U. C. NEVER RECOVERS FROM EARLY THRUSTS

Miami, Fla. Nov. 6 — Coach Ray Nolting and his 32 Florida Hurrican victims headed back toward Cincinnati today. The hurrican which hit them and blew them right out of the Orange Bowl have last night was the one which Andy Gustafson coaches at the University of Miami.

The score was 36 - 6 and a crowd of 31,561 gathered in the big stadium, where the annual New Years's Day Orange Bowl game is played to watch the performance.

It wasn't a veryn satisfying game. Even the local people found it a little drab and lop-sided and began walking out when there still were nearly 10 minutes of playing time remaining.

The Miami boys made five touchdowns and a safety to one touchdown for the Bearcats, but none of the scores was made on solid, sustained offensive football.

One of the Hurricanes' touchdowns was a gift. One was the result of a 75 - yard run which found the Bearcats standing *tikk around admiring the scenery. The other three were made on long, quick-striking pass plays and the safety was the result of a blocked punt.

The Bearcats were helped on their touchdown march by a Miami fumble and a 48 yd.

pass while Coach Gustafson had his reserves on the field.

Tt was helter-skelter football. Here's the way the game went:

The Bearcats received and fumbled on the first play on their own 4. The Hurricanes recovered. Three jabs at the line and they were across. Harry Ghaul, the remarkable punter and place-kicker, then kicked the first of four extre points which was to add to the score and the Miamians led by seven points.

This uhhappy incident seemed to unnerve the Beardats. The next time the home team got its hands on the ball they scored again. Halfback Elmer Smith, an extremely nippy sort of runner, edged his way through his right tackle position, turned on full throttle and outran the Bearcats for 75 yards and a touchdown.

The Hurricanes were stopped on their next series, but the fourth time, they took possession — on U. C.'s 25 — they tried two plays. The first lost five yards. The second was a pass from Quarterback Jack Del Bello to Halfback Don Cobb, Cobb made the catch on the Bearcat two-yard line and calmly stepped over the goal line.

With the first period over, the Miamians led, 21-0 while the Bearcats had only one offensive splurge to their credit. Midway of the period they moved their 22 to Miami's 24. The big gains were on passes from Tom O'Malley to Thurman Owens and Joe Hauk and on runs 66 ll and 15 yards by Pete St. Clair and Jim Daugherty.

The Bearcats put on another drive in the second period which carried from their 20 to Miami's 37, mainly on the strength of two passes from O'Malley to Hauk and Ray Penno. A pass interception killed the march.

The Hurricanes scored their fourth touchdown late in this period on a 59 yd.

pass from Clive Shrader to Halfback Al Hudson.

The score remained 27 - 0 through the third period, but in this stanza the Bearcats put on their longest and most polished sustained drive of the game.

They moved from their 12 to the Miami 19 with Daugherty running for gains of 12 and 13 and O'Malley passing to Owens for 26. Another pass interception stopped them.

The fourth period was more than half used when the Bearcats scored. A penalty put them on their one-yard line. O'Malley punted out and the Miami receiver fumbled on the Cinci. 36. Al Richards then passed to O'Malley for 48 yards. Tom was in the clear but was caught from behind on the Miami 16.

Five fare-yard penalty helped them to a first down on the 6. Another penalty set them back to the 8 and from here Daugherty wormed his way forward on fourth down and fell with the ball an inch or two on the pay-off side of the goal line. Tom Jessen missed the extra point.
