THE FACTS...

Miami comes into this weekend with a 10-match home winning streak dating back to last year. This weekend proves to be tough competition, once again, as a pair of ACC teams grace the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex. The first opponent is North Carolina State who enters at 9-13 overall (3-4 ACC). That is followed by a visit from North Carolina who is 10-8 overall (4-3 ACC).

Miami has no injuries to report, and the Hurricanes appear to be as healthy as ever along the front line of attack. This weekend's matches serve as the second in as many weeks that UM has hosted a pair of ACC matches at the Knight Sports Complex. These will be matches four and five of a five-match home stand for the Orange and Green after "living" on the road for five consecutive matches in which they went 3-2.

The Hurricanes assured themselves a winning season with a win over Maryland last Sunday, and have tied the 2004 team (17-9, 11-5 ACC) for the most wins in a season since that time. The school record for wins in a single season is 49 set back in 1980.

In fact, Miami has claimed five 20-win campaigns in school history, those coming in 1977 (22-17), 1979 (33-14), 1980 (49-14-1), 2002 (27-6) and 2003 (22-9). However, only the 2002 and '03 seasons were a part of the NCAA Division I record books. Prior to that, the records were set as part of the former AIAW league. With just three wins in the next 13 matches, Miami will notch the third 20-win season for head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch.

ON N.C. STATE...

After rolling off three consecutive wins, the Wolfpack of North Carolina State have dropped three of their last five matches, including a 3-1 decision this past Tuesday night against rival North Carolina. The Wolfpack are 2-3 on the road this season, and just 3-4 in conference play, and they sit with a 9-13 overall record on the year.

They are led by the play of Arlee Tamietti with 228 kills, while teammate Aiwane Iboaya sits behind her with 146 kills to her name. Tamietti also has 157 digs and 47 blocks. The setter for the Pack is Alex Smith with 659 assists under her belt.

ON NORTH CAROLINA...

The University of North Carolina Tar Heels enter this weekend's matchup with a 10-8 overall record, and a 4-3 ACC mark. They downed rival N.C. State, 3-1 in their last match, and hold a better home record than away from home. The Tar Heels are 6-1 at home this year, but just 3-4 on the road.

The Tar Heels are paved by the duo of Lauren Prussing (163 kills) and Suzanne Haydel (150 kills). The setter is Stephanie Jansma who leads the squad with 462 assists. The defensive efforts are sparked by Brianna Eskola who leads the team with 311 digs, while teammate Haydel has 200 digs to boot.

ON THE NET...

All Miami home matches this year will feature live stats through Gametracker on www.hurricanesports.com. A select number of them will feature radio broadcast through WVUM...the official student radio station for the University of Miami. That is also followed by a pair of matches on ACC Select sponsored through the Atlantic Coast Conference. The matches to be shown on ACC Select include home stands against Duke (Oct. 31) and a match at home against Clemson (Nov. 16).

MIAMI VS. NCSU SERIES...

The series has belonged solely to the Hurricanes since joining the Atlantic Coast Conference in 2004. Miami holds an 8-0 advantage in this series, having won four of those matches with 3-0 sweeps. NCSU has never

Head Coach ... Nicole Lantagne Welch



Nicole Lantagne Welch enters her eighth season at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in five of the last seven seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

In the 2006 season-opener, Lantagne Welch recorded her 100th career win with a 3-2 victory over Alabama. In 2007, UM finished 14-17 overall and 8-14 in ACC play, pushing Lantagne Welch's career record to 125-81 overall in seven seasons as a head coach, all at Miami.

Her career at UM is highlighted by two consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins (2003 & 2004) and a trip to the Sweet 16 in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her seven seasons at the helm, the Hurricanes have averaged 17.8 wins per season.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. As a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered first-team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and 1993, and earned second-team honors in 1991. She was also named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

As team captain her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career at Maryland, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

Under Lantagne Welch's training, Aggie setter Jenna Moscovic was named the 1999 Big 12 Conference Freshman of the Year and named to the All-American Freshman Team by Volleyball Magazine. As a sophomore, Moscovic was selected to the 2000 All-Big 12 Team and All-District 5 Team. Lantagne Welch also played a major role in bringing the Aggies back-to-back Top 10 recruiting classes. The 1999 class was ranked in the Top 10 by Student Sports Magazine and the 1998 class was ranked sixth by Volleyball Magazine.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7th, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

HURRICANES VB MEDIA POLICY**KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX**

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Information Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

MIAMI VS. UNC SERIES...

Since Miami joined the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC), the Hurricanes and Tar Heels stand even at a 4-4 deadlock in this series. The 'Canes have lost three of their last five meetings with the Tar Heels, but the two teams shared a season split last year. The home teams prevailed in each meeting in 2007. Ironically, the matches were sweeps both ways as well. Miami came into the ACC and swept the Heels in back-to-back matches in 2004 before UNC rolled off a sweep in 2006. The two foes split again in 2005.

WIN TOTAL SURPASSED; WINNING SEASON ASSURED...

The Hurricanes have surpassed their win total from the previous three seasons as they collected a pair of wins last weekend against Boston College and Maryland. With a victory this weekend, the 'Canes could surpass yet another season's winning streak if they move to 18 wins. That would be the most amount of wins in a single season since moving into the ACC, and the most since 2003 (22-9). The 'Canes won just 14 matches in 2007, and just 12 in 2006. They had a 17-9 performance in 2004, and collected a 16-14 record in 2005.

SHUTTING THE DOOR...

Miami has shutout nine opponents this season in their first 19 matches. Last year, the Hurricanes managed eight shutouts in 2007 altogether. The 2006 class had just four and 2005 with six. The most shutouts for the Hurricanes since joining the ACC is 11 back in 2004--their first season in the league. The most under head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch is 17 back in 2002, the last year UM made it to the NCAA Tournament.

HOME IS WHERE THE HITS ARE...

At home this year in the friendly confines of the James L. Knight Sports Complex, the 'Canes have yet to hit below a .200 clip. In fact, they are averaging a .280 hitting percentage (335-104-824) at home. Meanwhile, opponents are being held to just .150 hitting at "The Knight."

SPOTLIGHT ON THE STATS...

Miami is currently ranked 21st as a team in service aces per set (1.74) nationally. Individually, the 'Canes has a player ranked nationally as well with Cassie Loessberg ranking 41st in digs per set (4.56). Also ranked is the team in blocks per set (41st), digs per set (38th), hitting percentage (21st). UM is also ranked 37th in kills per set as well.

TRACKING LOESSBERG AND THE DIGS...

Junior libero Cassie Loessberg continues to jump up the charts this season as she now has 301 digs on the campaign, upping her career total to 1,172. That sets Loessberg at second place all-time in UM history behind Jamie Grass (2001-04) with 1,621 digs under her belt. Throughout the year, we will continue to track Loessberg in her goal to become the all-time leading digs collector at UM.

MAYHEW NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-ACC TEAM...

Junior outside hitter Genny Mayhew was named to the Preseason All-ACC Team as voted on by head coaches around the Atlantic Coast Conference. Mayhew, a 5-foot-11 junior from Clovis, Calif. (Clovis HS), finished ninth in the conference in both kills (428) and points (465) a year ago. She also finished fourth on the squad in digs (224) and tied for fifth in blocks (43) alongside teammate Ariell Cooke while playing in 111 games for the 'Canes.

CLEMSON PREDICTED TO WIN ACC ... AGAIN...

After finishing atop the league last season, the Clemson Tigers have been predicted to repeat as conference champs after collecting 11 of a possible 12 first place votes. Georgia Tech received the other first place vote while being predicted to finish second. Duke and North Carolina were third and fourth, while Florida State and Virginia tied for fifth, respectively.

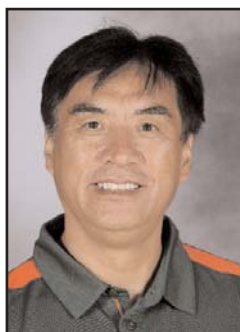
