#### **THINGS TO KNOW**

- · Miami is starting a busy stretch of three games in seven days heading into its break for final exams.
- · Miami owns 19 straight home non-conference wins.
- UM has won its last four games in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge.
- Zach Johnson averaged 18.0 ppg at the Wooden Legacy and was named to the all-tournament team.
- Five Miami players are averaging in double figures in scoring this season.
- · Chris Lykes has scored 17 or more points in every game this season and is fifth in the ACC in scoring.
- · Miami has scored at least 78 points in all six games.
- Junior forward Dewan Hernandez has been withheld from competition thus far as the University and NCAA review his eligibility.

#### **CANES IN ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE**

Miami is 6-5 in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge, including 5-2 under Jim Larrañaga. UM has a 4-1 home record and 2-4 road mark in the challenge.

The ACC owns a 12-5-2 edge in the previous 19 events and a 121-92 record overall. Ten of the 19 challenges have been decided by a single game.

UM is 33-37 against teams currently in the Big Ten and has played 13 of the 14 programs (except lowa).

#### **MIAMI-RUTGERS SERIES**

Miami leads the series with Rutgers, 10-5, with 11 of the 15 previous meetings coming during the programs' stints in the Big East Conference.

Miami prevailed in the last two matchups, including a 73-61 win on Nov. 30, 2016, in an ACC-Big Ten Challenge game at the Watsco Center.

Rutgers' last win in the series was a 61-45 victory in Piscataway on Nov. 21, 2010.

The teams' last game as Big East rivals was on Feb. 4, 2004, a 72-70 Rutgers win in overtime at the RAC.

Jim Larrañaga is 2-0 in his career against Rutgers, with both games coming during his time at UM.

#### **LAST MEETING: MIAMI 73. RUTGERS 61**

Davon Reed scored 18 points in leading Miami to a 73-61 win over Rutgers on Nov. 30, 2016.

Miami led by as many as 21 points in the second half and out-rebounded Rutgers, 44-30.

Five current Hurricanes played in that game.

Dewan Hernandez (then-Huell) scored 14 points and grabbed seven boards in 25 minutes of action.

Anthony Lawrence (8 pts, 25 mins), Ebuka Izundu (4 pts, 12 mins), DJ Vasiljevic (3 pts, 11 mins), and Rodney Miller (2 mins) also saw playing time.

#### **JOHNSON STEPS UP**

Zach Johnson had three strong games at the Wooden Legacy, averaging a team-high 18.0 ppg en route to all-tournament team honors.

He scored a season-high 24 points Friday in the semifinal win over Fresno State. His putback dunk with 0.6 seconds remaining broke a 76-all tie and provided the winning basket.

He made his first UM start Sunday and scored 18 points in the championship game.

With 1,427 career points, Johnson owns the most points of any current ACC player.

#### **WOODEN LEGACY TRENDS**

Miami forced 53 turnovers, resulting in 57 points. On the flip side, Miami committed 46 turnovers, leading to 36 opponent points.

The Canes shot 50.9 percent from the field. Five players averaged in double figures: Zach Johnson (18.0), Chris Lykes (17.7), DJ Vasiljevic (11.7), Ebuka Izundu (10.3) and Anthony Lawrence (10.0).

The Canes shot 77.6 percent from the free-throw line (52-67). UM shot 66 percent from the charity stripe last season.

Ebuka Izundu was 11-for-12 from the field and 8-for-11 at the line but battled foul trouble in each game.

#### **NOTING THE SETON HALL GAME**

- DJ Vasiljevic recorded a career-high five assists, topping his previous high of four.
- In his 85th career game, Ebuka Izundu attempted and hit his first career 3-pointer.
- Anthony Lawrence II attempted a career-high 16 field goals.
- Miami matched a season high by shooting 54.5 percent (30-for-55). UM also shot 30-for-55 in the first game of the tournament against La Salle.
- Miami shot 67 percent in the first half, its best shooting performance in a half since hitting on 72 percent of its attempts in the second half against Middle Tennessee on Dec. 25, 2017.
- Miami trailed by seven points with 6:22 left in the second half, matching its largest deficit this season.
- Fourteen of Seton Hall's first 28 points came off UM turnovers. The Pirates finished with 19 points off UM turnovers. The most points off turnovers for a Miami opponent in a full game this season was nine.

#### **BIG SUCCESS AT 70 POINTS**

Miami has eclipsed the 70-point plateau in every game this season after going 16-3 in those contests last season.

After falling Sunday to Seton Hall despite scoring 81 points, UM is 110-16 when scoring 70 or more points under Jim Larrañaga and 47-3 when breaking the 80-point barrier.

The Canes have scored at least 78 points in every game this season.

#### LYKES CONTINUES STRONG START

Chris Lykes has led Miami is scoring four times in six games and is averaging 19.3 ppg. As of Tuesday, he ranks fifth in the ACC in scoring.

He scored 20 or more points in each of the first three games this season, becoming the first UM player since Joe Wylie in 1989 to do so to begin a season.

He was the first UM player to record three straight 20-point efforts since Shane Larkin put up 20 or more points in consecutive games against Boston College, NC State and UNC in winning the 2013 ACC Tournament.

#### THE WATSCO ADVANTAGE

Miami has defended its home turf well in recent years, winning 41 of its last 46 games at the Watsco Center. The Canes are 91-25 (.784) at home under Jim Larrañaga.

Miami owns 19 straight home non-conference wins, dating to a 78-77 loss to Northeastern on Nov. 27, 2015.

In its 17th year at the Watsco Center (formerly BankUnited Center), Miami is 184-69 (.727) on the home court

In eight years under Larrañaga, Miami is 44-18 in ACC action at home and 47-7 in non-conference play.

#### **VASILJEVIC STEPS UP**

DJ Vasiljevic is off to a strong start, going 21-for-40 (52.5%) from 3-point range and averaging 14.7 ppg. He leads the ACC in 3-pointers made and is fourth in 3-point field goal percentage.

He already is 15-for-15 at the free-throw stripe this year, just one fewer attempt than his total all of last season in 32 games.

Vasiljevic led the ACC in 3-point field goal percentage last season, connecting on 41.1 percent (67-for-163) of his attempts from long range.

He led the team with 67 3-pointers and became the fifth Hurricane to top the conference in 3-point shooting (first since Malcolm Grant in 2011).

### CANES START SEASON AGAINST LEAGUE FAVORITES

Miami opened its season with three straight games against teams that were picked to win their respective conferences.

Lehigh was chosen as the preseason favorites in the Patriot League. Stephen F. Austin was picked to repeat as the Southland Conference champion, while Bethune-Cookman was selected as the preseason MEAC favorite.

#### **NOTING IZUNDU'S IMMENSE NIGHT**

Ebuka Izundu had a career night against Stephen F. Austin, recording career highs in points (22), rebounds (19), blocks (four) and assists (three). He also tied a career best with three steals.

He played a career-best 32 minutes as well. He fell one rebound shy of the first 20-rebound performance by a UM player since Reggie Johnson piled up 20 boards on March 16, 2011, against FAU.

#### **MILLER JR. TO REDSHIRT**

Miami junior center Rodney Miller Jr. will redshirt the 2018-19 season.

Miller lost 25 pounds during the offseason. He averaged 1.1 points in 3.6 minutes per game in 30 games during his first two seasons.

#### **EXPERIENCED GROUP RETURNS**

Miami's roster features seven upperclassmen – three seniors and four juniors.

They have played in a combined 526 games (average of 75 per player), and each has played in at least one NCAA tournament.

#### WHO'S DEPARTED

Miami lost three players from its 2017-18 squad, each of whom started at least 18 games: Lonnie Walker IV, Bruce Brown Jr. and Ja'Quan Newton.

Walker was an Honorable Mention All-ACC pick and ACC All-Freshman Team honoree last year. He was selected 18th overall in the NBA Draft by the San Antonio Spurs.

Brown started 19 games before missing the remainder of the season with a foot injury. He was picked 42nd overall in the NBA Draft by Detroit.

Newton played in 127 career games (seventh most in program history) and finished with 1,134 career points (28th in program history).

#### **NOTING THE SCHEDULE**

Miami's schedule features 14 games against teams that played in the 2018 NCAA Tournament.

The non-conference schedule features games against Stephen F. Austin and Penn, each of whom played in the NCAA Tournament last year.

The Canes' challenging conference schedule includes 11 games against teams that competed in the 2018 NCAA Tournament, including home-and-homes with Florida State, North Carolina and Virginia Tech.

## CANES LOOK TO TOP ACC EXPECTATIONS ONCE AGAIN

Miami was picked 10th in the Operation Basketball 2018-19 Preseason Poll, released Oct. 25 following a vote of the league's media.

In each of Jim Larrañaga's first seven seasons, Miami finished the year in a standing that exceeded its preseason ACC ranking.

UM was picked fourth in the preseason ACC coaches' poll last season (behind Duke, UNC, ND) but concluded the season in a third-place tie.

#### PROGRAM EARNS PERFECT GSR

The Miami men's basketball program earned its first perfect GSR rating, coming in 19 percent above the NCAA average of 81 percent.

The GSR measures graduation rates at Division I institutions and includes students transferring into the institutions. The most recent Division I Graduation Success Rates are based on the four entering classes from 2008-09 to 2011-12

#### **HUELL BECOMES HERNANDEZ**

The name is unfamiliar, but Dewan Hernandez remains a familiar face for the Canes. Formerly Dewan Huell, Hernandez legally changed his last name in the offseason.

The switch was made to honor his mother, Christina Hernandez, and was officially finalized in mid-October.

Walker and Wong each are four-star recruits who are rated among the top 100 players nationally in the latest Rivals recruiting rankings. Walker is a 6-foot-9, 210-pound power forward from Nottingham, Md., and Wong is a 6-foot-3, 170-pound guard from Trenton, N.J.

#### **SOLID SEASON IN THE ACC**

Miami finished with 11 ACC wins last season, its third-most conference wins since joining the league in 2004-05.

UM earned the No. 3 seed in the ACC Tournament after finishing in a four-way tie with Clemson, North Carolina and NC State in the regular-season standings.

Miami scored 10 or more league victories in five of Larrañaga's first seven years, including four straight seasons. The Canes join Virginia, Duke and UNC as the lone teams to win 10 or more ACC games each of the last four years.

Prior to Larrañaga's arrival, Miami never had won 10 ACC games in a season.

#### **DRAFT SUCCESS**

For just the third time in program history, Miami had two student-athletes selected in the NBA Draft last season. The others were 1968 and 1970.

Lonnie Walker IV was chosen 18th overall by the San Antonio Spurs.

Bruce Brown Jr. was picked in the second round by Detroit with the 42nd overall pick.

Brown made his NBA debut on Opening Night with a start against Brooklyn. Walker has yet to play because of injury.




