## Storyline

• Maryland hits the road for the first time in ACC play and just the second time this season when it takes on Miami Sunday at 8 p.m. The Terps will be looking for their first road win over the Hurricanes since they joined the ACC; Miami has won all six of its home games over the Terrapins since joining the league in 2004. Maryland and Miami split a pair of games last season, with each team holding home court.

• On Wednesday against Florida State, the Terps had the second-longest winning streak in school history snapped at 13 games as the Seminoles survived a furious last-minute comeback to win, 65-62. It was Maryland's first loss in exactly two months – the only other setback came in the season-opener vs. Kentucky on Nov. 9.

• Depth, rebounding, and hot shooting helped carry the Terrapins to their 13-game winning streak. Against FSU, though, Maryland shot under 40 percent (.367) for just the third time in 15 games, and held just a plus-3 advantage on the boards. Still, despite also committing 18 turnovers, the Terps had a chance to win or tie after scoring 11 points in the final minute, but Seth Allen had a go-ahead 3-pointer blocked with 0:02 left.

• Allen has led Maryland in scoring in the two ACC games by averaging 17.0 points, and the freshman has reached double figures in four straight games after doing it just once in the first 11 games. He's one of seven underclassmen who are providing the bulk of the scoring in Maryland's 10-man rotation. Of the 76.7 points per game Maryland is averaging, 62.2 (81%) are coming from freshmen or sophomores.

• Alex Len has led the Terps in scoring throughout the season, with his 13.6 points per game ranking 13th in the ACC, and his 8.2 rebounds per game ranking fifth. The sophomore recorded his fourth double-double of the year with 15 points and 10 rebounds against Florida State.

## 2012-13 University of Maryland Basketball

### Maryland-Miami Series

- Maryland trails the all-time series, which dates back to 1949, 8-12. The Hurricanes also hold a 9-4 advantage and have won seven straight at home.
- Last year the teams split the series, with each winning at home. In the game at Miami, the Hurricanes prevailed 90-86 in two overtimes. In College Park, Maryland won 75-70.

### Quick Hitters

- The 13-game winning streak Maryland went on this season is tied for the second longest in school history, trailing just the 14-game streak the Terps went on in 1931-32. Maryland also went on a 13-game win streak in 2001-02, the year they went on to win the national title.
- It was also the 11th time in school history Maryland has put together a 10-game winning streak. In the past 30 years, Maryland has gone on a 10-game winning streak on six occasions, and in each of the previous instances it has gone on to play in the NCAA Tournament.
- Logan Aronhalt is averaging one 3-point field goal made for every 6.6 minutes on the floor. By comparison, the ACC leader in 3PT FGs made, Scott Wood of NC State, makes one every 12.4 minutes on the floor.
- Charles Mitchell earned ACC Rookie of the Week honors on Dec. 31 for his play against Delaware State on Dec. 29. Mitchell came off the bench to score 19 points and grab 14 rebounds, both career highs. Mitchell is the second Terp to earn weekly ACC honors; Alex Len was Player of the Week on Nov. 12.
- Seven of the 10 players in Maryland's regular rotation are under-

classmen and 81 percent of Maryland's scoring (62.2 of 76.7 points per game) is coming from underclassmen. In the win over Virginia Tech, 81 of Maryland's 94 points came from freshmen or sophomores.

- When Seth Allen, Jake Layman and Shaquille Cleare drew starts against UMES, it marked the first time Maryland started three true freshmen since Dec. 28, 1993, when Keith Booth, Matt Kovarik and Joe Smith did vs. Hofstra.
- Maryland has assisted on 65.3 percent (217 of 415) field goals this season. The Terps have recorded at least 13 assists in every game (season-low 13 vs. Florida State).
- The Terps have made more free throws than the opponent has attempted this season (232 to 216).
- At least eight players have scored in 14 of Maryland's 15 games this year. The exception is vs. George Mason, when just seven players scored.

### Hot Shooting

- Maryland entered this week ranked second in the ACC and ninth nationally in field goal percentage at 50.4 percent. That percentage dipped to 49.5 on the year after the Terps shot 36.7 percent against Florida State. Despite the poor shooting night against the 'Noles, Maryland has shot above 40 percent in 12 of 15 games this year and above 50 percent in nine games.
- The last time a Maryland team shot better than 48 percent on the season was 2001-02, when the Terps connected at a .482 mark. Since the 1990-91 season, just four teams have done it: (also 1994-95, .498; 1998-99, .495; and 2001-01, .484).

## Rare Performance

- When freshmen Seth Allen and Jake Layman both reached the 20-point plateau against Virginia Tech, it marked a rare performance. Prior to Allen and Layman's performances, a freshman had scored 20 or more points in a game just 10 times since 1994-95 – with none of those occurring in the same game. In fact, the last time two different freshmen scored 20 or more points in a game in the same season was 1992-93 when Exree Hipp and Johnny Rhodes did it.

## Field-goal Percentage Defense

- Maryland entered this week ranked fourth nationally in field goal percentage defense at .352. The Terps have held nine of the last 11 opponents under 40 percent shooting, with Stony Brook and IUPUI being the exceptions.
- Since 2000, five Terrapin teams have held the opponent under 40 percent shooting. Of those five, four went on to at least the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

## Super Subs

- Maryland's bench has been an asset all season, as the Terps' non-starters have outscored the opponents non-starters in 13 of 15 games (exceptions are Kentucky & George Mason).
- On the year, Maryland's bench has a 434-181 (28.9 to 12.1 per game) advantage over the opponent. The biggest advantage Maryland has had this season was against UMES on Dec. 5 (55-7).
- With his 8.5 points per game, Seth Allen has been the biggest contributor. He has reached double figures in each of the past four games while coming off the bench.
- Logan Aronhalt has also been a consistent contributor as a long-range specialist. He is three 3-point field goals made shy of qualifying for the ACC lead, but his .529 mark from beyond the arc would lead the league. He has made at least one 3-pointer in 13 of 15 games this season.

## Sophomore Jump

- After averaging 6.0 points and 5.4 rebounds per game as a freshman, Alex Len has developed into Maryland's most consistent scoring threat as a sophomore. Len is averaging 13.6 points per game, which ranks first in the ACC among centers and 13th overall. His 8.2 rebounds per game rank fifth. Len also ranks second in the league with 2.2 blocks per game. He has four double-doubles this season: against Kentucky (23 & 12), Northwestern (13 & 13), Monmouth (14 & 10) and Florida State (15 & 10).

## On Assists

- Maryland entered the week ranked fifth nationally with 18.4 assists per game behind Notre Dame (19.9), Ohio (19.1), Pittsburgh (18.9) and North Carolina (18.7).
- Pe'Shon Howard, who ranks third in the ACC with 5.5 assists per game, would be in some rare company if he can average 6.0 assists per game this season. In the past 25 years, just three players have averaged more than 6.0 assists per game at Maryland: Terrell Stokes in 1998-99, Steve Blake from 1999-2003, and Greivis Vasquez in 2007-08 and 2009-10.
- Maryland's 28 assists against LIU Brooklyn were nine more than the team's season-high of 19 last year. In fact, the last time a Maryland team had more assists in a game was in the 2002-03 season, when the Terps had 29 on two occasions. The Terps also had 28 assists in a game on 2/9/11 vs. Longwood and 12/31/05 vs. VMI. The school record for assists in a game is 37.
- Howard's 13 assists vs. LIU Brooklyn are tied for the fourth-most in a single game by a Terp. The only better performances are: Greivis Vasquez (2008) and Terrell Stokes (1998) with 15; and Steve Blake (2002) and Terrell Stokes (1996) with 14.

## Force on the Boards

- Though the rebounding advantage over the last two opponents was just plus-3, Maryland leads the ACC and is tied for third nationally in rebounding margin at plus-12.1 per game. Just Colorado State (plus-13.9) and Missouri (plus-13.0) rank above that. Maryland is the only ACC school with a double-figure advantage in rebounding margin; North Carolina is second at plus-5.5.
- The Terps have built advantages on the boards in all 15 games this season.
- Alex Len and Charles Mitchell are the biggest factors in that; Len averages 8.2 rpg and Mitchell averages 6.7. Len ranks fifth in the conference and Mitchell ranks 11th, including first among freshmen.
- Len ranks third in the conference with 3.1 offensive rebounds per game, and the Terps are

averaging 13.6 offensive rebounds per game as a team, second in the league behind North Carolina (15.5).

- Mitchell made an impressive debut by grabbing 10 rebounds in his first career game, against No. 3 Kentucky. That's the most rebounds by a Maryland freshman in his debut since Buck Williams had 13 against Bucknell in 1978. Williams went on to lead the ACC in rebounding that year (10.8 pg) en route to capturing ACC Rookie of the Year honors.

### Looking Like a Turgeon Team

- Maryland has resembled a team with the characteristics of some of Mark Turgeon's best teams. Of the five seasons Turgeon has led his team to a NCAA Tournament, his teams have held the opponent to a low field goal percentage in addition to enjoying a rebounding margin and averaging at least 12.3 assists per game. Through 15 games this season, the Terps are excelling in each of those categories.

### Who's Next?

Head coach Mark Turgeon and his staff signed a consensus top-20 recruiting class this season with freshmen Seth Allen, Shaquille Cleare, Jake Layman and Charles Mitchell.

The influx of talent gives Maryland the opportunity to extend a streak of being recognized for having talented young players in the program - for three years in a row, a Terp has been on the ACC All-Freshman Team. Prior to Nick Faust last year, Terrell Stoglin was honored in 2011 and Jordan Williams was honored in 2010.

### Head Coach Mark Turgeon

The eighth head coach in Maryland Basketball history arrived in College Park with a stellar resume:

- Turgeon led his teams to at least 20 wins in seven of the last nine seasons.
- His teams have advanced to postseason play eight times in the last 10 years, including NCAA berths in five of the last seven seasons. His record in the last nine years is 201-99 (.670).
- As a player, assistant coach and head coach, Turgeon has compiled a 26-13 NCAA Tournament record (8-4 as a player, 13-4 as an assistant, 5-5 as a head coach).
- In 14 NCAA Tournament appearances as a player, assistant coach and head coach, Turgeon has lost an NCAA opener only twice (Oregon in 1995 under Coach Jerry Green, and 2011 as the head coach at Texas A&M - 57-50 loss vs. Florida State).

### Milestones, Streaks, etc.

- Maryland's last win over a ranked team was a 79-72 win over then-No.4 Duke on 3/3/2010 at Comcast Center. The Terps' last road win over a ranked team was an 82-80 win at then-No. 1 North Carolina on 1/19/2008.

- Maryland's last losing season came in 1992-93, the last year of devastating NCAA sanctions levied against previous staffs at Maryland. Each school in the ACC has had a losing season since the Terps fell below .500 some 20 seasons ago. In fact, 9 of the 11 ACC opponents have suffered through a losing season since the Terps won the NCAA title in 2002, with Duke and UNC the exceptions.

### Hitting the Weights

- Several Terps, under the tutelage of director of basketball performance Kyle Tarp, have made significant body changes in the offseason. Most notable are:
  - Alex Len - increased body weight from 219 lbs to 251 since arriving at Maryland. Increased lean weight from 202 to 235 (net 33 lbs of muscle).
  - Nick Faust - gained 24 lbs since last year (added 22 lbs of muscle).
  - The NCAA rule allowing summer workouts also provided the opportunity for several of Maryland's newcomers to hit the weight room.
    - Jake Layman gained 15 lbs in the offseason, adding 17 lbs of muscles and losing 2 pounds of fat.
    - Charles Mitchell - lost 21 lbs (lost 24 lbs of fat and gained 3 lbs of muscle)
    - Shaquille Cleare - lost 24 pounds and decreased body fat from 20.7% to 13.8%. He bench pressed 185 lbs for 29 reps (NBA combine record is 27).

## Working Overtime

Maryland is 48-50 all-time in overtime games. It's double-OT game at Miami last season (2/1/12) was Maryland's first in 59 games (20 games last season, 33 in 2010-11 and five in 2009-10). Prior to the 90-86 loss at Miami, the Terps' most recent OT contest was a 2OT win at Virginia Tech (104-100, 2/27/10). Maryland was 0-2 last season in extra sessions, also losing 75-72 at Comcast Center on 3/4/12 against Virginia.

- Maryland has played at least one overtime game in 17 of the last 20 seasons. The Terps did not go overtime in 2010-11, marking the first time in eight seasons they finished business in regulation.

- Maryland's 89-74 OT win over Vermont (11/21/08) marked the largest winning margin in an overtime game for the Terps, who outscored the Catamounts 17-2, including the first 17 points of the extra session.

- Maryland is 25-18 in overtime games played at home, including a 6-1 mark at Comcast Center. Prior to the Virginia game, the last overtime game in College Park was an 88-85 victory over then-3rd-ranked North Carolina on 2/21/2009.

## Home Sweet Home

Maryland has been a dominant home team over the years:

- The Terps are 857-296 (.743) all-time at home dating back to 1923-24.
- Maryland is 151-34 (.816) all-time at Comcast Center.
- Maryland is 205-39 (.840) at home the last 12 seasons (since 1998-99).
- Maryland is 76-17 (.817) in home-openers in College Park all-time, including a 36-game winning streak (last loss on 11/27/76 to Notre Dame, 80-79, OT). The Terps did not play a home game in 1918-19.

## Fear the Turtle!

Maryland is one of the most consistent winning programs in the country following more than a decade of excellence:

- The Terps have averaged 22.25 wins per season the last 16 years, including eight consecutive 20-win seasons from 1996-2004.
- Maryland has 17 postseason appearances in the last 19 years, including 11 consecutive trips to the NCAA Tournament from 1993-2004.
- The Terrapins have won at least two postseason games (ACC, NCAA, NIT) in nine of the last 14 seasons.
- The Terps have advanced to the NCAA Sweet sixteen seven times in the last 18 years.
- Maryland made consecutive trips to the NCAA Final Four in 2001 and 2002 .
- The Terps captured the 2002 NCAA National Championship.
- The Terps captured the 2004 ACC Tournament Championship.
- Maryland shared the 2010 ACC Regular-Season Title with eventual national-champion Duke.

## Terps Sign Two For 2012-13

On Wednesday, Nov. 14, head coach Mark Turgeon announced the signing of Damonte Dodd and Roddy Peters to the class of 2013. The two signees give Maryland the 24th-ranked class nationally according to 247Sports.com.

### DAMONTE DODD (6-9, 240, C, Centreville, Md.)

A three-star prospect and the 12th-ranked center nationally by 247sports.com ... a four-star prospect, the No. 99-ranked player overall and the No. 13 center by Scout.com ... ranked as the best shot blocker to sign in the ACC by Scout.com ... committed to Maryland in February and is attending Massanutten Military Academy this season ... averaged 24 points, 16 rebounds and seven blocks as a senior (2011-12) at Queen Anne's County High ... tallied 41 points, 21 rebounds and seven blocks in an overtime victory over Kent County during his senior year ... played AAU for the DC Assault under former Washington Wizards head coach Eddie Jordan last summer.

### RODDY PETERS (6-4, 190, PG, Suitland, Md.)

A five-star prospect, the 19th-ranked player overall and the third-ranked point guard by 247Sports.com ... a four-star prospect and the 11th-ranked point guard by Scout.com ... a four-star prospect, the No. 45-ranked player overall and the No. 8-ranked point guard by ESPN.com ... averaged 25 points and seven assists a game as a junior (2011-12) ... chose Maryland over offers from UCLA, Illinois, Rutgers and Xavier ... played AAU for the DC Assault under former Washington Wizards head coach Eddie Jordan last summer.

# MarkTURGEON

► **280-176 (15th Season) / 30-17 (2nd Season at Maryland)**

Entering his second season at the helm of the University of Maryland men's basketball team, Mark Turgeon looks to continue to build upon the momentum he created after finishing his first season at College Park with a winning record and one of the nation's top-rated recruiting classes.

Turgeon, who came to College Park after directing Texas A&M to four consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament, led Maryland to a 17-15 record in 2011-12. Afterwards, he signed a recruiting class that was ranked No. 15 by Rivals.com. At A&M, he posted a 97-40 record in four seasons and was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year in both 2010 and 2011. He is the only coach in Big 12 history with at least 24 victories in each of his four seasons.

In the area of recruiting, Turgeon saw immediate dividends for his efforts as his first class at Maryland was ranked as a consensus top 20 group.

Turgeon, 47, replaced longtime Terrapin head coach Gary Williams, who announced his retirement in May of 2011 after 22 seasons at Maryland.

"We're thrilled to bring Mark to the University, where I'm sure he will continue to build on the great legacy and success of Maryland Basketball," director of athletics Kevin Anderson said at the time of Turgeon's hiring. "In Mark, we have brought one of the outstanding young coaches in the country, and one who has a proven record of achievement on and off the court. We couldn't be more excited."

Turgeon is 280-176 in his 15th season overall as a head coach. In seven years at Wichita State, he built the Shockers into a power in the Missouri Valley Conference, earning the league title and an NCAA Sweet Sixteen appearance

in 2006. In that NCAA Tournament, Wichita State beat Seton Hall and Tennessee before losing to eventual Final Four participant George Mason.

He went 128-89 at Wichita State (2000-07), posting the third-most wins in school history. The Shockers went to three straight NITs from 2003 to 2005 in addition to the 2006 NAAs, the first time WSU had four straight postseason appearances in 40 years.

He began his head-coaching career at Jacksonville State, going 17-11 in his final season there (1999-2000) after going 8-18 in his first year.

Turgeon was an assistant at Kansas for five seasons, first under Larry Brown (1987-88) and then under Roy Williams (1988-92). The Jayhawks made the NCAA Tournament in four of those seasons, winning the national championship in 1988 and finishing second in 1991. KU also won Big Eight titles in 1991 and 1992 with Turgeon on staff.

He was the top assistant under Jerry Green at Oregon from 1992-97 and was an assistant coach under Brown with the Philadelphia 76ers in 1997-98 before taking the head coaching position at Jacksonville State.

A point guard at Kansas from 1984-87, Turgeon was the first player in Jayhawks history to play in four straight NCAA Tournaments. KU went 108-33 under Brown in that stretch. Turgeon served as team captain in his junior



and senior seasons, leading the Jayhawks to the 1986 NCAA Final Four.

As a student-athlete, he was selected to the Big Eight All-Academic Team in 1986 and was a Big Eight All-Freshman pick in 1984. He earned a bachelor of science degree in personnel administration from Kansas in 1987.

A native of Topeka, Kan., Turgeon led Hayden High School to back-to-back Class 4A state titles in 1982 and 1983, earning all-tournament honors each year. A first team all-state pick as a senior, Hayden went 47-3 in his high-school career.

In the summer of 2008, Turgeon was inducted into the Topeka Sports Hall of Fame.

Turgeon ("TURGE-in") is married to the former Ann Fowler of Chicago, Ill, and they have two sons - William Harris and Leo - and a daughter, Ella.
