THINGS TO KNOW

- Miami is the only team among basketball's six power conferences with five players averaging at least 11.8 ppg apiece.
- UM has led in the second half in 15 of its 16 games.
- UM averages 8.8 3-pointers per game (third in ACC).
- Chris Lykes is seventh in the ACC in scoring (17.9) and averaging 22.0 ppg in conference play.
- Zach Johnson is one of 10 players nationally with 1,500 career points and 350 assists.
- DJ Vasiljevic has hit at least one 3-pointer in 29 straight games the longest current streak in the ACC.
- Ebuka Izundu is third in the ACC in rebounding (9.5), and fourth in double-doubles (6).
- As a team Miami ranks 11th nationally in fewest fouls per game (14.7).
- Miami, UNC, Virginia and Duke are the lone teams to win 10 or more ACC games each of the last four seasons.
- Junior forward Dewan Hernandez has been withheld from competition thus far as the University and NCAA review his eligibility.

MIAMI-NORTH CAROLINA SERIES

North Carolina owns a 22-8 edge in the all-time series with Miami, although the programs have split the 12 contests since Jim Larrañaga took over as head coach. UM has won six of the last 10 meetings.

The teams split two games last season, with UM prevailing, 91-88, on Feb. 27 in Chapel Hill on JaQuan Newton's 40-foot buzzer beater and UNC countering with an 82-65 win in the ACC Tournament quarterfinals.

In UNC's last trip to the Watsco Center (Jan. 28, 2017), the unranked Canes topped the then-No. 9 Tar Heels. 77-62.

Jim Larrañaga is 7-7 in his career against North Carolina, including 6-6 while at Miami.

THE ACC GRIND CONTINUES

Miami's ACC schedule is not for the faint of heart. Nine of UM's 18 conference games pit the Canes against teams currently ranked in the AP Top 20.

Miami and Wake Forest each play a league-high nine games against ACC teams that currently are ranked in the top 20.

The Canes' challenging conference schedule includes 11 games against teams that competed in the 2018 NCAA Tournament, including home-and-homes with Florida State, North Carolina and Virginia Tech, all of which are currently ranked in the top 15.

SECOND RANKED FOE OF SEASON

Miami is facing its third top-25 opponent this season and is 0-2 against ranked foes this year.

The Canes are 19-37 against ranked opponents under Jim Larrañaga. UM's last win against a ranked team came on Feb. 27, 2018, a 91-88 buzzerbeating victory against then-No.9 UNC in Chapel Hill.

UM is 56-153 all-time against top-25 teams, including 29-68 in ACC play.

THE MAGNIFICENT SEVEN

Miami has primarily played with a rotation of seven to eight players. UM currently has seven scholarship student-athletes available.

Chris Lykes (33.3, 9th), Anthony Lawrence (32.1, 17th), DJ Vasiljevic (31.4, 19th) and Zach Johnson (30.7, 24th) rank among the ACC's top 25 in minutes played.

The rotation was shortened to seven when Deng Gak went down with a season-ending injury on Dec. 1.

BALANCE ON OFFENSE

Five Miami players are averaging at least 11.8 points per game apiece.

The Canes are the lone team among basketball's six power conferences with five players averaging 11.8 or more points per game.

The five: Chris Lykes (17.9), Zach Johnson (13.4), DJ Vasiljevic (12.2), Anthony Lawrence (12.0) and Ebuka Izundu (11.8).

LAST TIME OUT: MIAMI 76. WAKE 65

Miami earned its first ACC win of the season, 76-65, over Wake Forest last Saturday at home.

Chris Lykes tallied his sixth 20-point outing of the season, scoring 25 points while converting on all 14 of his free-throw attempts.

Lykes was joined by Dejan Vasiljevic (14 points) and Ebuka Izundu (11 points) in double figures, while Ebuka Izundu notched his seventh career double-double with 11 boards.

UM limited Wake Forest's leading scorer, Brandon Childress, to a season-low 11 points on 2-of-12 shooting. Wake shot 34 percent from the field.

CLOSE, BUT NOT QUITE

Despite its seven losses, Miami has been in every game this season.

UM has held a lead in the second half in 15 of 16 games, with the Penn game being the lone exception.

In the Penn game, UM closed to within four points with just over three minutes left in the game.

LYKES PACES OFFENSE

Chris Lykes is averaging 17.9 ppg and ranks seventh in the ACC in scoring. He is averaging 22.0 ppg in conference games, which is third among all ACC players.

As part of his 25-point day last Saturday against Wake Forest, Lykes went 14-for-14 at the free-throw line, the second best performance at the line in school history. Jack McClinton went 16-for-16 against NC State on March 7, 2009.

Lykes scored a career-high 28 points in the ACC opener against NC State.

He owns six 20-point games this season, which is seventh most among ACC players, and has upped his scoring average by 8.3 ppg from his freshman season, marking the second largest increase among ACC players.

IZUNDU: THE DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

Ebuka Izundu has stepped into a starting role this season and averaged 11.8 ppg and a team-high 9.5 rebounds per game (5.0 ppg, 3.8 rpg last season).

Izundu has produced six double-doubles and is averaging a double-double in ACC play (10.5 ppg, 10.3 rpg).

He leads the conference in offensive rebounds (3.75/game), ranks third overall in rebounds (9.5), fourth in double-doubles and eighth in blocks (1.63/game)

With 22 points and 19 rebounds against SFA, he fell one rebound shy of the first 20-rebound performance by a UM player since Reggie Johnson's 20-rebound effort against FAU on March 16, 2011.

JOHNSON IN ELITE 1,500/350 CLUB

Zach Johnson is one of nine active players nationally to score 1,500 career points and rack up 350 career assists.

Johnson has scored 1,558 career points (1,344 at Florida Gulf Coast, 214 at UM) and owns 357 career assists (321 at FGCU, 36 at UM).

Johnson ranks 36th nationally in career scoring and 44th in assists among active Division I players. He is averaging 13.4 ppg this season.

VASILJEVIC AMONG ACC 3-PT LEADERS

DJ Vasiljevic is 47-for-107 (43.9%) from 3-point range and averaging 12.2 ppg. He is second in the ACC in 3-pointers made and 3-pointers per game (2.94) and fifth in 3-point field goal percentage.

2018: CANES, HEELS SPLIT TWO GAMES FEB. 28: MIAMI 91, NO. 9 UNC 88

Ja'Quan Newton hit a running 30-footer at the horn to help Miami upset No. 9 North Carolina 91-88 in a wild finish on Feb. 28 in Chapel Hill. Newton's heave off his left foot came immediately after UNC's Joel Berry II hit a tough 3 of his own to tie the game with 4.1 seconds left.

Miami's 91 points matched its most in regulation in any road ACC game since UM joined the league for the 2004-05 season (91 at UVA on Jan. 12, 2005).

Chris Lykes scored 18 points to lead Miami, which shot 55 percent despite squandering a 16-point second-half lead. Berry led UNC with 31 points.

MARCH 8: NO. 12 UNC 82, NO. 24 MIAMI 65

Miami bolted to an early 14-0 lead but North Carolina rallied to earn an 82-65 win in the quarterfinals of the ACC Tournament.

UNC misfired on its first 13 shots before Seventh Woods finally made a layup at the 12:51 mark. The Tar Heels built a 10-point lead before UM cut it to three, 66-63, with 4:56 left. The Tar Heels pulled away from there, ending the game on a 17-2 run.

Ja'Quan Newton paced the Hurricanes with 17 points, while Anthony Lawrence had 12 points. Theo Pinson led UNC with 25 points.

Miami held UNC to 41 percent shooting, but UM shot just 37 percent while the Tar Heels outrebounded the Hurricanes 52-41 and outscored UM 18-7 at the free-throw line.

He has hit at least one 3-pointer in 29 consecutive games (longest current streak in ACC). It is the fifth-longest streak in Miami history.

If Vasiljevic hits a triple in the UNC game, he would match Jack McClinton (2007-08) for the fourth-longest streak in program history.

Vasiljevic led the ACC in 3-point field goal percentage last season (41.1%), becoming the fifth Hurricane to top the conference in 3-point shooting (first since Malcolm Grant in 2011).

MACK PROVIDING VALUABLE MINUTES

Anthony Mack has given Miami valuable minutes off the bench in the last seven games, averaging 21.9 minutes and 5.1 points per game in that span.

In four ACC contests, he has averaged 25.3 minutes per game.

He scored a career-high nine points last Saturday against Wake Forest, including a pair of 3-pointers, while making his third straight start.

He scored five total points in 33 minutes while playing in five of UM's first nine games.

NOTING THE WAKE FOREST GAME

- Miami now has led in the second half in 15 of 16 games this season (Penn is the lone exception).
- · Miami is 3-3 this season when trailing at the half.
- UM held Wake's leading scorer Brandon Childress to a season-low 11 points. He went without a field goal until there was 2:11 left in the game.
- Chris Lykes scored in double figures for the 15th

Miami has eclipsed the 70-point plateau in 14 of 16 games this season. The Canes are 9-5 when breaking the 70-point mark this year.

The Canes are 114-20 when scoring 70 or more points under Larrañaga and 48-4 when breaking the 80-point barrier.

THE WATSCO ADVANTAGE

Miami has defended its home turf well in recent years, winning 45 of its last 52 games at the Watsco Center. The Canes are 95-27 (.778) at home under Jim Larrañaga.

Miami had its 19-game home non-conference win streak snapped on Nov. 28 in a 57-54 defeat to Rutgers. The streak dated to a 78-77 loss to Northeastern on Nov. 27, 2015.

In its 17th year at the Watsco Center (formerly BankUnited Center), Miami is 188-71 (.726) on its home court.

In eight years under Larrañaga, Miami is 45-19 in ACC action at home and 50-8 in non-conference play.

Walker and Wong are four-star recruits and rated among the top 100 players nationally in the Rivals recruiting rankings. Walker is a 6-foot-9, 210-pound power forward from Nottingham, Md. Wong is a 6-foot-3, 170-pound guard from Trenton, N.J.

CANES START SEASON AGAINST LEAGUE FAVORITES

Miami opened its season with three straight games against teams that were picked to win their respective conferences.

Lehigh was chosen as the preseason favorites in the Patriot League. Stephen F. Austin was picked to repeat as the Southland Conference champion, while Bethune-Cookman was selected as the preseason MEAC favorite.

WHO'S GONE

Miami lost three players from its 2017-18 squad, each of whom started at least 18 games: Lonnie Walker IV, Bruce Brown Jr. and Ja'Quan Newton.

Walker was an Honorable Mention All-ACC pick and ACC All-Freshman Team honoree last year. He was selected 18th overall in the NBA Draft by the San Antonio Spurs.

Brown started 19 games before missing the remainder of the season with a foot injury. He was picked 42nd overall in the NBA Draft by Detroit.

Newton played in 127 career games (seventh in program history) and finished with 1,134 career points.

PROGRAM EARNS PERFECT GSR

The Miami men's basketball program earned its first perfect GSR rating, coming in 19 percent above

the NCAA average of 81 percent.

The GSR measures graduation rates at Division I institutions and includes students transferring into the institutions. The most recent Division I Graduation Success Rates are based on the four entering classes from 2008-09 to 2011-12

HIGH SCHOOL TEAMMATES REUNITE

With the transfers of Zach Johnson and Anthony Mack, Miami now has two pairs of high school teammates on its roster this season.

Johnson reunites with Dewan Hernandez, with whom he played two seasons and won two state championships at Norland High School.

Mack is back together with Deng Gak, with whom he played two seasons at Blair Academy in New Jersey.

HUELL BECOMES HERNANDEZ

The name is unfamiliar, but Dewan Hernandez remains a familiar face for the Canes. Formerly Dewan Huell, Hernandez legally changed his last name in the offseason.

The switch was made to honor his mother, Christina Hernandez, and was officially finalized in mid-October.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Miami has six team co-captains this season: Dewan Hernandez, Ebuka Izundu, Zach Johnson, Anthony Lawrence II, Chris Lykes and DJ Vasiljevic.

Hernandez, Lawrence and Vasiljevic are team captains for the second straight season.

SELLING OUT THE WATSCO CENTER

Miami sold out its season ticket allotment for all home games at the Watsco Center for each of the last three seasons.

Fans bought over 5,500 season tickets for each of the last three years, more than doubling the total number of season tickets sold in Jim Larrañaga's first season in Coral Gables.

A 6-foot-6 guard, Proctor played at Bishop Gorman High School in Las Vegas, where he won a pair of state championships.

He was the the 14th-ranked player in Nevada in 2017 according to 24/7 Sports and the 103rd-ranked shooting guard in the nation per 24/7.

ANOTHER 20-WIN CAMPAIGN UNDER LARRAÑAGA

Miami recorded 22 wins last season, its sixth 20win campaign in seven years under Jim Larrañaga, and tied for the 10th most wins in a season in school history.

He is the first coach in program history to post six 20-win seasons. Bruce Hale (1954-67) recorded five 20-win campaigns from 1954-67.


