (North Florida), Carolyn Kieger (Marquette) and Stephanie McCormick (Western Carolina). Additionally, 22 of Meier's players at Miami have gone on to play professionally after their college careers.

## A New Era

Hired April 19, 2005, Meier was appointed by then-Miami AD Paul Dee in front of national and local media, fans, alumni and support staff, signifying the beginning of a new era.

Following an unprecedented career as one of the greatest athletes to ever play in the Atlantic Coast Conference, Meier quickly established herself in the coaching ranks. Following an impressive four-year tenure as the head coach at Charlotte where she helped bring the 49er program into national prominence, Meier made it clear that her goal was to make Miami one of the premier women's basketball programs in the country.

## Creating a Winning Program

In her first season, Meier wasted little time in making the first steps towards those goals. After receiving little attention in the ACC preseason polls, the Hurricanes posted an impressive overall record of 17-13. Under Meier, Miami earned a berth into the second round of the 2006 Women's National Invitation Tournament and standout Tamara James produced one of the greatest seasons ever seen by a UM player, becoming Miami's all-time leading scorer. James was selected with the eighth overall pick in the 2006 WNBA Draft by the Washington Mystics.

Over the next two years, the Hurricanes continued to develop under Meier's direction. Miami's Renee Taylor emerged as the ACC's leading scorer in 2006-07, while Maurita Reid finished the 2007-08 campaign with 110 steals, good for second in the ACC and fifth in the NCAA.

With the No. 21-ranked incoming recruiting class, Meier and the Hurricanes saw significant improvement during the 2008-09 season. The freshman class was highlighted by McDonald's All-American Shenise Johnson of Henrietta, N.Y., and Riquna Williams from nearby Pahokee, Fla. Under Meier's guidance, Johnson was named the ACC Rookie of the Week on three occasions and was named to the ACC All-Freshmen team as well as ACC Honorable Mention. The

versatile guard/forward also led the U19 USA team to a gold medal finish in the 2009 World Championships in Bangkok, Thailand.

The 2009-10 season was one of the most successful in program history. Under Meier's vision, the Hurricanes advanced to the WNIT Championship game. Miami posted a 22-14 overall record - the first 20-win campaign since the 2002-03 season and just the eighth all-time in history. In her sophomore season, Johnson was named first team

All-ACC, while a healthy Riquna Williams garnered second-team honors. The tandem led Miami to a 5-1 WNIT record - the deepest postseason run in team history, with both earning all-tournament honors along the way.

Following the success of the 2009-10 campaign, Meier signed a contract extension through 2015 and the Hurricanes continued their rise in the ACC. Miami earned a conference regular season title in 2010-11 and returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in seven seasons. Johnson was named to four different All-America squads and became the second player in program history to be named the conference player of the year (Frances Savage - BIG EAST - 1992). Williams, along with Johnson, was named First Team All-ACC and was the conference scoring leader, posting 21.7 points per game.

Miami's dominance continued into the 2011-12 season. The Canes finished second in the conference standings with a record of 14-2 and were 26-6 overall, earning a No. 3 seed in the NCAA Tournament. UM also defeated the eventual conference tournament champion, Maryland, both times they played in the regular season.

Seniors Shenise Johnson and Riquna Williams continued to shine in the ACC as the duo were second and third in the league in scoring and each were again named First Team All-ACC. Johnson was also named to the All-ACC Defensive Team for the third consecutive season and earned a place on five different All-America teams, including the WBCA squad for the second straight year. Williams earned AP All-America third team recognition in her final collegiate campaign as well.

The Hurricanes went to a school record third straight NCAA Tournament in 2012-13, earning a No. 8 seed. Meier's Hurricanes defeated two top-10 opponents during the season, besting No. 6/7 Penn State and knocking off No. 5/4 Duke on senior day, marking the first win over a team in the top four of either poll in program history and the school's first win over the Blue Devils, who went 20-1 against ACC opponents that season, including winning the ACC Tournament.

After reaching the WNIT in 2014, Meier guided the Hurricanes back to the NCAA Tournament in 2015 and the 11th-seeded Hurricanes defeated No. 6 seed Washington in the first round, before dropping their second round matchup against third-seeded Iowa, the host school.

Earlier in the 2014-15 season, Meier also led the Hurricanes to the program's first win over a team in the top four of the AP Poll. They defeated No. 4/4 Notre Dame, 78-63, the Fighting Irish's only loss in their first two years in the ACC. Sophomore guard Adrienne Motley went on to be named a consensus First Team All-ACC pick after averaging 16.9 points on 49.2 percent shooting. Meier also earned her 250th career win during the season.

In 2015-16, Meier led Miami to a 24-9 record to tie for the fifth-most wins in a season in program history. Miami received a No. 5 seed the NCAA Tournament and made its fifth appearance in the field in the past six years. The 2015-16 campaign also saw the Hurricanes beat both Duke and North Carolina in the same year for the first time. The victory at North Carolina was good for the 200th of Meier's tenure at Miami. Adrienne Motley was also tabbed as a consensus First Team All-ACC honoree for the second straight year, in addition to garnering WBCA All-America Team Honorable Mention recognition.

In 2016-17, Meier guided the Hurricanes to a second straight 24-9 record. In the quarterfinals of the ACC Tournament, Miami again defeated a Florida State team ranked in the top 10, downing the No. 8/12 Seminoles, 56-54, to earn back-to-back semifinal appearances for the first time. The Hurricanes beat four top-25 teams, defeating three ranked teams – two of which were in the top 10 – away from home for the first time in the ACC era. Miami earned a No. 4 seed in the NCAA Tournament, hosting the first two rounds of play, and reached the second round for the fourth time in seven years.

Adrienne Motley and Jessica Thomas were both Second Team All-ACC picks in 2016-17, with Motley becoming Miami's fifth WNBA Draft pick. In addition, Motley, Thomas and Keyona Hayes formed the second Miami teammate trio to all reach 1,000 points and each signed a WNBA contract, the first time three Hurricanes in the same class did so.

Despite losing many talented players to graduation and injuries, Meier led the Hurricanes to a 21-11 finish in 2017-18 and surpassed 250 wins in her tenure with the program. Erykah Davenport, a Second Team All-ACC honoree, and Keyanna Harris became the first Miami seniors to make four straight NCAA Tournaments. Miami had two freshman all-league honorees for the first time since 1992-93 in the BIG EAST, as Mykea Gray and Kelsey Marshall both made the cut.

### **Establishing Her Legacy as a Player**

Meier's success as a coach is a direct reflection of her playing career as a standout at Duke University. A four-year letter winner for the Blue Devils under head coach Debbie Leonard from 1986-90, Meier's name is scattered throughout the Duke record books.

She currently ranks among the school's all-time career leaders in scoring average (16.2 points per game), steals (232), free throws made (447) and free throws attempted (624). She is also listed among Duke's leaders in career points (1,761), field goals made (653), field goals attempted (1,283), assists (409) and rebounding average (6.1 rebounds per game).

Meier wasted no time making her mark at Duke, earning ACC Rookie of the Year and Basketball Yearbook Freshman All-America honors in 1986. Meier injured her knee in 1988 during her junior season and ultimately missed the entire 1988-89 campaign while recovering.

Meier returned to Duke for her senior season in 1990 without missing a beat, earning Kodak/WBCA District 2 All-America and All-ACC first team accolades while being named the Blue Devils' most valuable player.

In 2002, Meier was honored by Duke for her efforts as a player when she was named to the inaugural induction class in the Blue Devils' Hall of Honor. That same year, Meier was named to the ACC's 50th Anniversary Team. In 2006, she was once again honored by the conference when she was named an ACC Legend at the 2006 ACC Women's Basketball Tournament.

Meier's success on the court was only outdone by her accomplishments in the classroom. She was named to the Dean's List from 1986-88. In 1988 she also earned GTE Academic All-America Second Team honors.

After receiving a bachelor's degree in English literature with cum laude honors in 1989, Meier went on to earn a master's degree in teaching English from Duke in 1990.

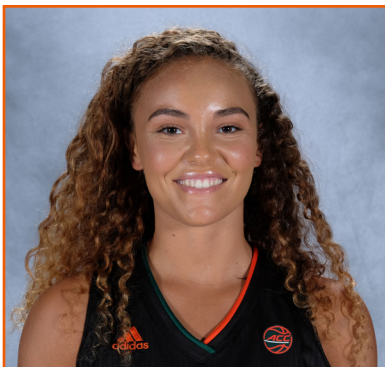
Following her career at Duke, Meier moved overseas to play three seasons with BBC Mini-Flat Waregem in Belgium from 1990-93. There, she helped lead her team to three First Division regular season titles and one Belgian Cup Championship. While in Belgium, Meier also spent time teaching classes of conversational English while coaching teams of 15- to 17-year-olds.

A native of Wheaton, Ill., Meier graduated from Wheaton Central High School in 1985 and in October 2009 was inducted into her high school's athletic hall of fame.

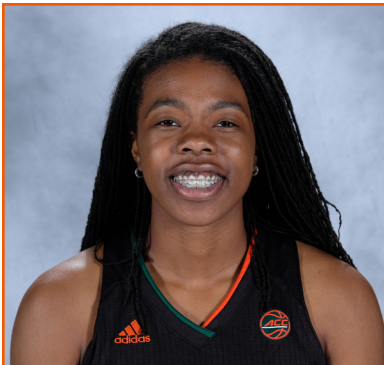

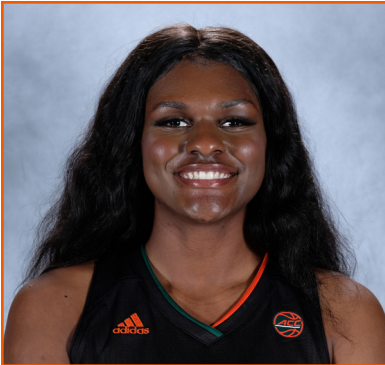
