UCF QUICK NOTES

• UCF will play its second ACC foe of the year and its first road game of the season when it faces the Hurricanes. The Knights bounced back from a 12-point loss to visiting Florida State on Nov. 13 with an 83-63 victory over Bethune-Cookman at home Sunday. UCF finished with a 55-24 rebounding advantage and was led by 22 points from Isaiah Sykes, who also had eight rebounds and eight assists.

• The game is the first of three-straight on the road for the Knights, who opened the campaign with three-consecutive home games. After facing the Hurricanes, UCF will play at Valpo next Tuesday and conclude the stretch against FAU on Dec. 3.

• UCF will be playing a contest in south Florida for the first time since Dec. 18, 2010, when it rallied for an 84-78 victory over Miami at the Orange Bowl Classic at the BB&T Center in Sunrise. On Thursday, the Knights will play at the BankUnited Center for the first time. Their last trip to Miami-Dade County, and their last game against the host Hurricanes, came on Dec. 9, 2000, at the old Miami Arena.

• Isaiah Sykes will make his 100th appearance as a Knight Thursday. The senior ranks 16th in program history in scoring (1,086), ninth in rebounds (568), eighth in steals (137) and 10th in assists (244).

• The Knights were picked ninth in the American Athletic Conference preseason coaches' poll and Isaiah Sykes was named to the all-league second team. In the new league, the Knights will compete against some of the nation's premier programs, including defending national champion Louisville, UConn, Cincinnati, Memphis and Temple.

Grab a Rebound

- The Knights bounced back from their Nov. 13 loss to Florida State with an 83-63 triumph over Bethune-Cookman Sunday thanks to some strong rebounding
- UCF finished with a 55-24 advantage on the glass and totaled 23 offensive rebounds, one fewer than the Wildcats' total boards
- The 55 rebounds were the most for the Knights since 2004 and ranked 10th on the school's single-game boards list

Going for 20

- UCF opened 2013-14 seeking its fourth-straight 20-win campaign under Donnie Jones
- The Knights, who went 20-11 a year ago, have never registered four-consecutive 20-victory seasons since joining the Division I ranks in 1984

Show and Improve

- Isaiah Sykes has done nothing but improve during his time as a Knight, as evidenced by a quick look at his year-by-year statistics
- Despite only scoring 127 points as a freshman in 2010-11, he ranks 16th on the UCF career scoring chart with 1,086 points

- A year ago, Kasey Wilson was one of the most accurate shooters from deep in the country as he shot 50.0 percent, making 42-of-84 3-point attempts
- It seems like the junior is continuing that accuracy in 2013-14 as he has made 5-of-9 treys this season

The Future is Bright

- Last Wednesday, a pair of Orlando high school stars - Adonys Henriquez and B.J. Taylor - elected to stay at home when they signed NLI's to join the Knights next year
- Orlando Christian Prep's Henriquez is 80th in the ESPN 100 national rankings and is listed the 17th-best wing in the country by the network
- He averaged 13.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists and finished second in the Florida Class 2A Player of the Year voting as a junior
- A point guard from Boone High School, Taylor averaged 18.8 points, 4.6 rebounds, 4.3 assists and 2.0 steals last year
